Bar Nunn's Population Grew the Fastest in 2012

CHEYENNE – The nine most rapidly growing cities and towns (2.6% or higher) between July 1, 2011 and July 1, 2012 are all located in Northeast, Central, and Southwest of Wyoming, according to population estimates released by the U.S. Census Bureau. These estimates provide a look at how much total population has changed in each of Wyoming's incorporated places since the 2010 Census.

After a couple of years of slow population and employment growth, which was caused by the Great Recession, Wyoming's energy driven economy recovered well in 2011 and early months of 2012, particularly in the Northeast and Southwest. However, many rural areas without much mineral extraction continued to experience slower population growth. Mostly affected by the Niobrara Shale oil drilling in the Powder River Basin (mainly in Northern Converse County), the town of Bar Nunn in Natrona County showed the fastest growth, at 7.8 percent. Cheyenne and Casper are still the only cities in the state with population over 50,000, and together they contributed one-third of Wyoming's total population increase during the year.

As of July 1, 2012, 69.7 percent, or 396,195 people in Wyoming lived in incorporated places. Over 45 percent of the State's population lived in nine cities with population of more than 10,000. Overall, Wyoming's population grew by 1.6 percent from July 2011 to July 2012. However, the large cities and towns with population of over 3,000 grew 1.9 percent, slightly faster than the 1.8 percent for all the state's incorporated places. There are 99 cities and towns in Wyoming.
