


• Energy index: natural gas and crude oil prices, rig counts, and oil & gas employment.^{1,3,8,11}



✤ The Henry Hub natural gas price averaged \$2.16 per MMBtu in April, \$0.14 lower than a month ago. The WTI crude oil price increased 8.4% in April compared to the previous month, but decreased 21.9% compared to April 2022.


