


• Energy index: natural gas and crude oil prices, rig counts, and oil & gas employment.^{1,3,8,11}



✤ The West Texas Intermediate crude oil price averaged \$63.54 in April, 6.9% less than the previous month. The Henry Hub natural gas price averaged \$3.41 per MMBtu in April, \$0.72 less than a month ago, but \$1.82 more than April 2024.


