


## • Energy index: natural gas and crude oil prices, rig counts, and oil & gas employment.<sup>1,3,8,11</sup>



▶ The Henry Hub natural gas price averaged \$1.49 per MMBtu in March, \$0.23 lower than a month ago. The WTI crude oil price increased 5.2% in March compared to the previous month and increased 10.9% compared to March 2023.


