Municipalities in Natrona County Gain Population in 2019

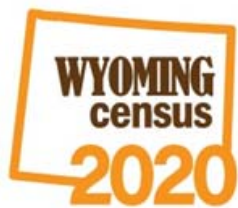
CHEYENNE –The U.S. Census Bureau has released the July 1, 2019 population estimates for incorporated places. These estimates for cities and towns provide a look at how the population has changed since the 2010 Census.

Four Natrona County municipalities were in the top seven rankings by largest percentage increases in population over the year for cities and towns with 2,000 or more population (Bar Nunn, Mills, Casper, and Evansville). Bar Nunn demonstrated the fastest annual growth rate in the State with 2.7%. Casper had the largest numerical increase in the State, 416 residents. This increase in Casper’s population comes after several years of decline. Other cities and towns that are included in the top ten in annual population growth include Douglas, Afton, Glenrock, Cheyenne, Sheridan, and Jackson. The cities and towns that experienced the largest declines in population include Thermopolis (-3.4%), Wheatland (-1.8%), Green River (-1.3%), and Rock Springs (-1.2%). Rock Springs had the largest decrease over the year in the number of residents, -274. The decrease in conventional natural gas drilling in Southwest Wyoming is the main factor for the population declines in Sweetwater County’s large municipalities.

Wyoming’s population grew a moderate 0.2% from 2018 to 2019. This growth occurred after three consecutive years of population decline.
