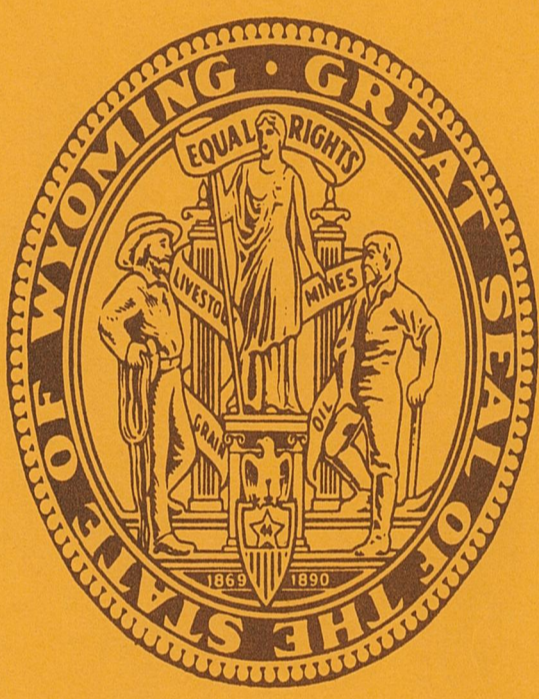

PREFACE

The 1978 Wyoming Tax Revenue Report displays receipts to State funds which are maintained by the State Auditor and selected tax revenues which are collected by the Department of Revenue and Taxation. Although the report accesses information gathered by these agencies, the Division of Research and Statistics is responsible for the tabulations. This edition contains information on the period, fiscal '72 through fiscal '78. The additional tables that present the balance of all funds and receipts to the General Fund have been added for completeness. For example, portions of the tax revenues in Table 3 of Section I are the major source of contributions to the General Fund category 10000. Sales tax figures are cross referenced for place of collection and the 1967 Standard Industrial Classification of the reporting firm. These classifications are explained in the Glossary section. The source reference for the data appears at the end of the tables. Other footnotes are referenced using the British Modern method (eg: (2, 12) implies page 12 of the second Bibliographic citation. WYOMING TAX REVENUE REPORT

One of the best indications of Wyoming's economic progress in recent years is the increasing revenue that has been obtained from the State sales tax. Although some counties have increased the volume of collections by levying an additional 1% optional tax, this accounts for only a portion of the growth rate. For example, in 1972 the collections from retail businesses in the State amounted only to 16 million. For fiscal 1978 tax collections from this group increased over 300% in the six year period. Perhaps the best statistic with which to measure economic progress of this nature would be gross sales and not tax collections. However, this information had not been recorded by the Department of Revenue and Taxation until recently and will not be available until next summer.

This annual issue displays actual sales taxes collected in each county and business or industry group. The Division of Research and Statistics has been publishing these figures since 1973, but only recently has the report contained information for previous years. Currently, sales tax collection is the major emphasis, although other revenues which contribute to the General Fund are also included. Returns for each of these revenue categories are tabulated for the last seven fiscal years. In this manner changes in growth rates can be easily computed and the

contributing factors identified. For example, in Natrona County part of the substantial increase in collections for fiscal 1975 can be attributed to the adoption of the 1% optional tax in December of 1974.

The industry classifications used in Sections II and III represent groupings in accordance with the 1967 Standard Industrial Classification Manual which is published by the Federal Office of Management and Budget. Although the changes in the 1972 revisions were slight, comparisons among states or between Wyoming and National figures would be misleading. This system of reporting is particularly useful in ascertaining business progress; moreover, it also insures that the receipts of an individual firm are not disclosed. Business owners are allowed to class themselves by choosing that sector which contributes the largest revenue to their establishment. Many Wyoming enterprises are so diversified that it would be impossible to second guess the owners' choice. For the definition of the type of firms in these groups refer to the Glossary on page i.

The measurement of Wyoming's economic progress or a specific industry can be obtained from these tax reports by conversion to net taxable sales. This is calculated by dividing each tax collection figure by the appropriate tax rate (see Table 1 for effective rates) for that county. The result is then gross sales less principal exemptions allowed under State statute. Because of these exemptions (see Table 2) the proxy could be defined as a conservatively biased estimate of gross sales.

Another factor which will bias such estimates is the broad categorization of multi-sector businesses under one SIC code. When firms file a

return, no distinction is made among their business sales as to SIC category. Rather the general rule is that the business is categorized under that SIC code which accounts for the largest percentage of that firm's sales. So in many cases estimates will be understated in one sector and overstated in another. While this does not influence the accuracy of the total for either counties or the State, it will obviously have an effect upon estimates for a particular sector.

This information can also be used to forecast expected revenue to the county as a result of the adoption of the optional tax. Since the additional rate raises the effective price of commodities, the growth rate of net taxable sales could be dampened. Therefore, a forecast derived by extending the previous years net taxable sales figure by the historical growth rate and multiplying the result by the effective tax is also biased. By displaying collections for industrial groups the degree to which the additional one cent per dollar effects the buying behavior of Wyomingites can be determined. With collections in some counties as high as 21 million dollars, the additional accuracy in projections could be substantial.

The following tables display collections only for fiscal year periods. However, since the information is stored on magnetic tape and accessed electronically, the information can be tabulated for any time period, broad industrial category and county group. This flexibility is also being applied to the compilation of gross sales which are now being recorded by the Department of Revenue and Taxation. Other economic and demographic data which might be beneficial to individuals, businesses or municipalities is available in similar form including aggregate income

and employment. The information can be obtained free of charge by contacting the Division of Research and Statistics, Room 302 Emerson Building, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002.

GLOSSARY AND BIBLIOGRAPHY

GLOSSARY

AGRICULTURE

This division includes establishments primarily engaged in agricultural production, forestry, commercial fishing, hunting and trapping, and related services. (1, 17)

APPAREL

This major group includes retail stores primarily engaged in selling new clothing, shoes, hats and related articles for personal wear and adornment. (1, 267)

AUTOMOBILE

This major group includes retail dealers selling new and used automobiles, boats, recreational and utility trailers, and motorcycles; those selling new automobile parts and accessories and gasoline service station. However, these collections do not include sales for new and used vehicles, since the County Treasurer collects this tax. (1, 265)

BUILDING AND HARDWARE

This major group includes retail establishments primarily engaged in selling lumber and other building materials; paint; glass and wallpaper; hardware; nursery stock; lawn and garden supplies and mobile homes. (1, 260)

CIGARETTE TAX

(Sec. 39-6-101 to Sec. 39-6-110, W.S. 1977)
This State Cigarette Tax, which was created in 1951, is levied only on cigarettes. The rate is eight cents per package; however, wholesalers are allowed a six percent discount for administrative costs. The collections are distributed between the State General Fund and the local jurisdiction where the collections occurred.
(4, 2)

CONSTRUCTION

This division includes establishments primarily engaged in construction, which is defined to include new work, additions, alterations and repairs. (1, 45)

COAL EXCISE TAX

(Sec. 39-6-301 to 39-6-307, W.S. 1977)

This excise tax is levied against the gross value of production of all coal which is produced in a calendar year. The rate changed from 1.6% in 1977 to 2% in 1978 and will continue until January 1 following the year in which aggregate revenues exceed 160 million dollars. This tax, which was passed by the 43rd Legislature, was designed to aid community development in coal areas and; therefore, the collections are deposited in the coal tax revenue account and distributed by the Wyoming Farm Loan Board. (4, 3)

FINANCE

This division includes establishments operating primarily in the fields of finance, insurance and real estate. (1, 277)

FOOD STORES

This major group includes retail stores primarily engaged in selling food for home preparation and consumption. (1, 263)

FURNITURE

This major group includes retail stores selling goods used for furnishing the home such as furniture, floor coverings, drapes and electrical and gas appliances. (1, 269)

GASOLINE TAX

(Sec. 39-6-201 to 39-6-214, W.S. 1977)

The State Gasoline Tax, which was created in 1923, is levied against the volume of gasoline used within the State. The Aviation Gas Tax, which is levied on gasoline for use in operating aircraft, is similar to this tax. The former rate is eight cents per gallon and the later is four cents per gallon. The gasoline tax collections are distributed among the Wyoming Highway Department, The State General Fund and the county or municipal jurisdiction. A refund of two cents per gallon on purchases of 10,000 gallons or more is authorized the user of gasoline for aircraft use. Exemptions for the gasoline tax are provided for sales to the U.S. Government if a single delivery for export exceeds 300 gallons.

GENERAL MERCHANDISE

This major group includes retail outlets such as department stores, variety stores and general merchandise stores which sell a number of lines of merchandise such as dry goods, apparel, accessories, furniture and home furnishings, small wares, hardware and food. (1, 262)

INHERITANCE TAX

(Sec. 39-6-801 to 39-6-808, W.S. 1977)

The Inheritance Tax, which was enacted on February 21, 1903, is levied on all tangible and intangible personal property within the State or belonging to a Wyoming descendent. The tax rate is based on the descendent's relationship to the beneficiary. An additional tax is imposed to offset credits which are allowed as deductions from federal estate taxes. (4, 7). For more specific information see either citation two or four.

MANUFACTURING

The manufacturing division includes all establishments such as plants, factories, and mills engaged in the mechanical or chemical transformation of materials or substances into new products. (1, 57)

MINERAL SEVERANCE TAX

(Sec. 39-6-301 to 39-6-307, W.S. 1977)

The tax is levied on the cash market value of specified minerals and valuable deposits after the mining or production process is completed. The particular rate varies with the type of deposit. The distribution of collections also varies among the State funds (General, Trust and Agency, Capitol Facilities, etc.) with the type of deposit.

MINING

This division includes all establishments primarily engaged in mining. Mining is here used in the broad sense to include the extraction of solid and gaseous minerals occurring naturally as well as other preparation customarily done at the mine site, or as a part of mining activity. (1, 31)

MISCELLANEOUS STORES

This major group includes retail establishments not elsewhere classified such as drug stores, liquor stores and used merchandise stores. (1, 272)

MOTOR CARRIER TAX

(Sec. 31-4-201 to 31-4-210, W.S. 1977)

This tax, which includes compensatory fees, penalties and tow bar permits, is levied on vehicles carrying freight, express or passengers. For information on exemptions, rates and distribution refer to the Wyoming Tax Summary.

PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

This division includes the legislative, judicial, administrative and regulatory activities of Federal, State, Local and international governments. Also, nonclassifiable establishments have been placed in this category.

RESTAURANTS

This major group includes retail establishments selling prepared foods and drinks for consumption on the premises, and also lunch counters and refreshment stands selling prepared foods and drinks for immediate consumption. (1, 271)

RETAIL TRADE

This division includes establishments engaged in selling merchandise for personal or household consumption and rendering services incidental to the sale of the goods. (1, 259)

SALES TAX

(Sec. 39-6-401 to 39-6-417, W.S. 1977)

This tax is levied on the gross receipts from the sale of tangible personal property and specified services. For a listing of exemptions and rates refer to the introduction. The collections are distributed between the State General Fund and local jurisdictions. (2, 36)

SERVICES

This division includes establishments primarily engaged in providing a wide variety of services (ie. such as legal, health and repair) for individuals, business and government establishments, and other organizations. (1, 295)

TRANSPORTATION

This division includes establishments providing to the general public or to other business enterprises, passenger and freight transportation, communication services, electricity, gas, steam water or sanitary services, and the U.S. Postal Service. (1, 219)

USE TAX

(Sec. 39-6-501 to 39-6-603, W.S. 1977)

The Use Tax is levied upon tangible personal property that is purchased from an out-of-state vendor and shipped directly to the purchaser for storage, use or consumption in the state. Freight and property in interstate transportation is exempted. The rate is fixed at three percent and the collections are distributed between the State General Fund and local jurisdictions. (4, 14)

WHOLESALE TRADE

This division includes establishments or places of business primarily engaged in selling merchandise to retailers or acting as agents or brokers in buying merchandise for or selling merchandise to retailers. (1, 241)
