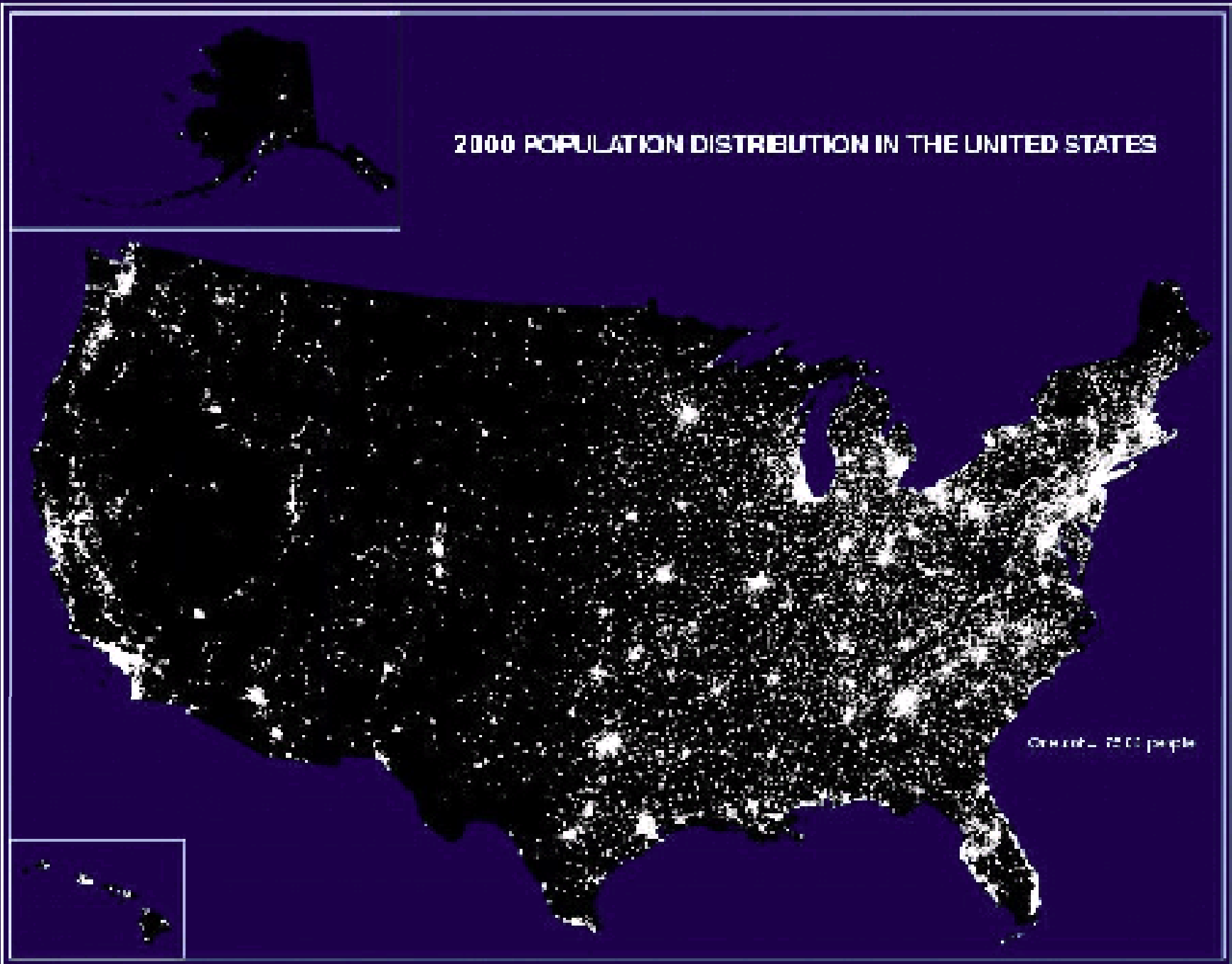

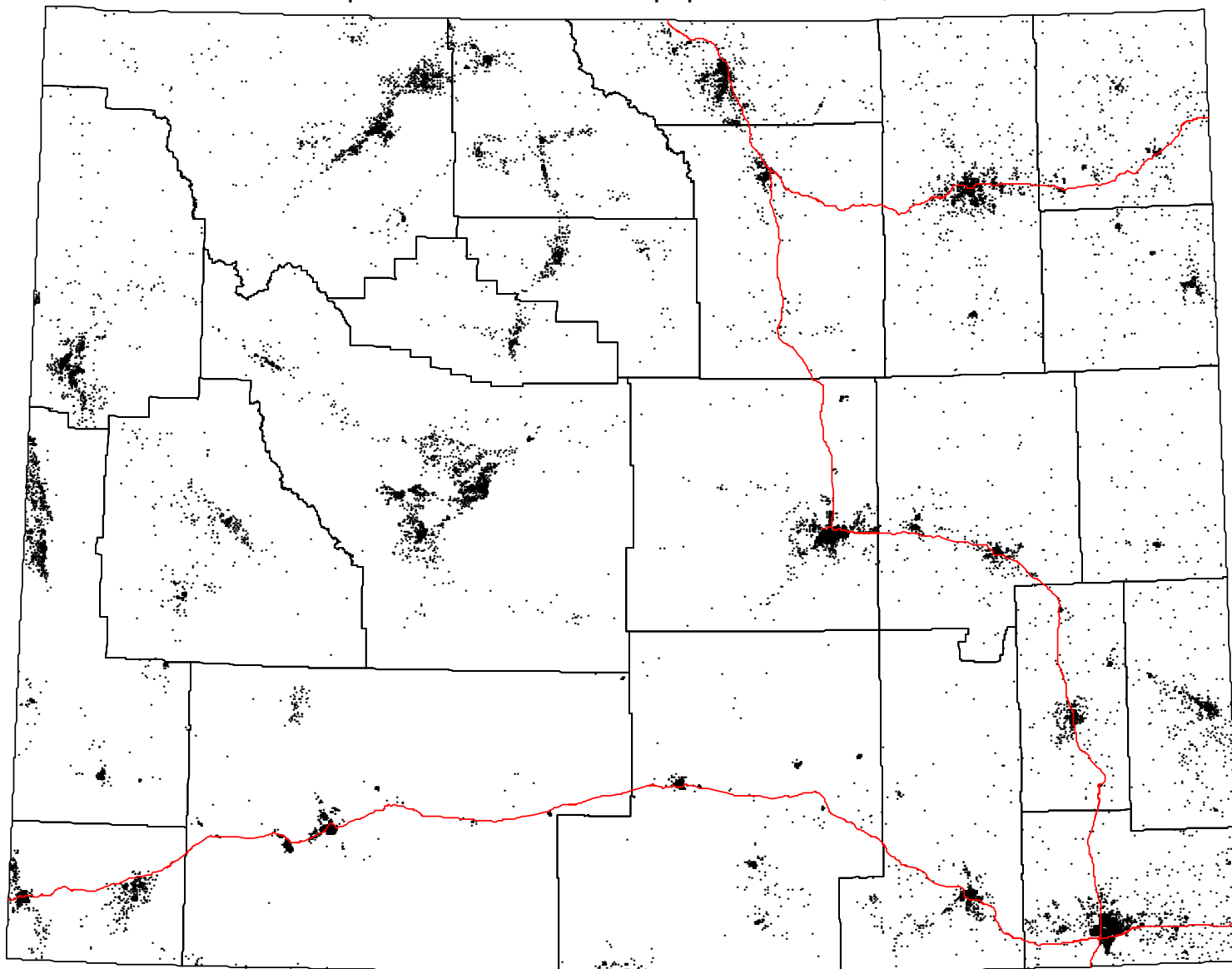

# Population Distribution Map for Wyoming: 2000

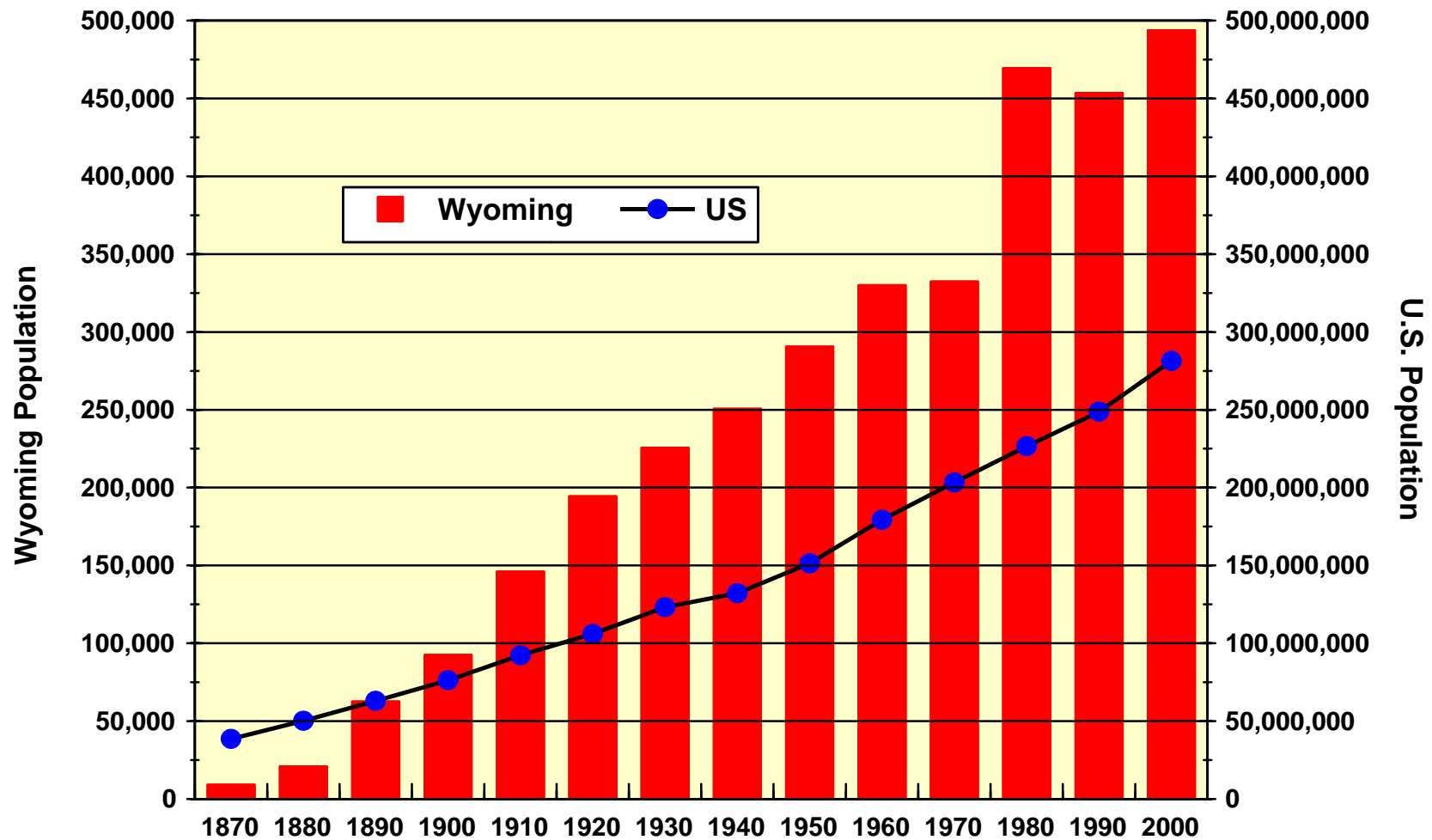

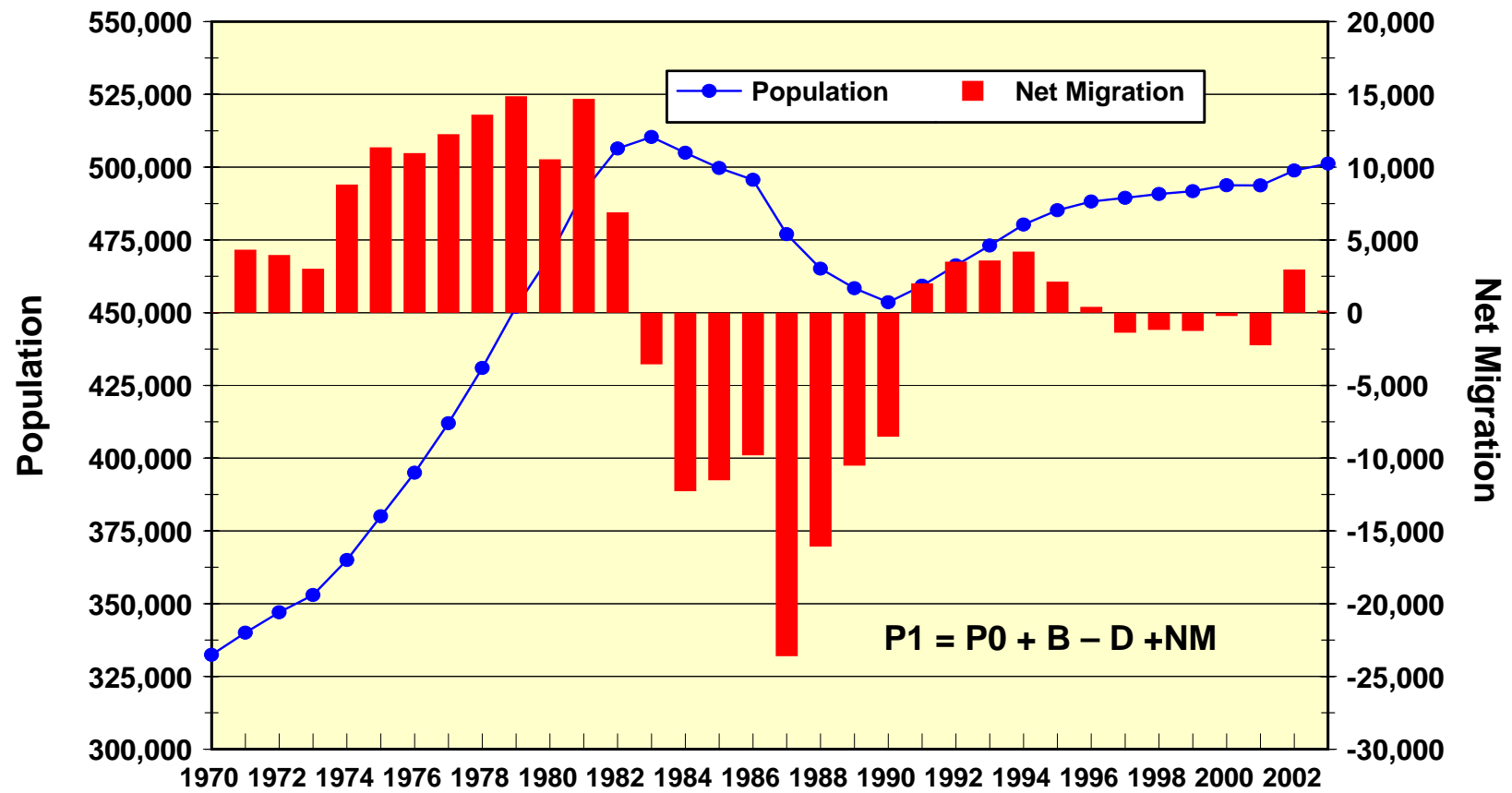

## Wyoming Population and Net Migration: 1970 to 2003

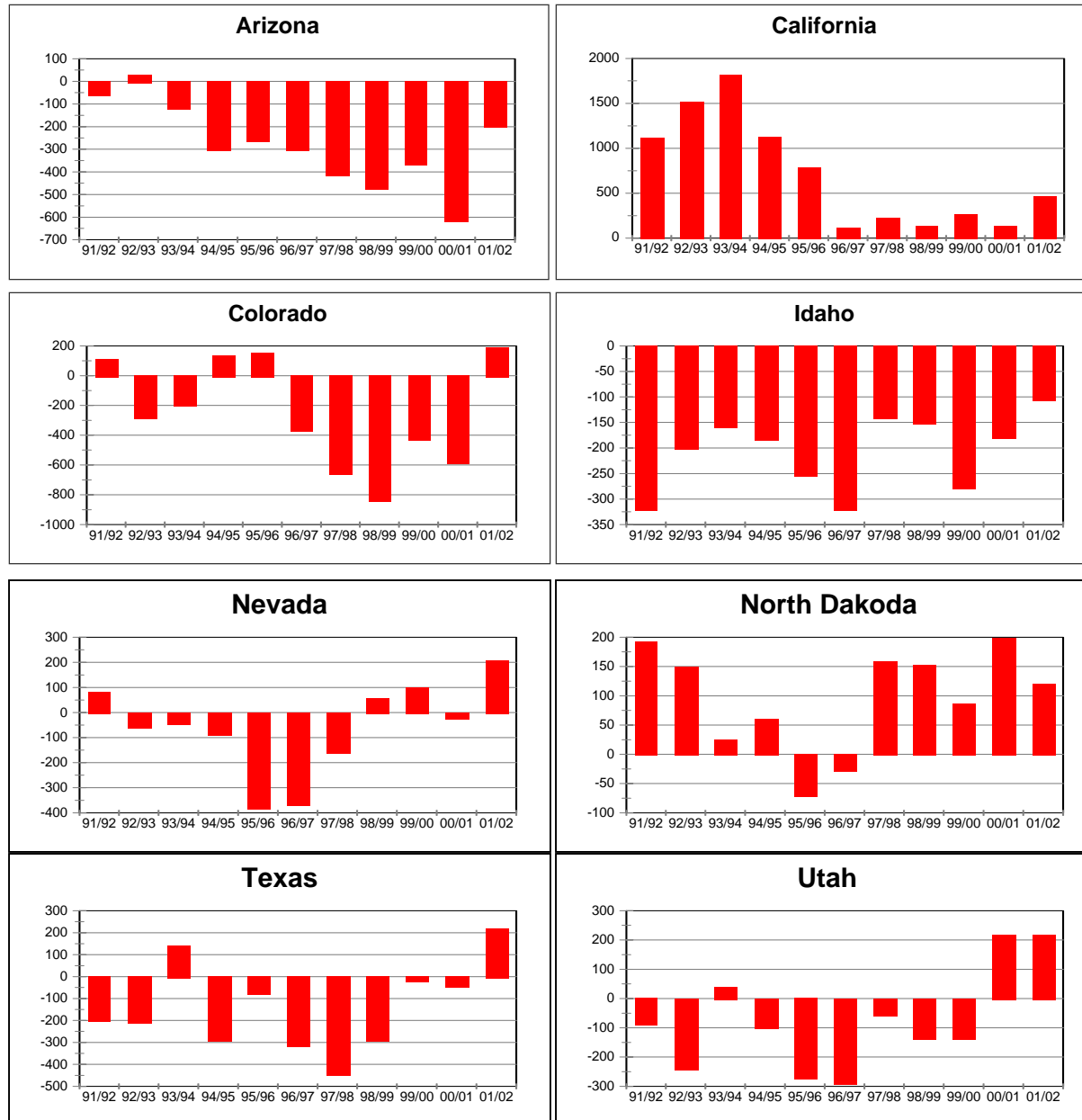


Net Migration = Immigration - Outmigration

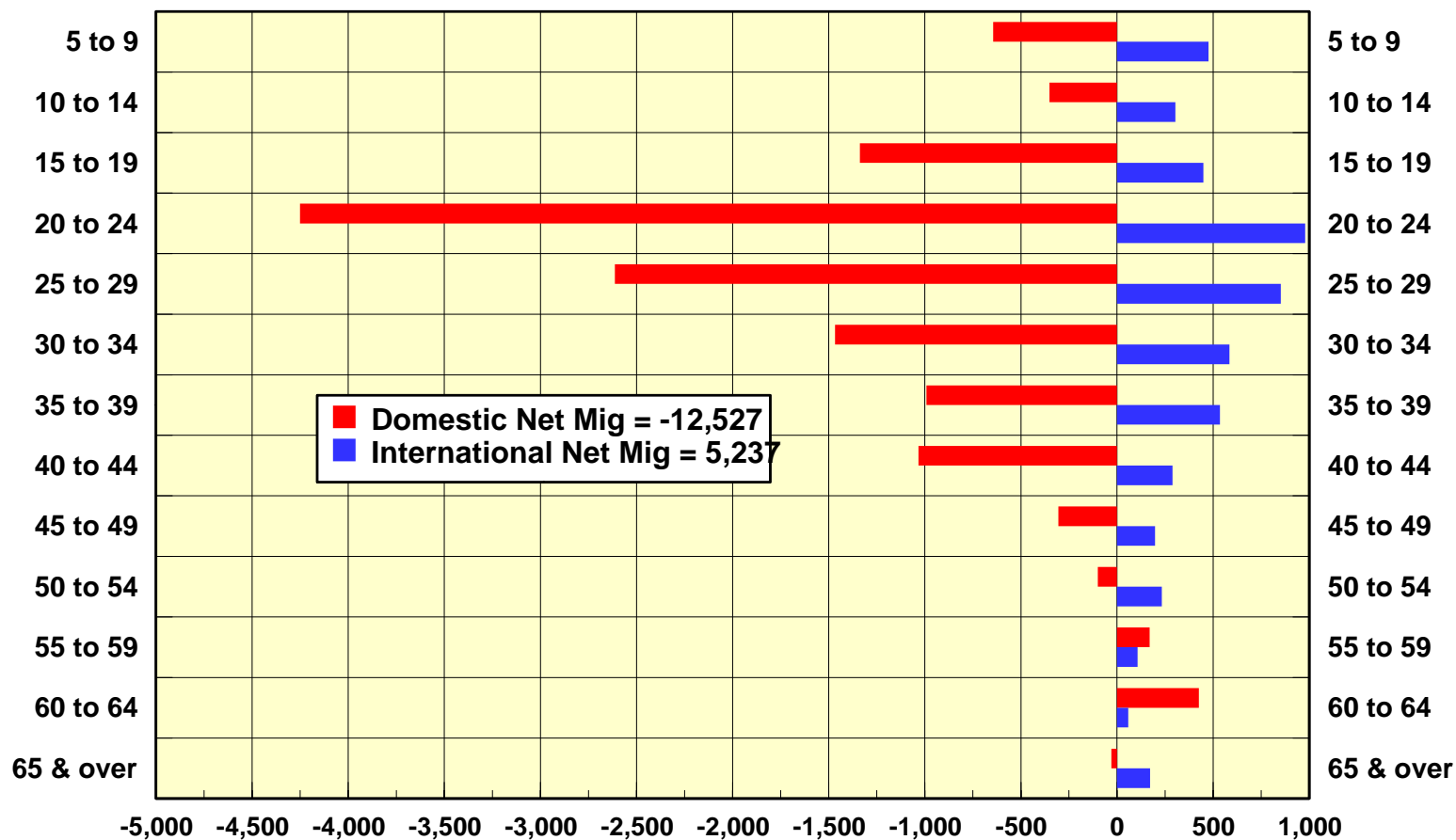

## Net Migration Between Wyoming and Selected States: 1991- 2002



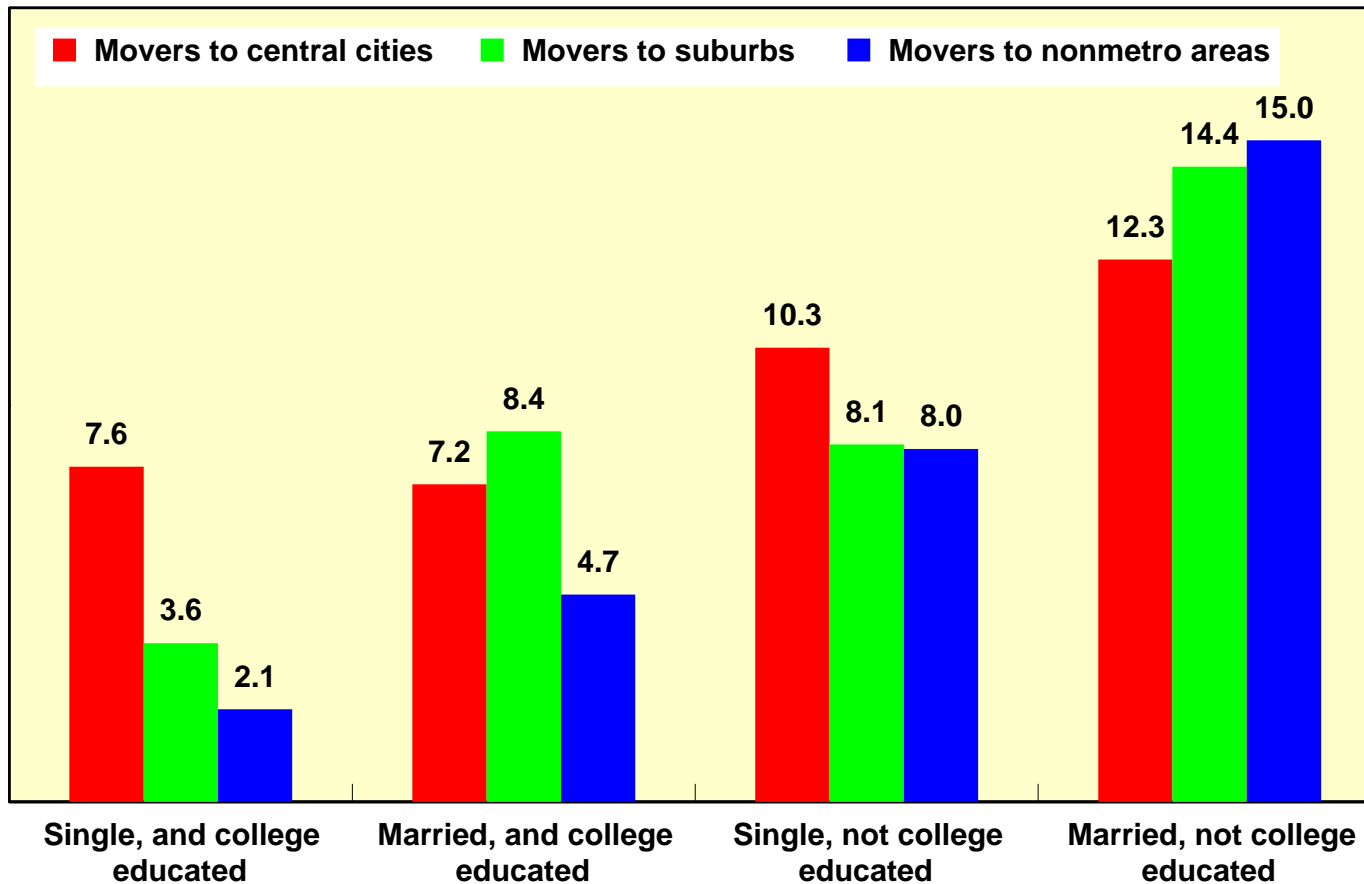
## Net Migration by Age for Population 5 Years and Over (1995 to 2000)

## Percent of Young Movers (age 25 to 39) to Specified Destination for U.S. : 1995 to 2000



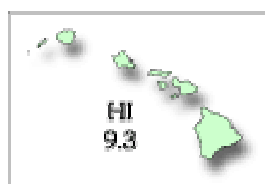
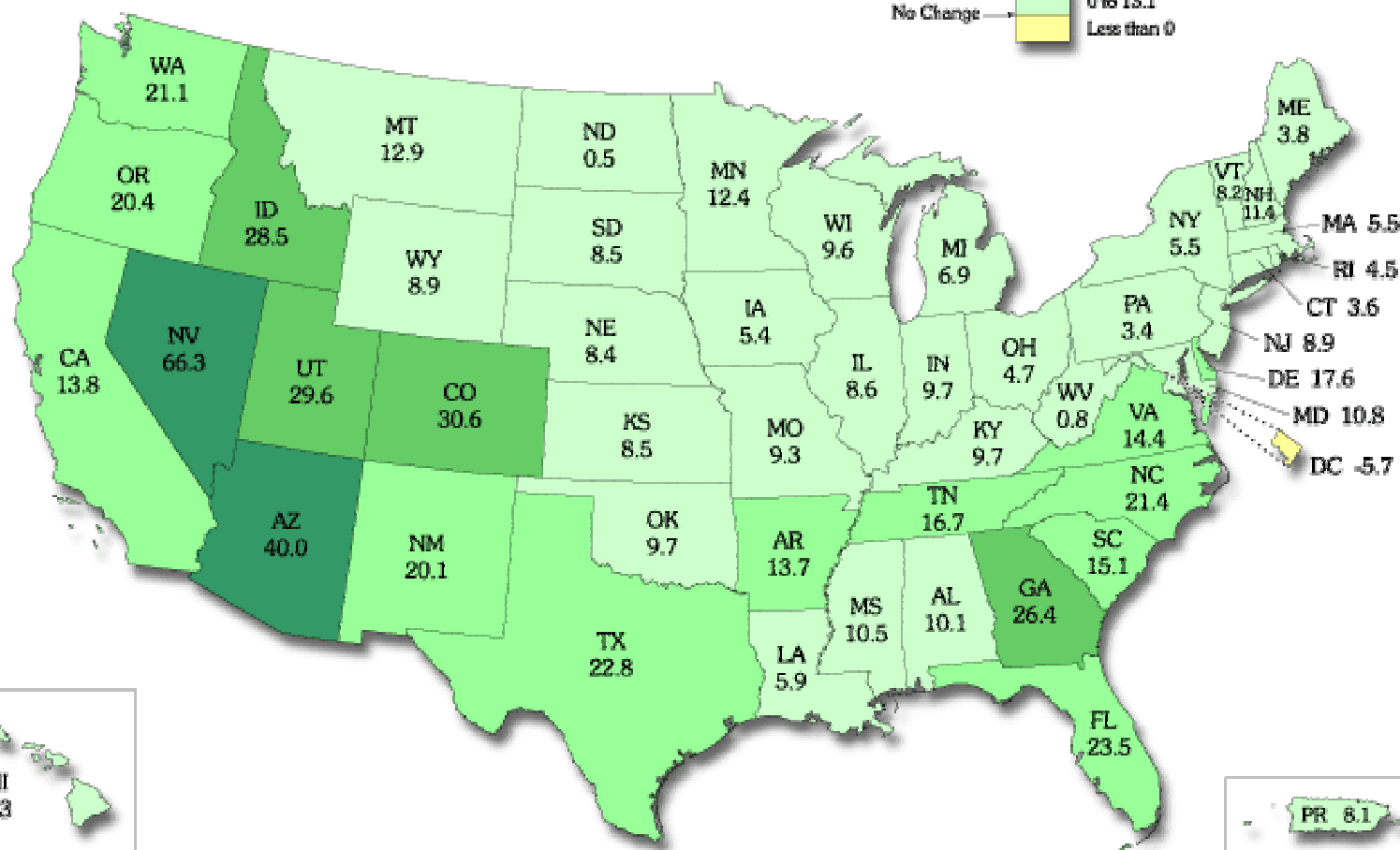
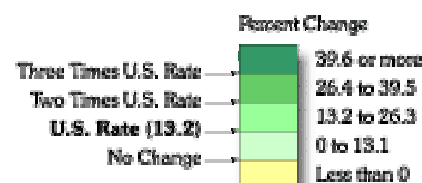

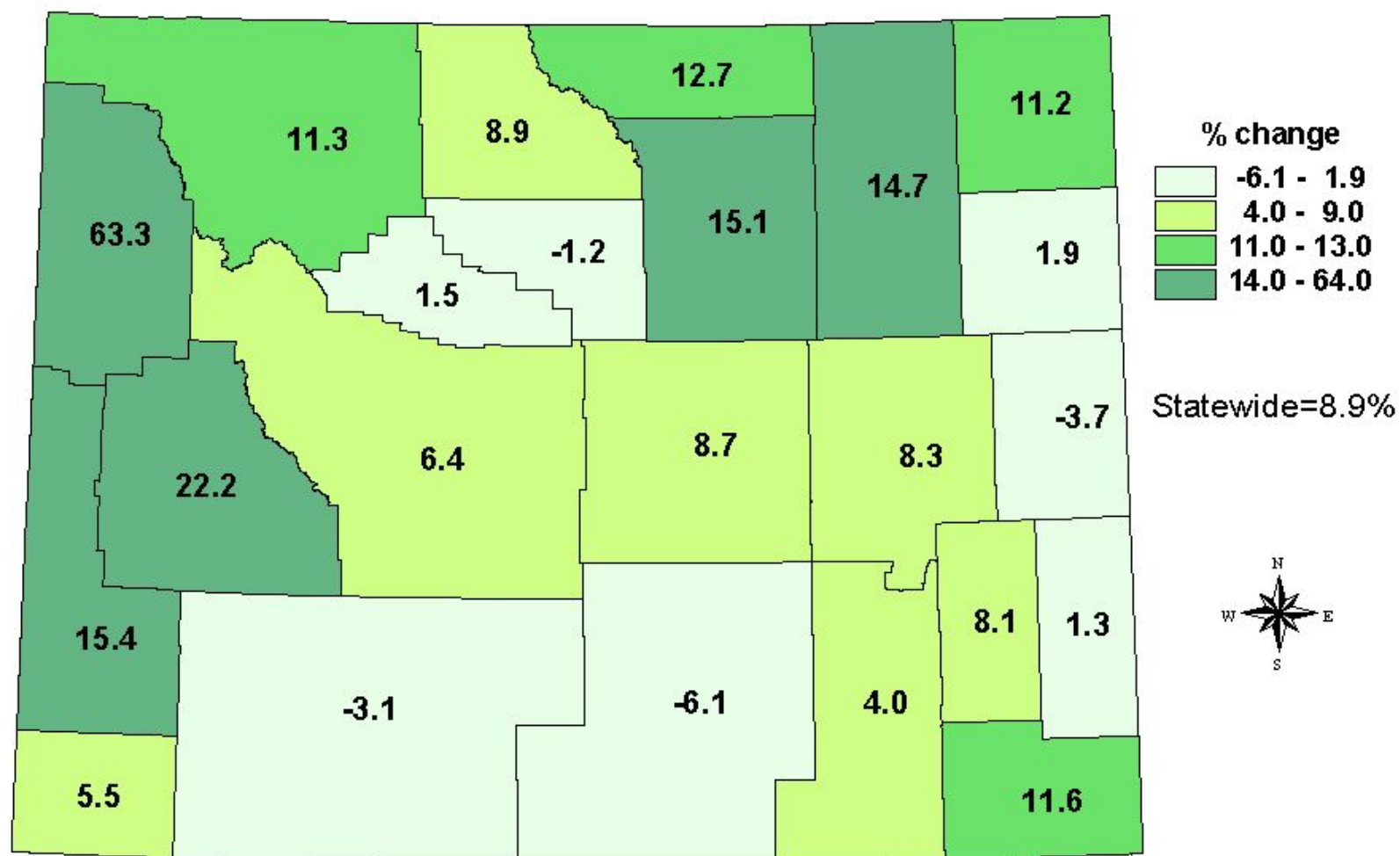




**Figure 1. Percent Change in Resident Population for the 50 States, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico: 1990 to 2000**

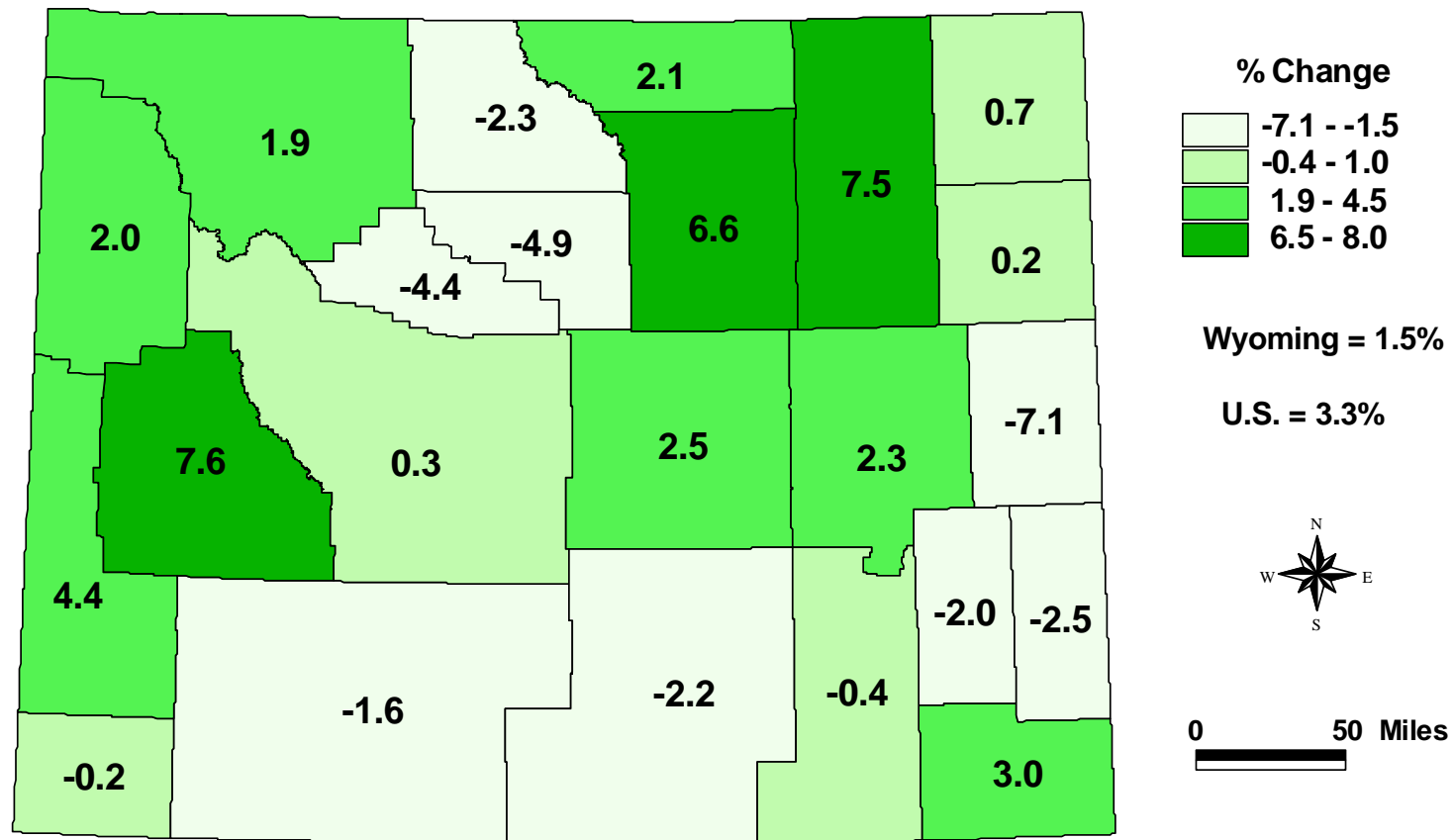


## Percent Change in Population for Counties: 1990 to 2000



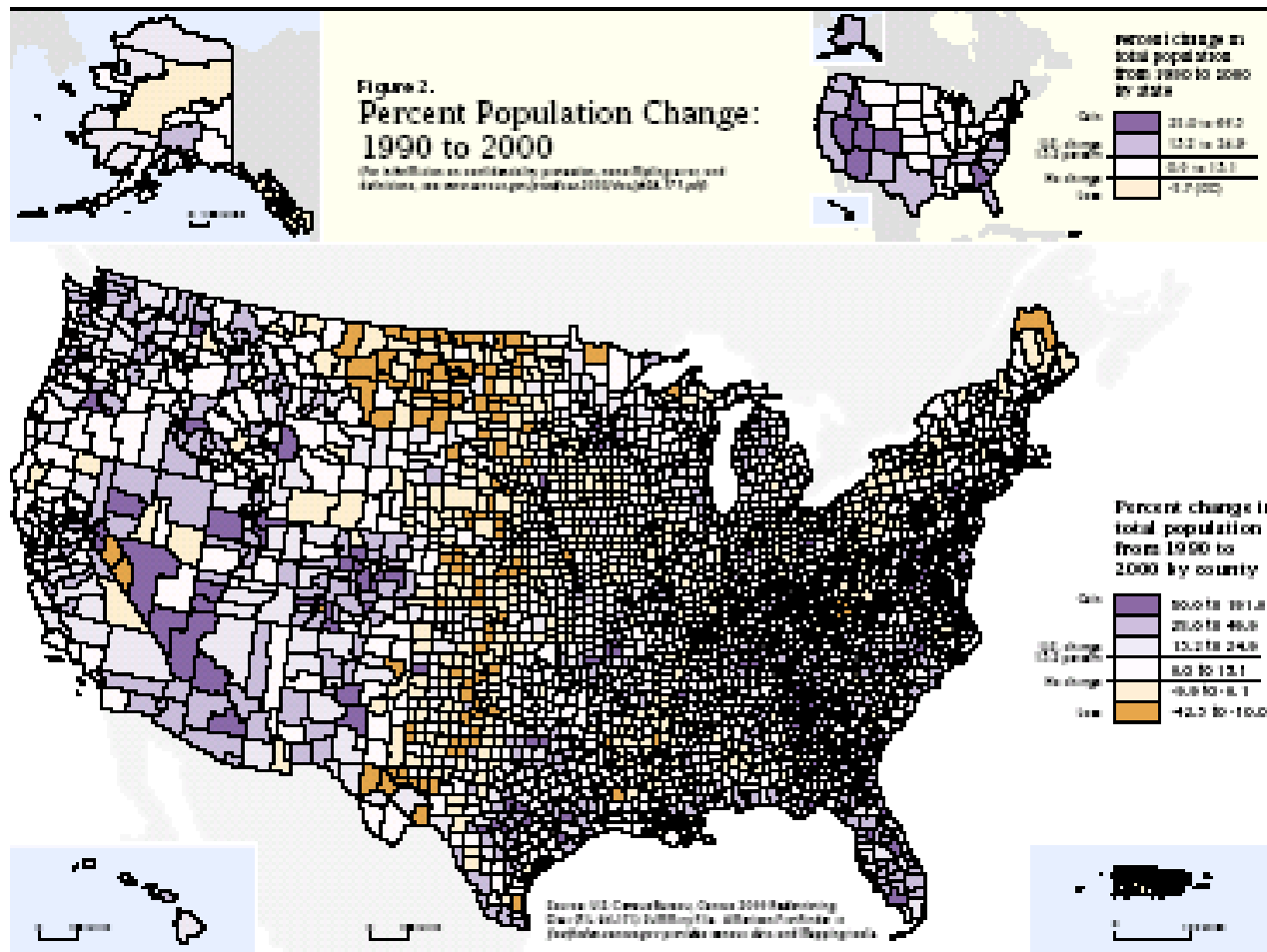

## Percent Change of Population: 2000 to 2003

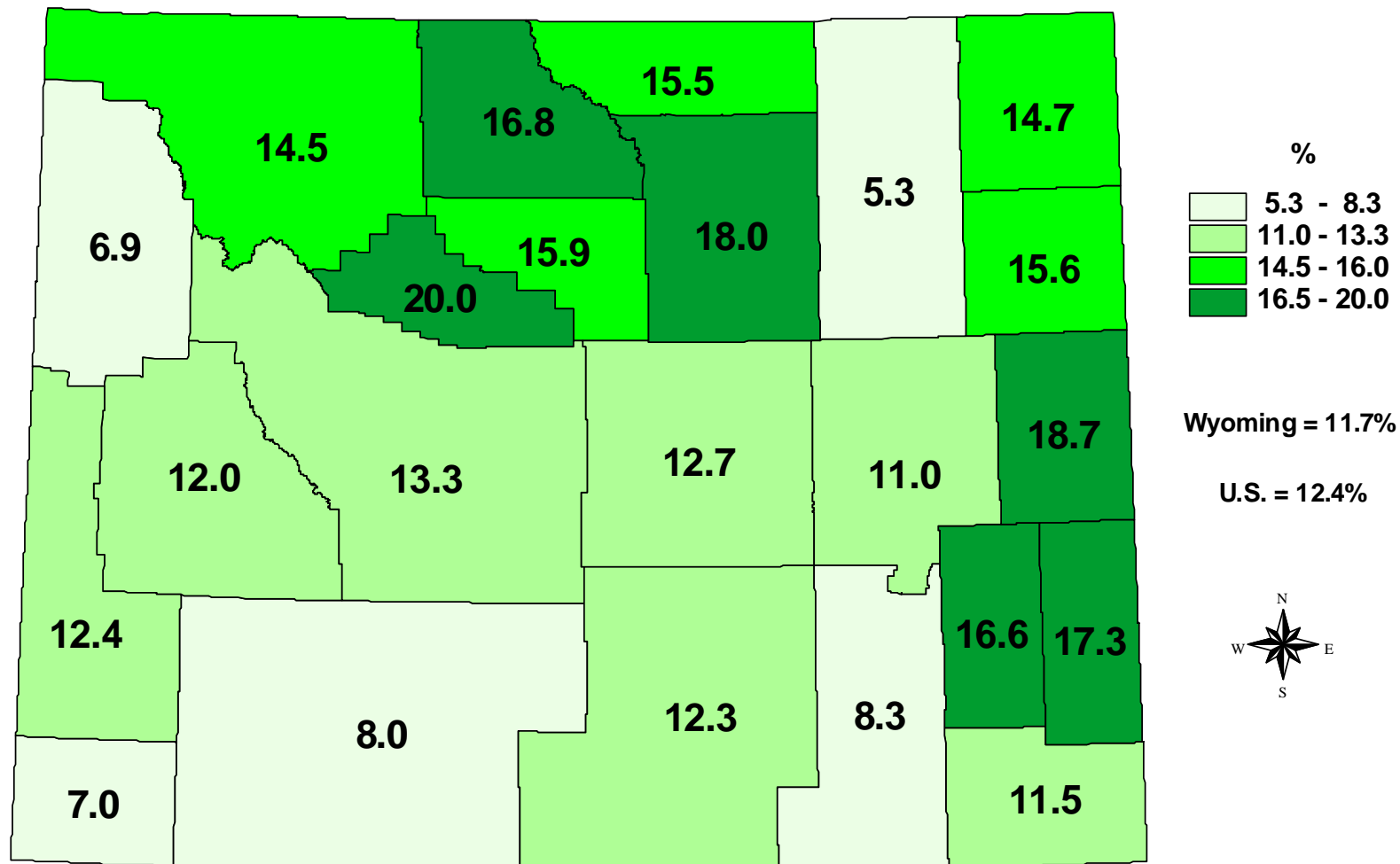

## Percent of Population 65 Years and Over: 2000

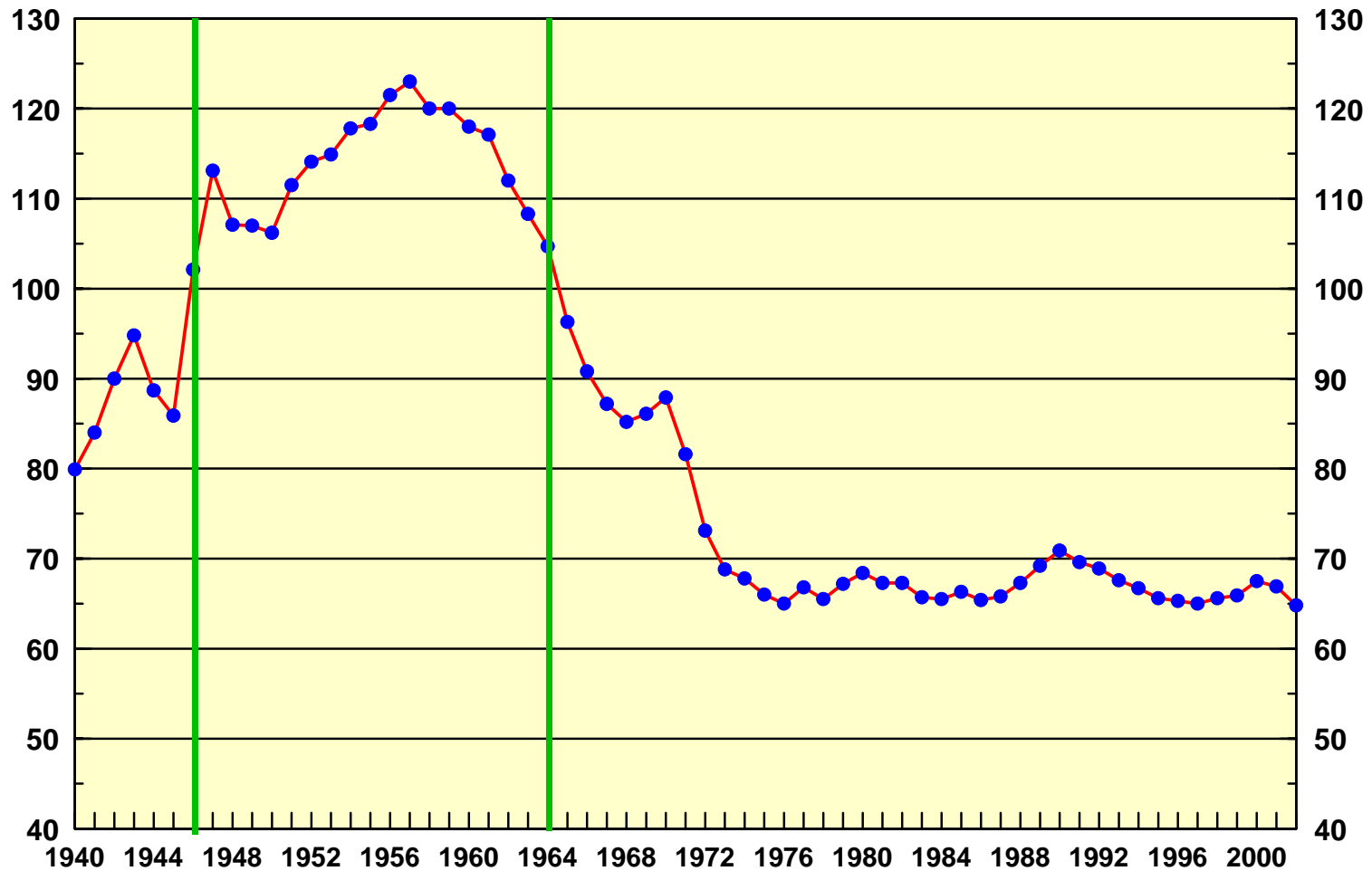

## General Fertility Rate for the United States: 1940 to 2002

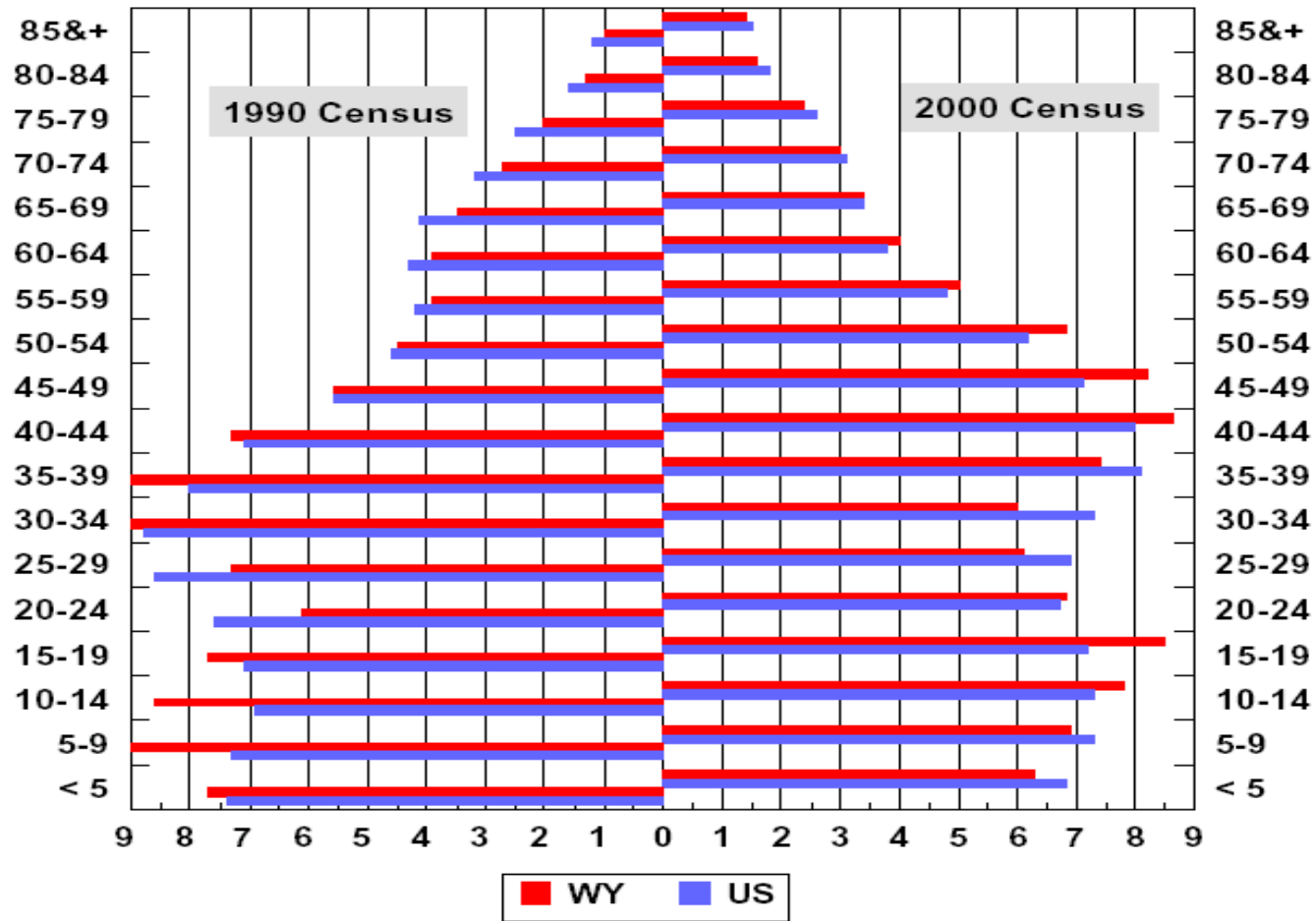
(live births per 1,000 women aged 15-44 years)

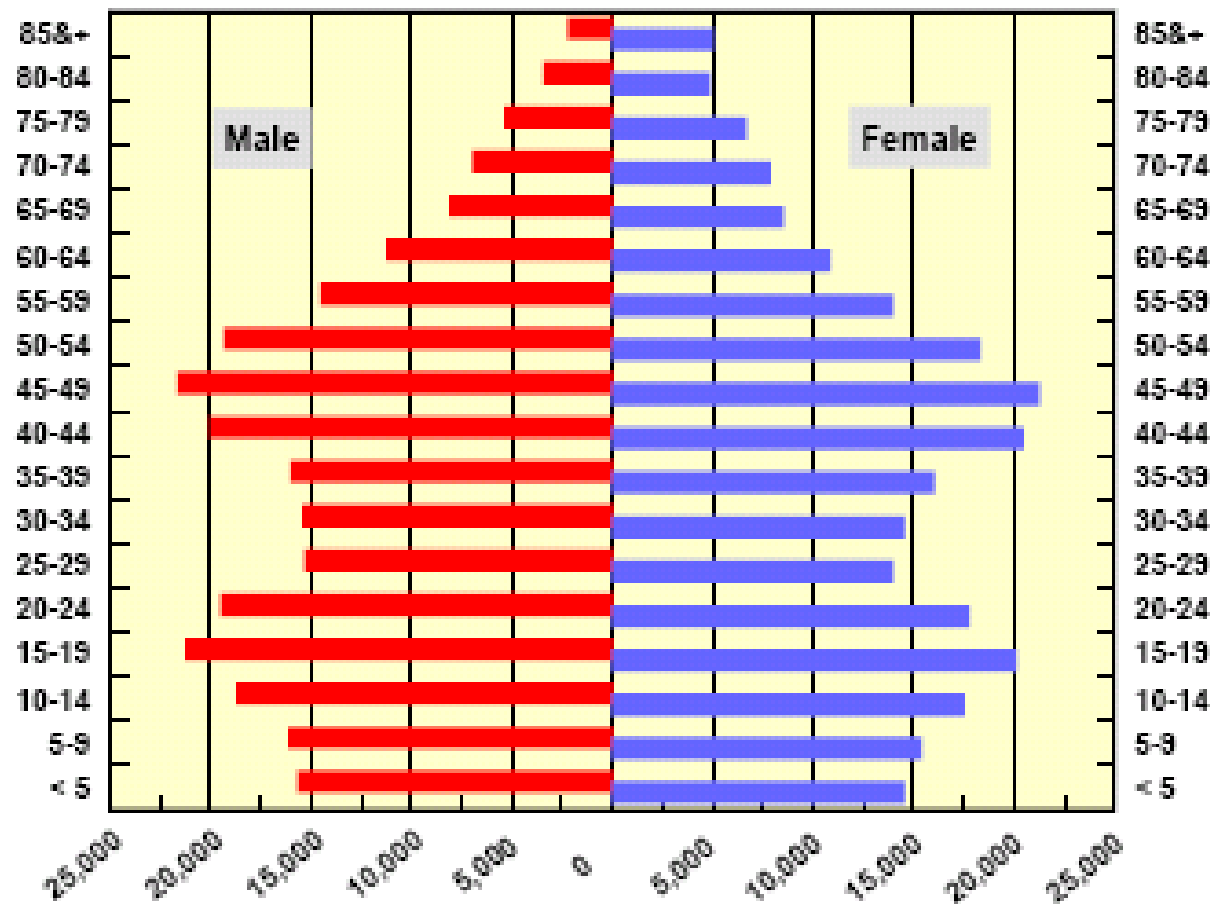
## Population Distribution by Age Group: %

## Population Distribution by Age Group for WY: 2002

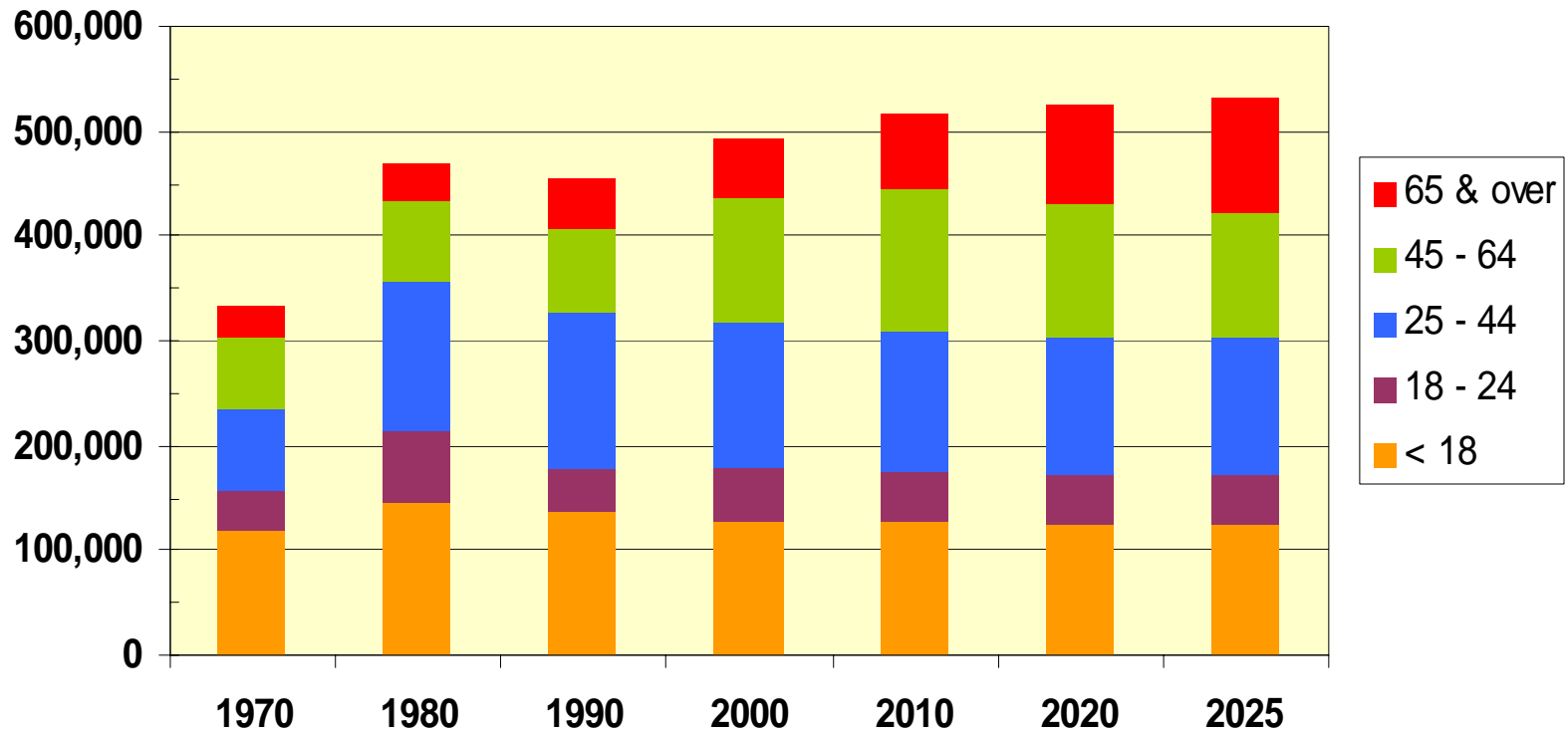

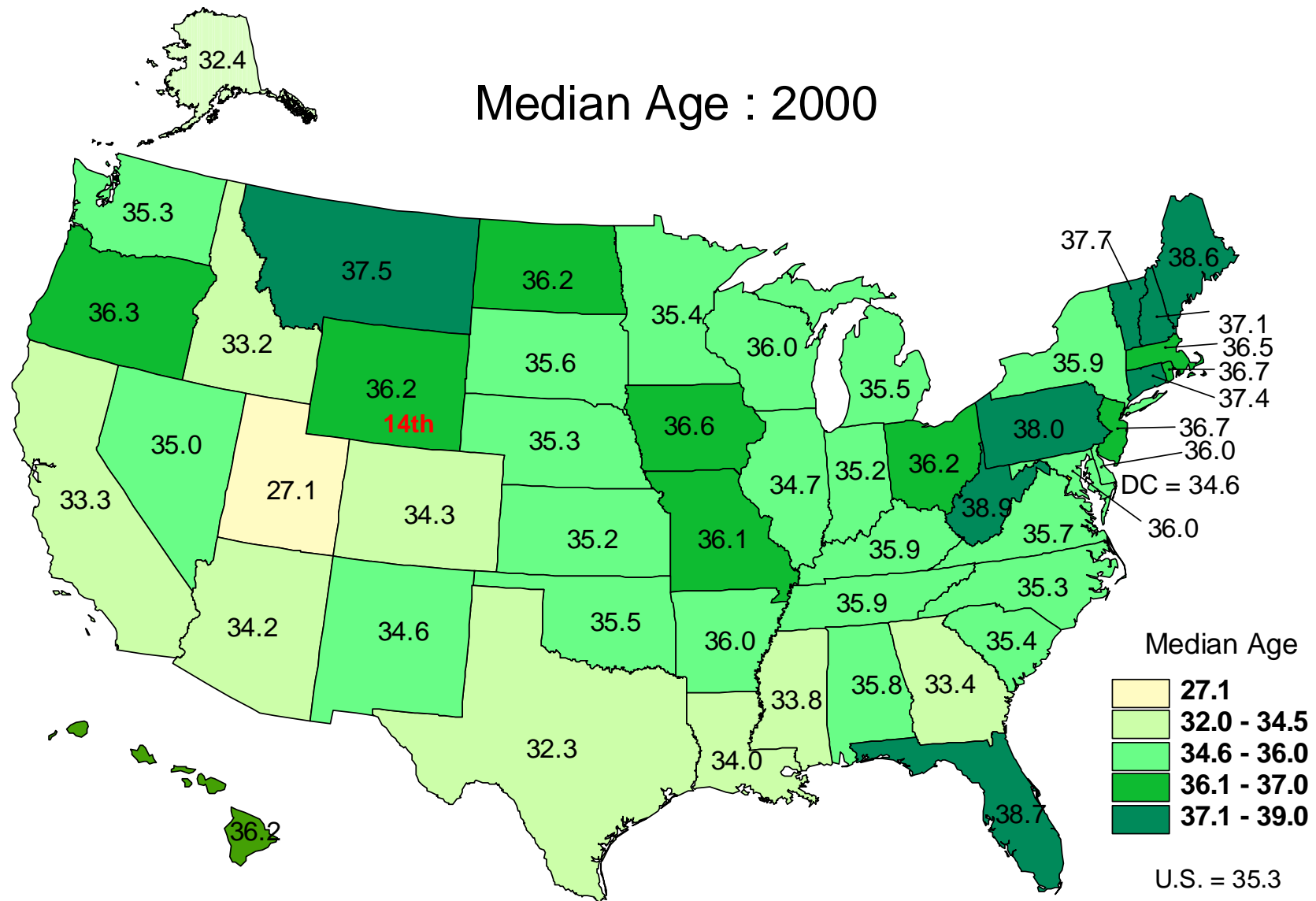


## Wyoming Population by Age Group

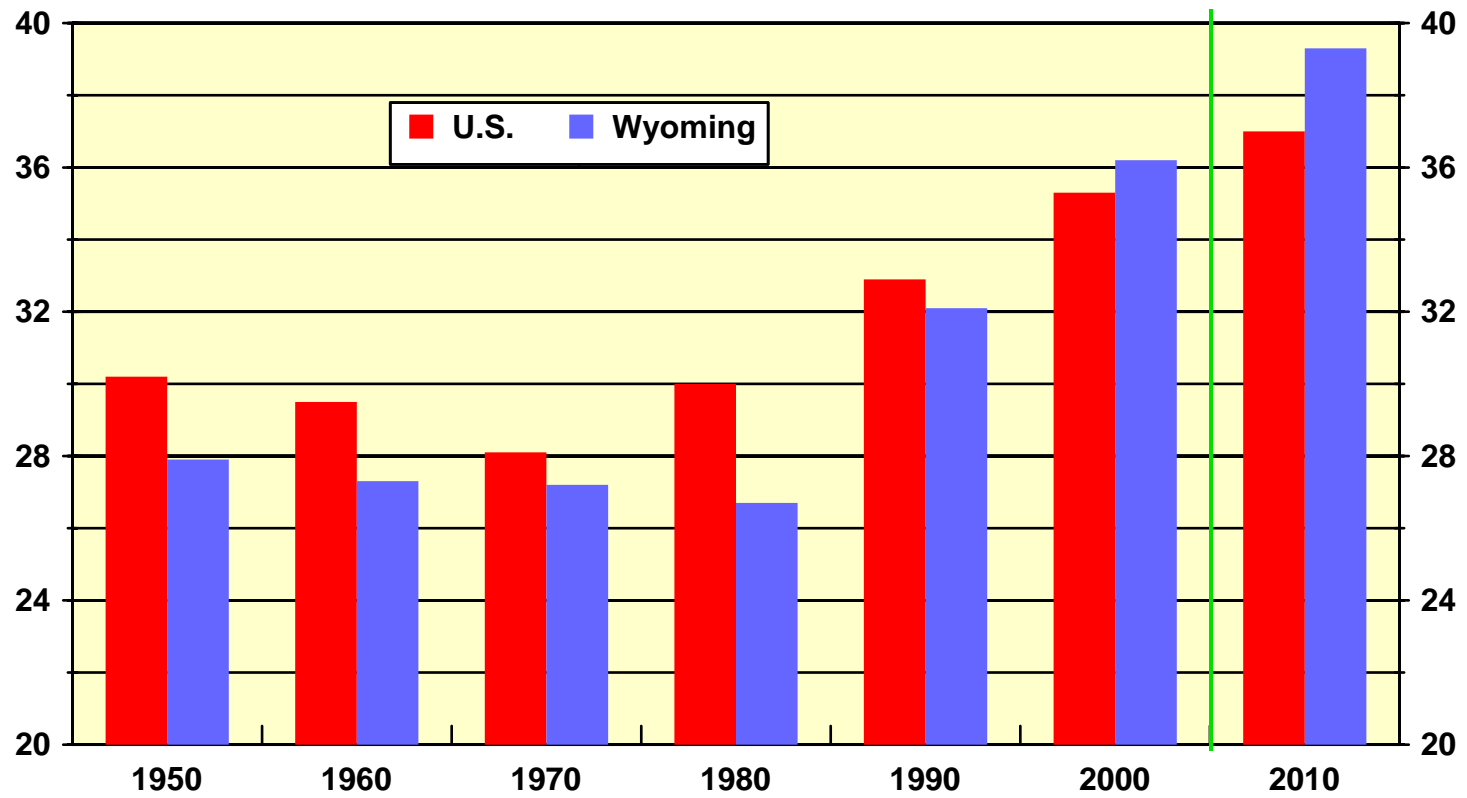
# Median Age : 2000

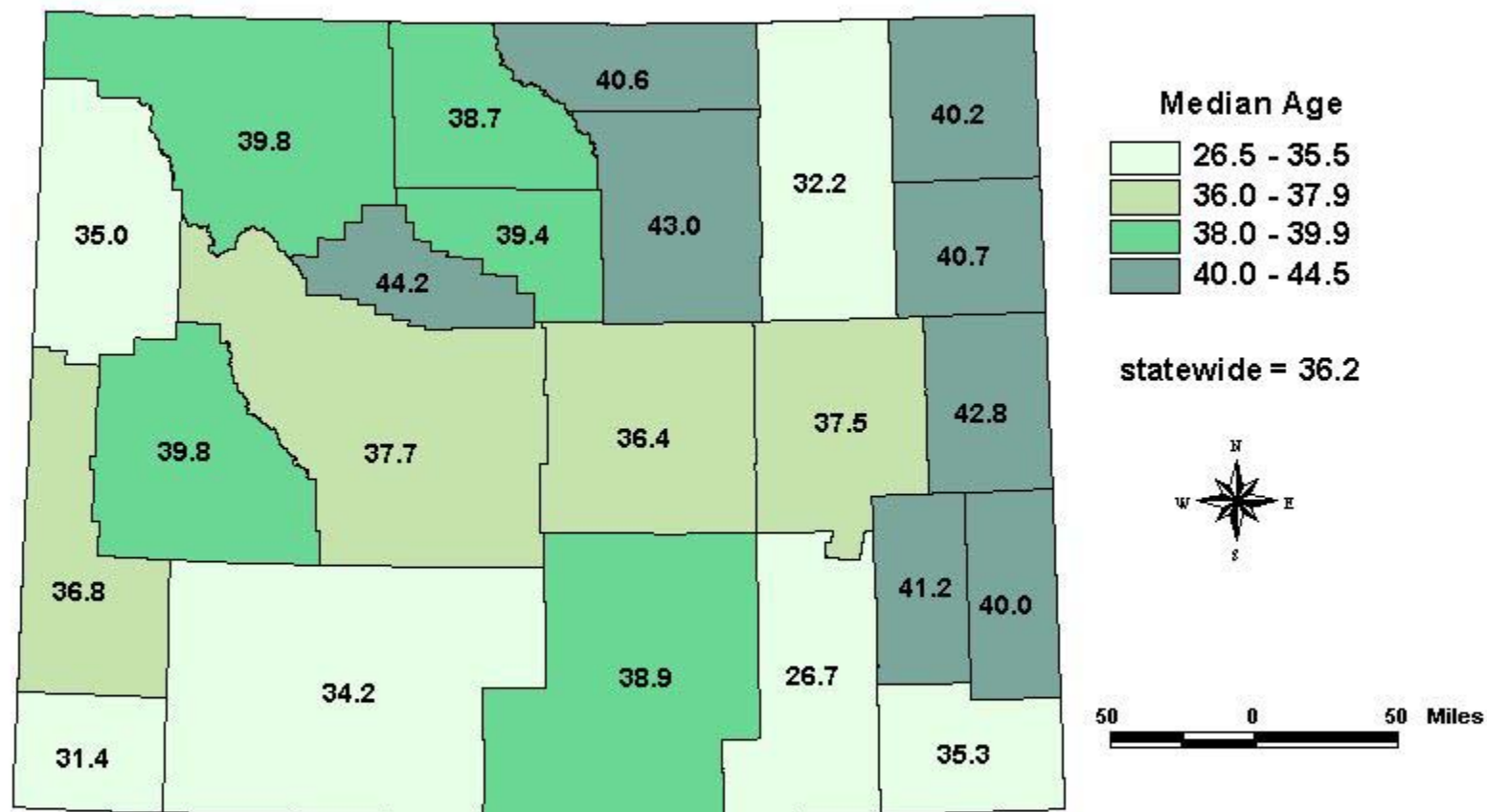

## Median Age by County: 2000

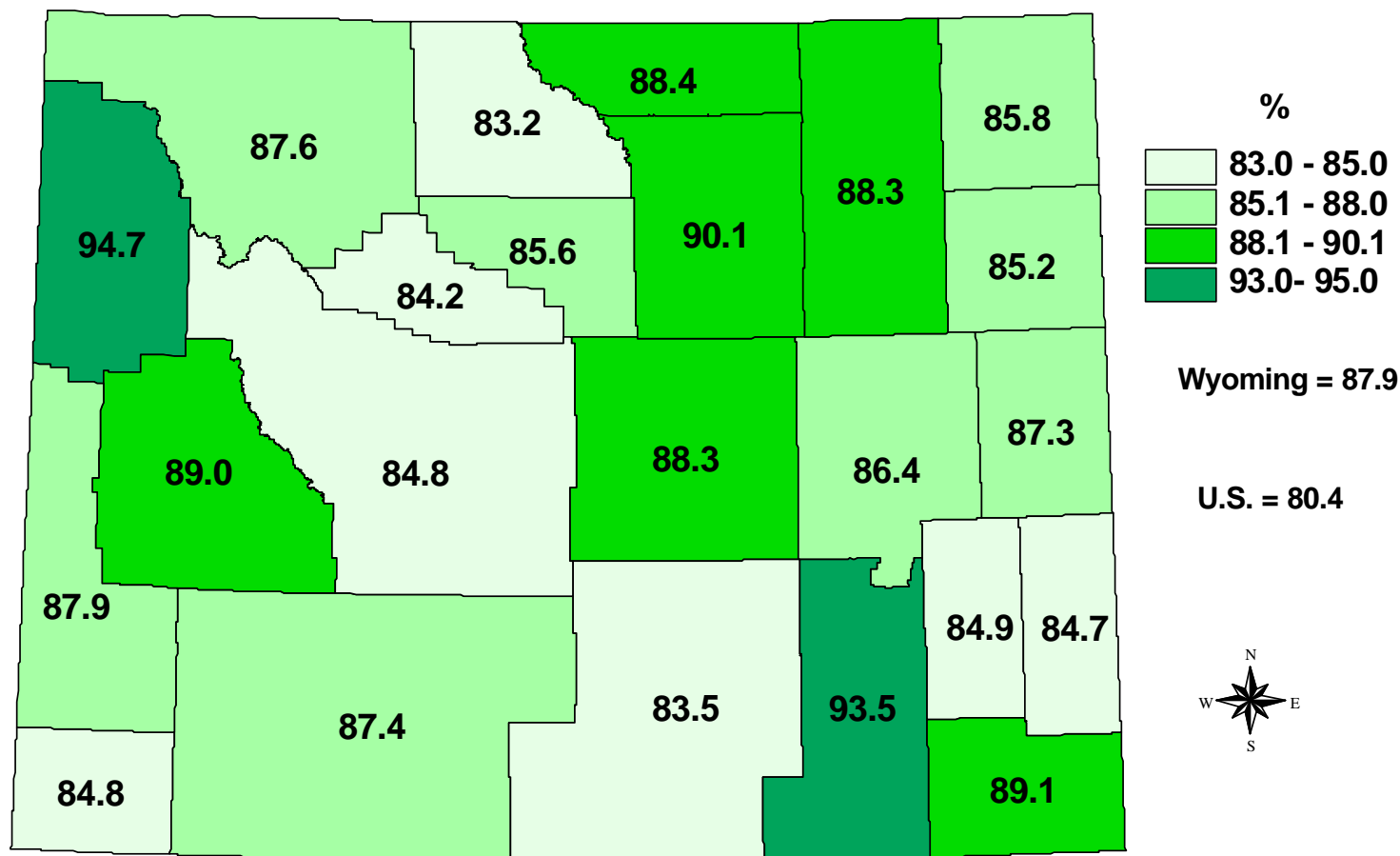

(% with high school graduate or higher)

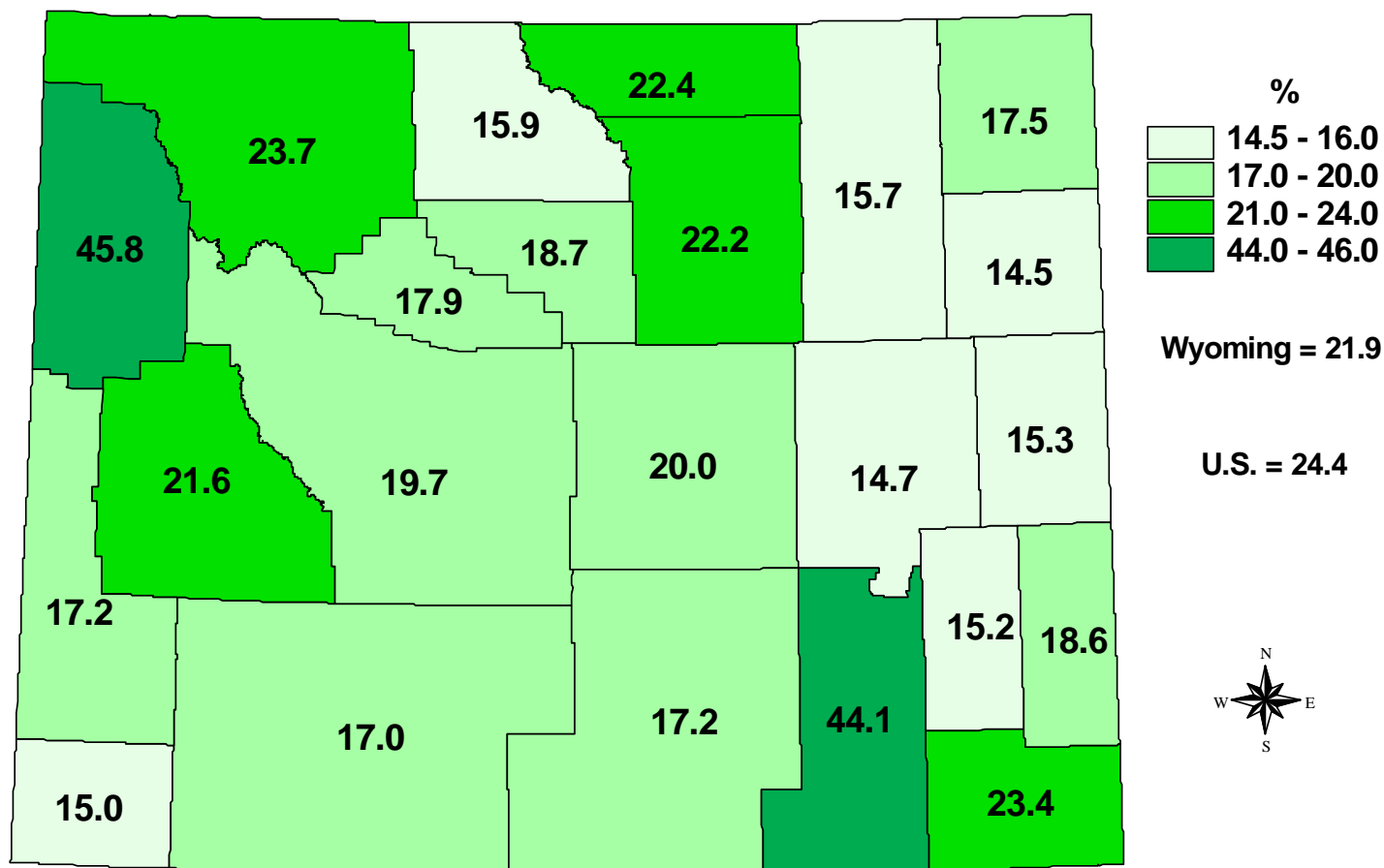

## Educational Attainment for Population 25 Years and Over

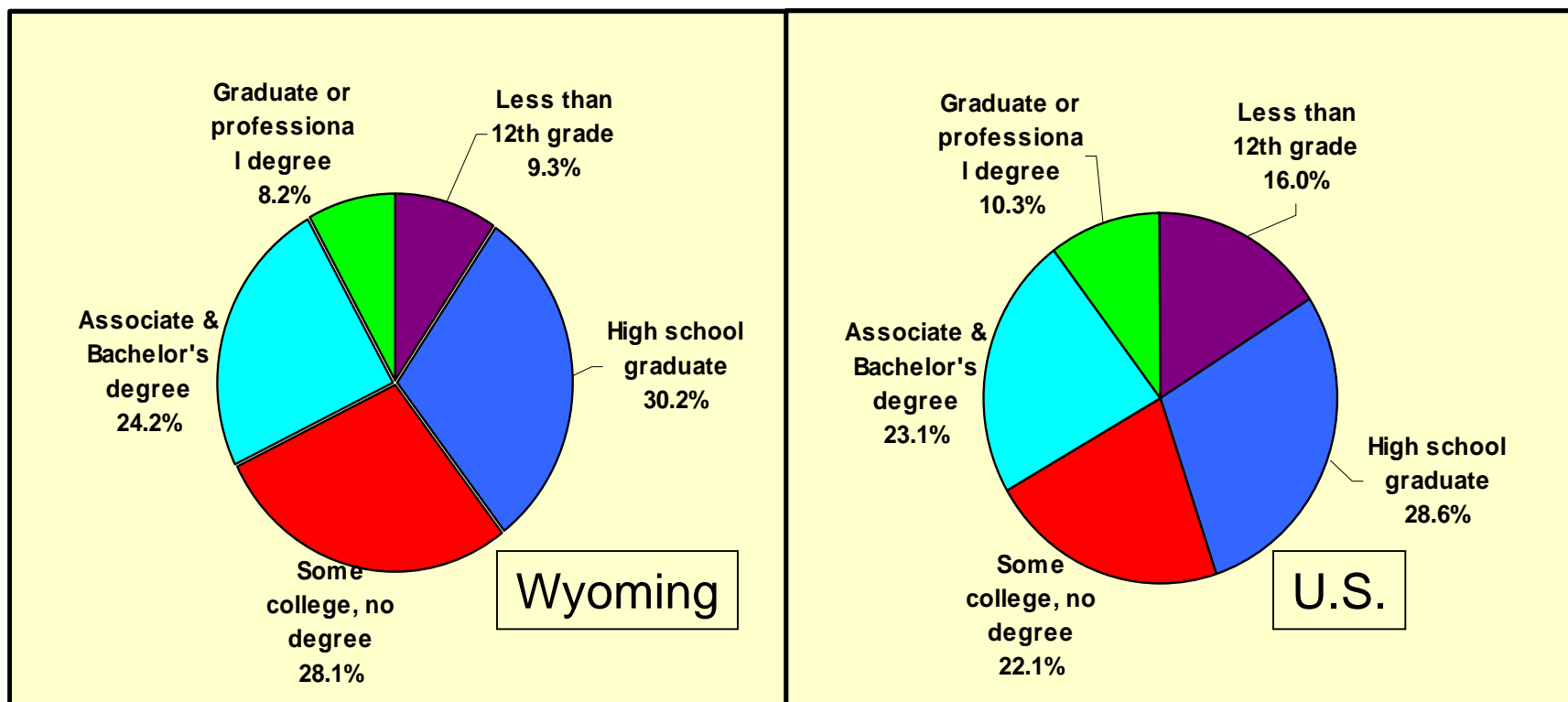
(% with bachelor's degree or higher)

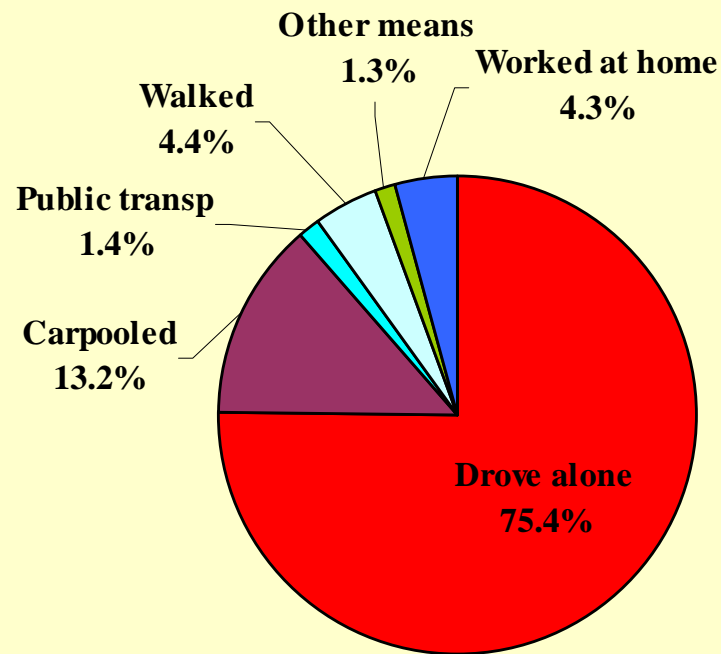
## Educational Attainment for Population Aged 35 to 64 Years: 2000

## Commuting to Work for Workers 16 Years and Over in WY: 2000



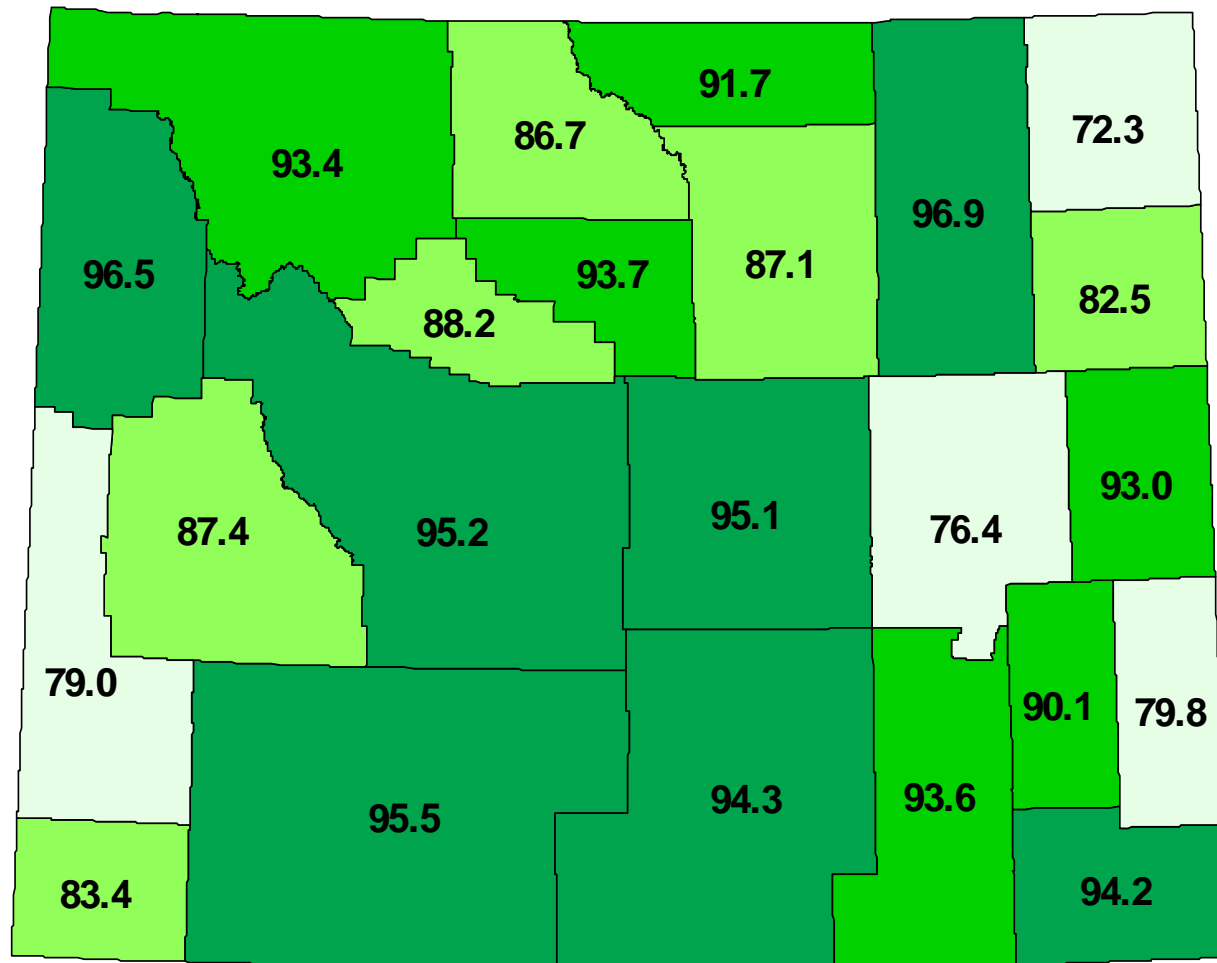

(where county's residents work: %)

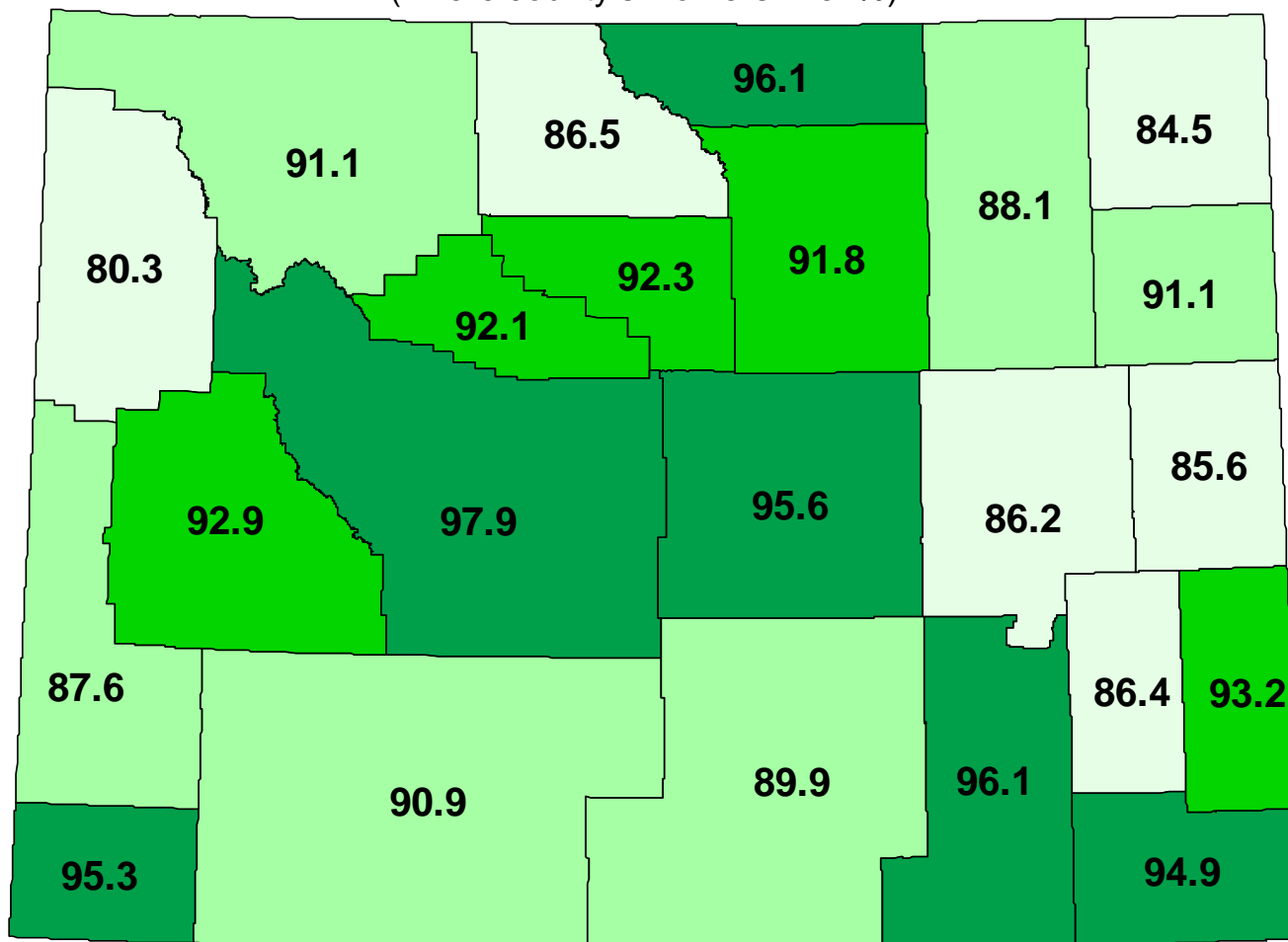

## Residence County to Workplace County Flows: 2000

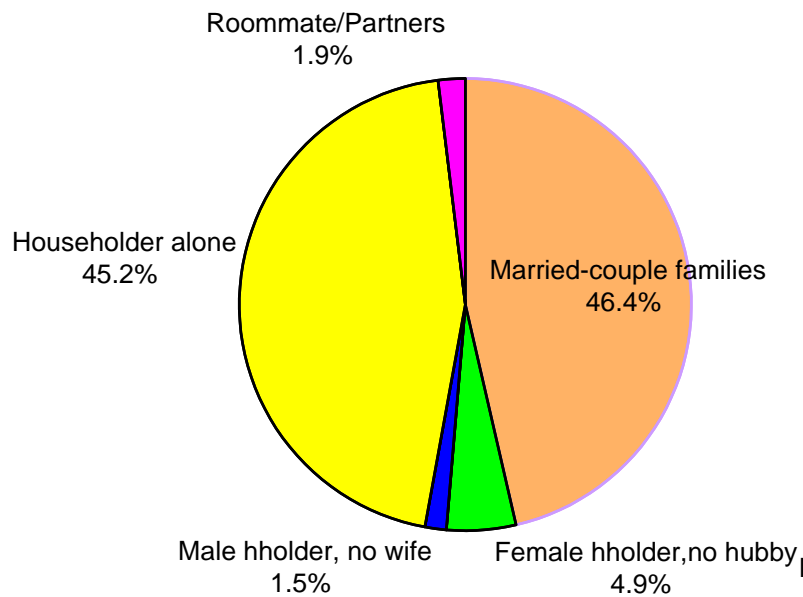
(where county's workers live: %)



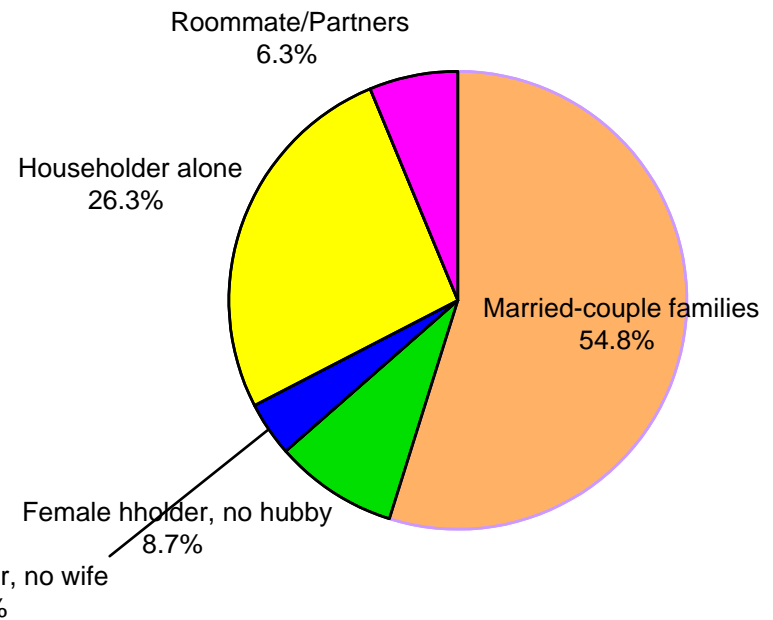

**Householders 65 yrs and over**

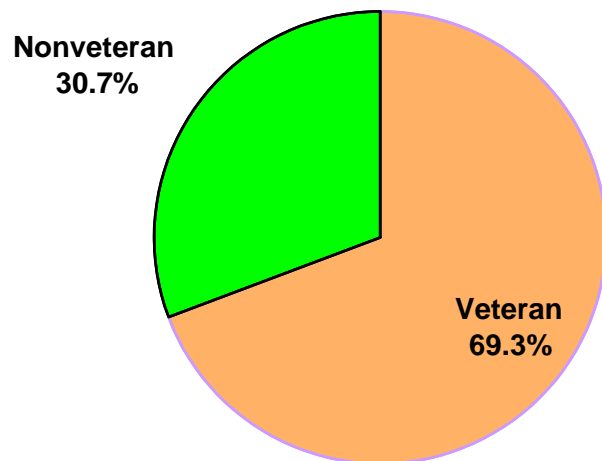

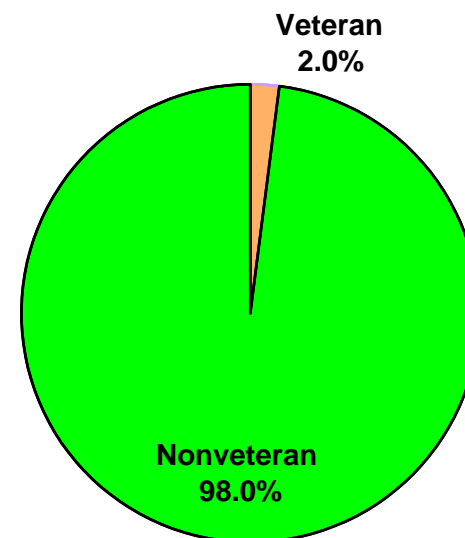

**Male**

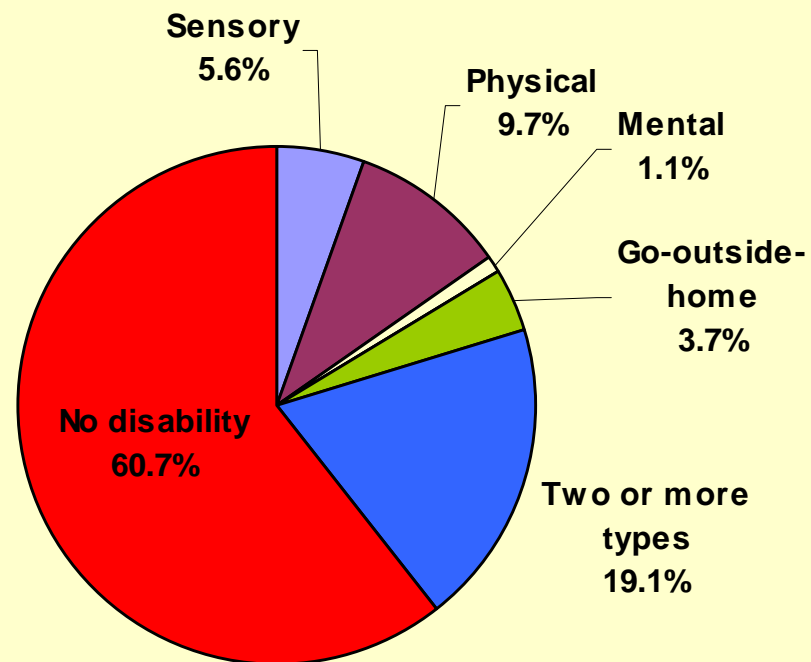

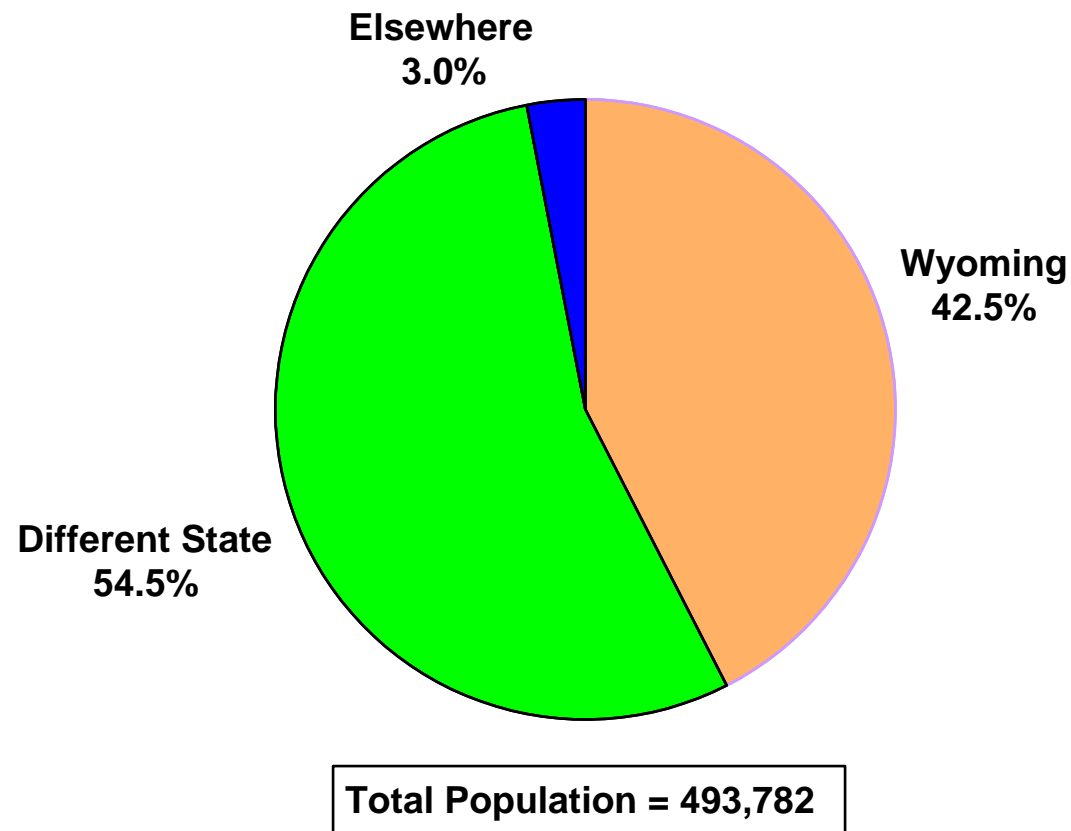
## Disability Status for Population 65 Yrs and Over in WY: 2000

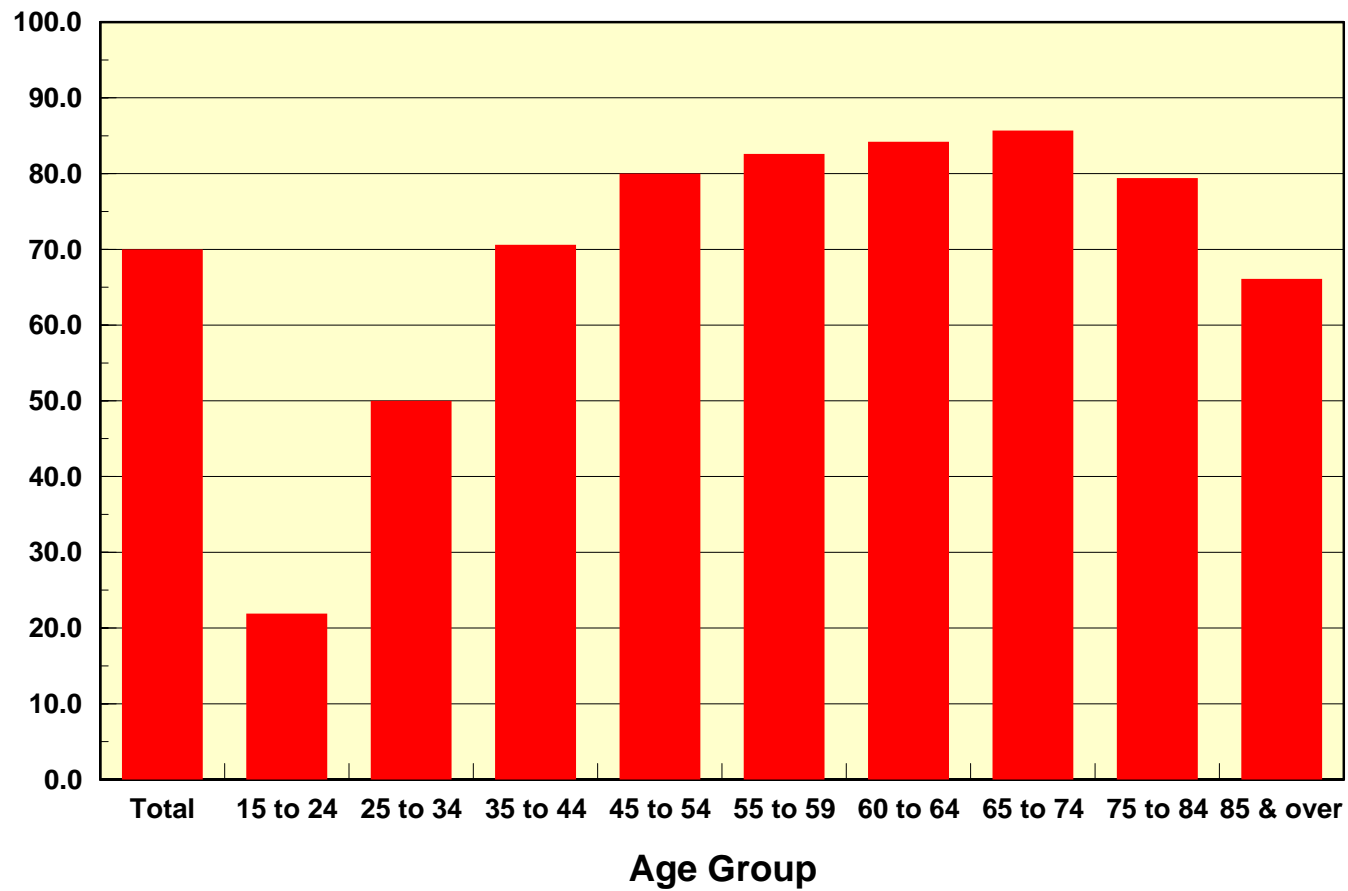
## Place of Birth for Wyoming Residents: 2000

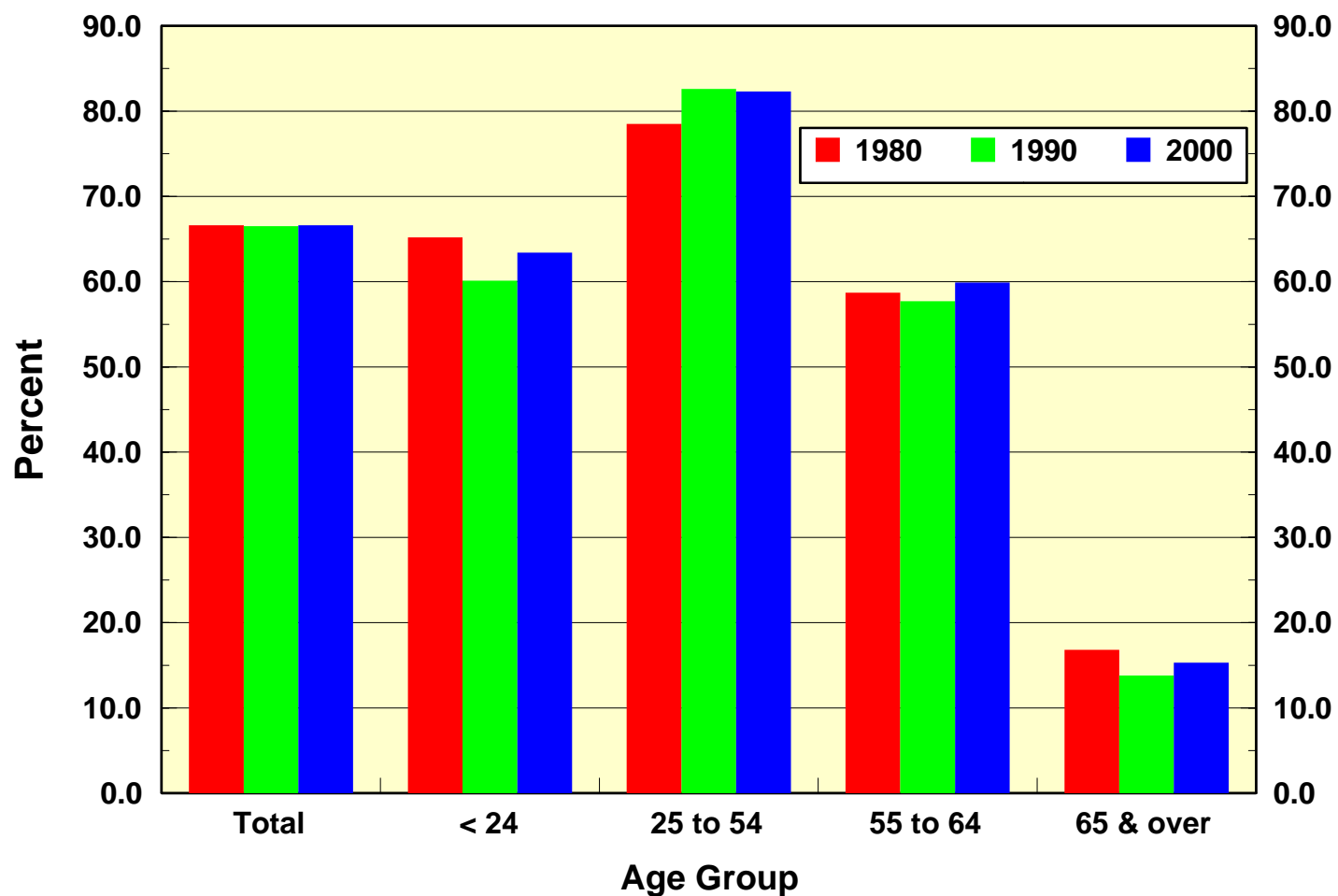
### Homeownership Rate by Age of Householder for WY (%): 2000

### % of Persons 16 Years and Over in Civilian Labor Force

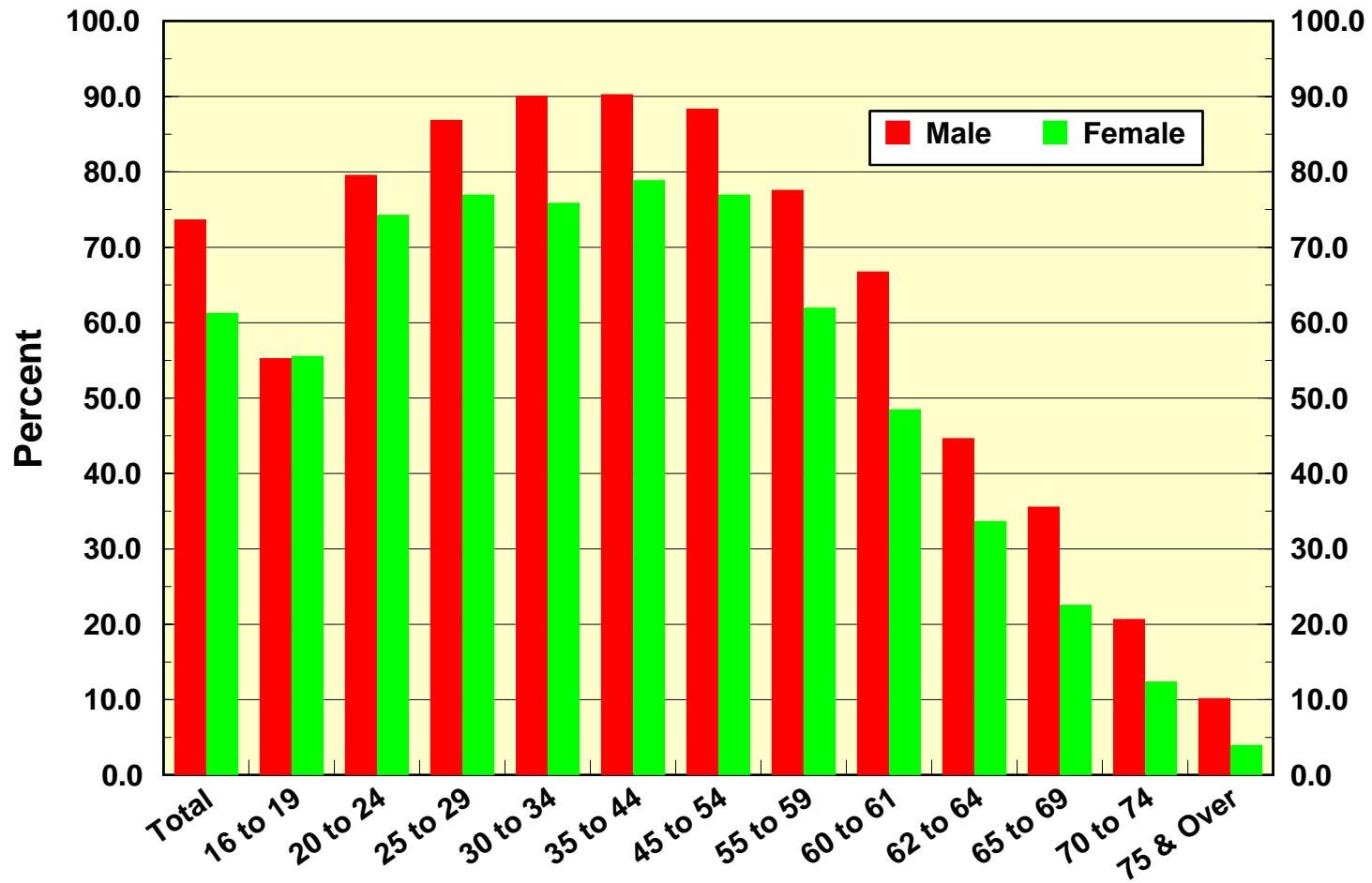

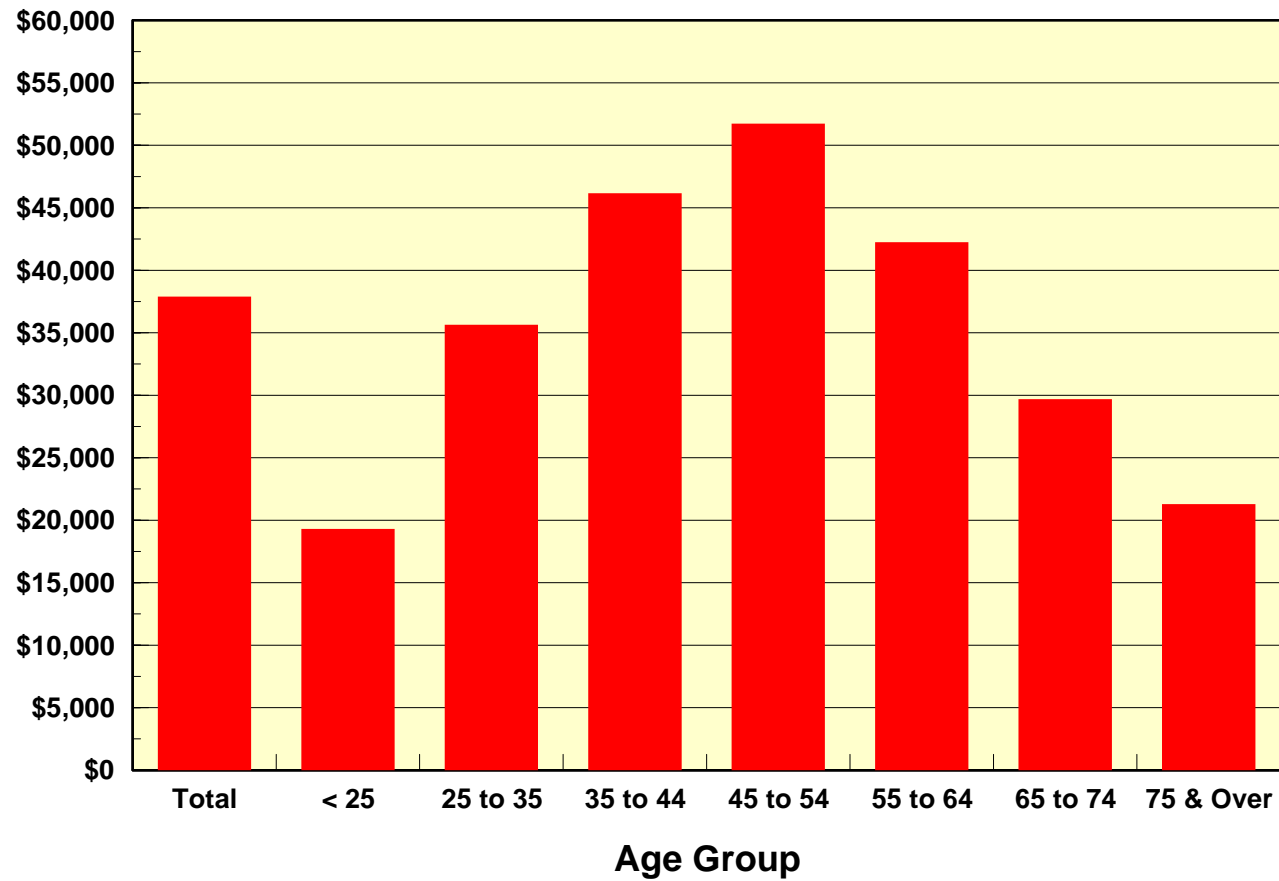
### % of Persons in Civilian Labor Force for Wyoming: 2000

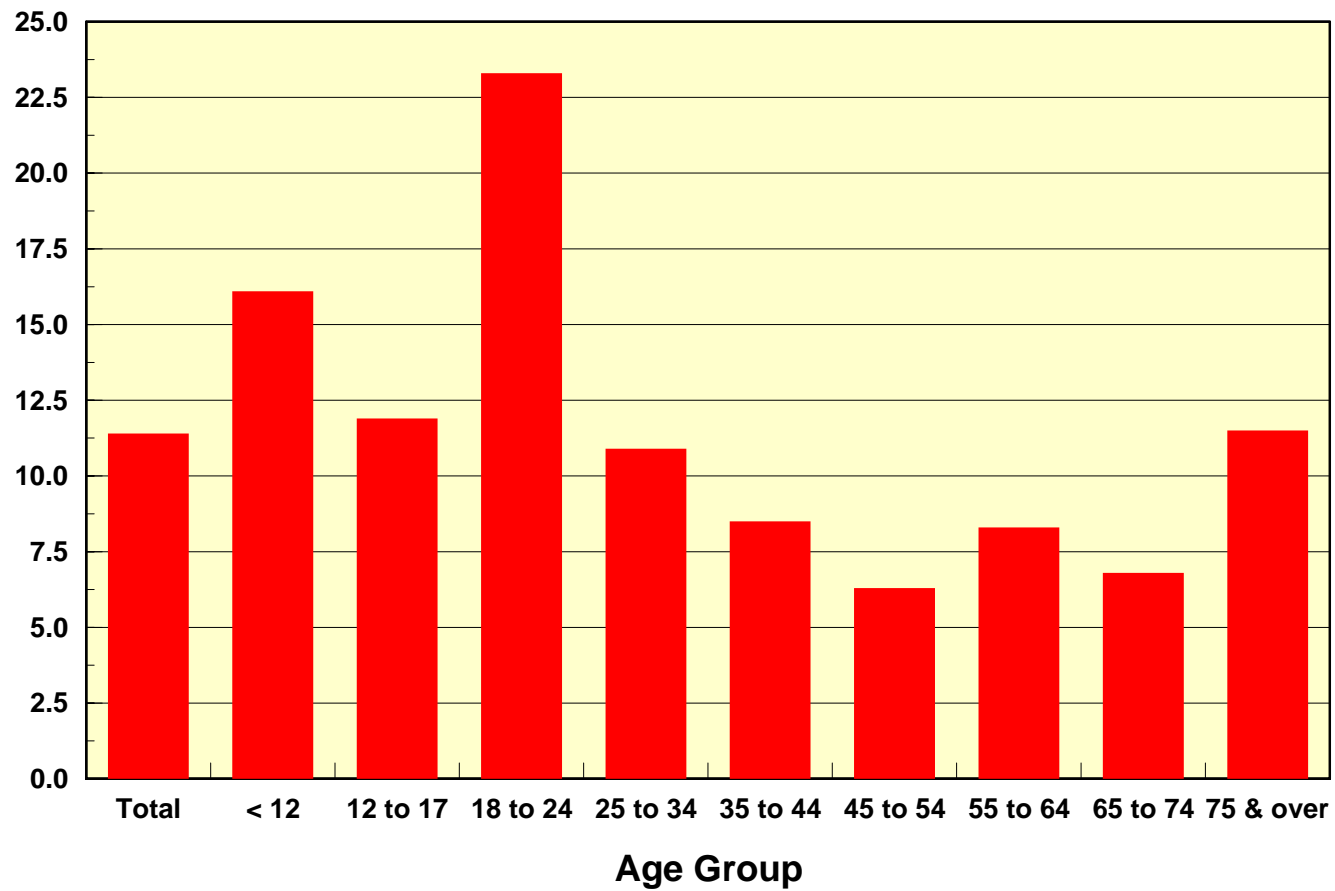
### Median Household Income by Age of Householder for Wyoming: 2000
