


• Energy index: natural gas and crude oil prices, rig counts, and oil & gas employment.^{1,3,8,11}



➤ The Henry Hub natural gas price averaged \$3.02 per MMBtu in December, \$0.92 more than a month ago. The WTI crude oil price increased 0.2% in December compared to the previous month, but decreased 2.5% compared to December 2023.



In a year-over-year comparison (December 2024 vs. December 2023), sales and use tax collections statewide decreased by \$8.6 million or 10.4%. 13 of the 23 counties saw year-over-year decreases in collections. Albany County experienced the largest decrease in collections, down 67.9%. Platte County saw the largest increase, up 28.1%.






State & local shares of 4% sales and use tax collections.⁷ [Change by Industry: December 2024 vs. December 2023 by percent and dollars (in thousands)]
