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PREFACE

The 1986 edition of the Wyoming Sales and Use Tax Revenue Report contains tax collection information by Standard Industrial Classification. In addition, sales tax collections for the retail sector, broken down into eight major categories, are provided. This report covers the activity of fiscal years 1975-1986 for sales tax collections and fiscal years 1981-1986 for use tax collections. The information is provided by the Department of Revenue and Taxation and compiled for publication into report form by the Division of Research and Statistics, Department of Administration and Fiscal Control.

State sales and use tax collections are two major sources of income to state and local governments; however, their importance does not stop there. These two revenue sources, when examined over time, provide a valuable indication of economic growth and activity, both at the state and county level.

SALES TAX

The state imposed sales tax, since 1967, has been 3 percent. This tax is shared between state government (2/3) and the county of origin (1/3). Distribution of the county's share to the municipalities is based upon population. The State's share is placed in the General Fund to meet state operating expenses. The significance of this tax is evident in Table 1 and Figure 1.

Since 1973, the counties are allowed to impose an optional 1 percent sales tax through public election. Currently, those counties not engaging in the additional sales tax option are: Albany, Big Horn, Fremont, Goshen, Park, Platte, Sheridan, Sublette, and Washakie. The optional sales tax is returned to the county and utilized through their general revenue fund. The effective date of each county's optional tax is found in Table 2. To arrive at an estimate of county gross sales, divide the specific county tax collection by the corresponding tax rate. This method provides only an estimate of gross sales since it does not account for non-taxed sales. (Table 3 lists all taxable events and exemptions). Despite this limitation,

information provided by sales tax collections is valuable for analyzing trends and the direction of Wyoming's economy.

In addition to the authority to impose an optional 1 percent sales tax (as mentioned earlier) any county through public election, may impose an excise tax of up to 1 percent on retail sales made within the county. The revenue from the tax is used only for the planning, construction, furnishing, equipping and debt service for any capital improvement project authorized through public election. Currently, those counties that have imposed a 1 percent capital improvement tax are: Teton and Laramie. (See Table 2)

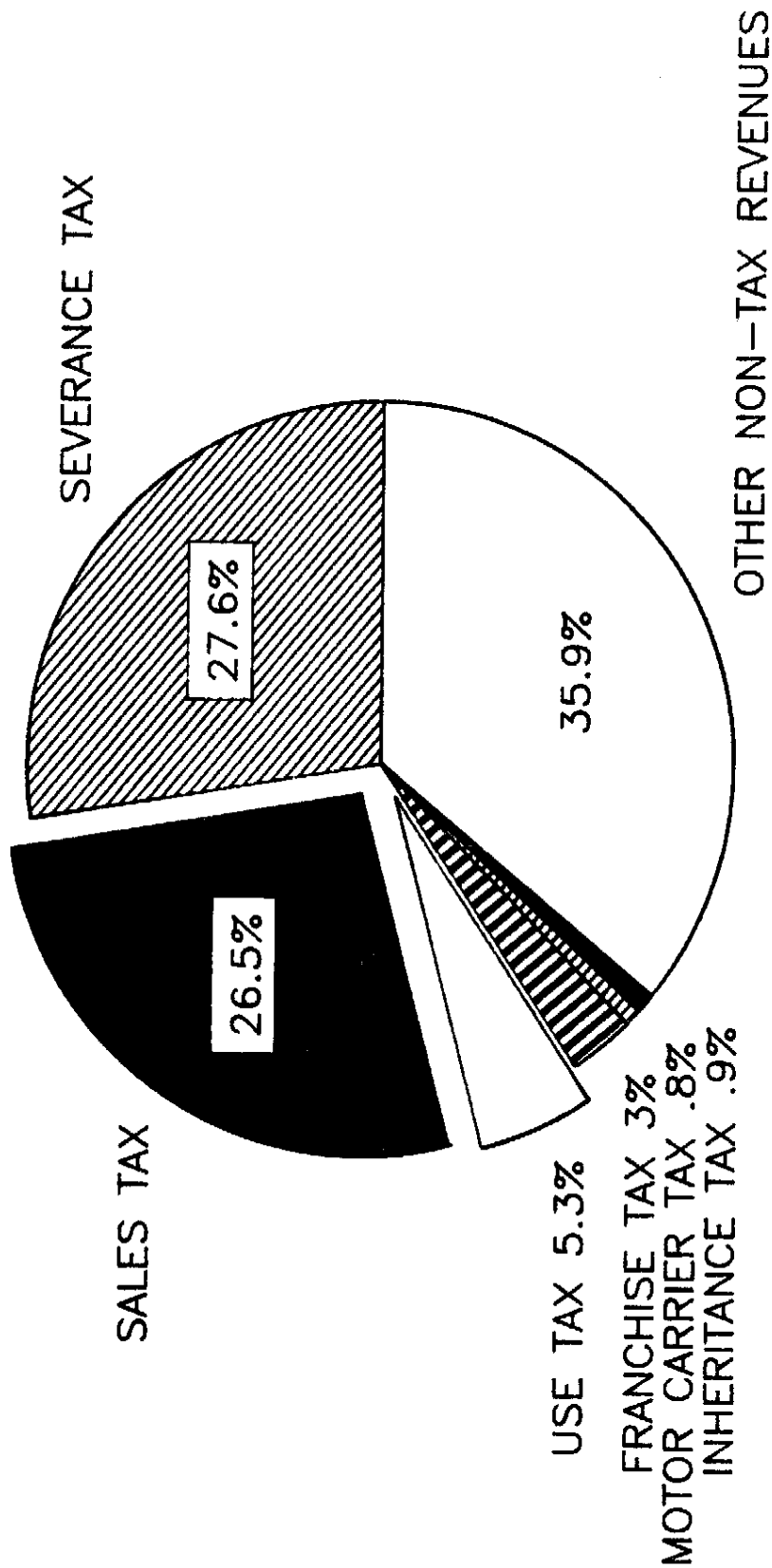
USE TAX

State use tax is imposed on purchases made outside a taxing jurisdiction for first use, storage or other consumption within that taxing jurisdiction. Thus, the use tax prevents a person from avoiding sales tax or paying a lower tax rate by making purchases outside of the taxing jurisdiction where first county use, storage or other consumption will occur. Wyoming taxing jurisdictions are the State of Wyoming and/or each Wyoming county. The use tax complements the sales tax. Effective January 1, 1981, the adoption of an optional sales tax also includes an increase in the use tax of equal amount. State use tax is shared between State government and the county of origin on the same basis as sales tax.

Sales and use tax collection data are supplied by the State of Wyoming Department of Revenue and Taxation and compiled by the Division of Research and Statistics, Department of Administration and Fiscal Control. This report contains

twelve fiscal years of sales tax collections and six years of use tax collections. The State of Wyoming's fiscal year runs from July 1 through June 30. This report also details collections by major industrial sectors for sales and use tax at both the state and county level. A detailed breakdown of the retail sector for sales tax has been provided as well. The reporting of tax collections is based upon the Standard Industrial Classification (SIC), devised by the Federal Office of Management and Budget. Under this system a business is classified by its primary activity, determined by its principle product or group of products produced, distributed and/or services rendered. Each sector classification is described in the glossary.

* The option tax was first effective December 1, 1976. The 4% rate was in effect until December 31, 1978. The question on the ballot to continue the tax was defeated at the General Election of 1978. The 3% rate was in effect from January 1, 1979 through December 31, 1979. The option question was presented again at a Special Election in 1979 and the 4% rate was again in effect from January 1, 1980 through December 31, 1980. The question to continue was once again defeated at the General Election in 1980. January 1, 1981 the 3% rate became effective.

** The question on the ballot to continue the tax was defeated at the General Election of 1984. The 3% rate was effective July 1, 1985.

*** The 1984 Session of the Legislature provided the counties with the ability, by election, to impose an optional sales tax for the express purpose of capital construction. Teton County voters elected on August 20, 1985 to impose this tax effective January 1, 1986. Laramie County followed with an effective date of April 1, 1986.

TABLE 3

TAXABLE EVENTS AND EXEMPTIONS

Wyoming Statute 39-6-404 describes the following sales and services as taxable events:

1. Retail sales of tangible personal property within the state.
2. Leases of tangible personal property if the property would have been taxable, had it been sold.
3. Telephone and telegraph services, and the equipment used to carry out such services.
4. Intrastate transportation of passengers.
5. Sales by public utilities and by those furnishing gas, electricity, or heat for domestic, industrial or commercial consumption.
6. Meals regularly served to the public, and cover charges.
7. Lodging services, e.g., motels, hotels.
8. Admissions to amusements or athletic events.
9. Repair, alteration or improvement of tangible personal property.
10. Contract seismographic surveying, contract geophysical surveying and other contract geophysical exploration operations calculated to reveal the existence of geologic conditions favorable to the accumulation of oil or gas, and for all services rendered in and all types of coring, logging, testing, stimulating, perforating, cementing, completing, recompleting or attempting to complete any well for production of oil or gas.
11. Sales of automobiles, mobile homes, campers, semitrailers.
12. Sales of alcoholic beverages.

Wyoming Statute 39-6-402 (a) (iv) defines "Sales price" as the consideration paid by the purchaser of tangible personal property excluding the actual trade-in value allowed on property exchanged at the time of transaction, admissions or services which are subject to taxation as provided by this article and excluding any taxes imposed by the federal government or this article.

Wyoming Statute 39-6-405 governs exemptions from our state sales tax. Exemptions include:

1. Sales of tangible personal property to a person engaged in manufacturing, if such property becomes an ingredient or component of the item manufactured. Sales of containers, labels, etc. are also exempt.
2. Sales of livestock, feeds for feeding livestock for marketing purposes; seeds, roots, bulbs, small plants, and fertilizer, planted or applied to land, the products of which are to be sold.
3. Intrastate transportation of sick, injured and deceased persons by ambulance or hearse.
4. Intrastate transportation of employees when the transportation is paid for by the employer.
5. Intrastate transportation of raw farm products to processing plants.
6. Interstate transportation of freight and passengers.

7. Sales of energy if the energy is consumed directly in manufacturing, processing or agriculture.
8. Sales of the services of professional engineers.
9. Sales which are subject to a federal excise tax in excess of 20%.
10. Sales of tangible personal property which is subject to a state excise tax in excess of 5%.
11. Sales to the U.S. Government.
12. Sales made to the State of Wyoming or its political subdivisions.
13. Sales made to a religious or charitable organization.
14. Sales of trucks, etc., to holders of a valid I.C.C. permit, provided they are used substantially in interstate commerce.
15. Occasional sales made by religious or charitable institutions for fund raising purposes.
16. Sales which Wyoming is forbidden to tax, either by the State or by the laws or constitution of the United States.
17. Sales of prescription drugs, oxygen for medical use, plasma, prosthetic devices, hearing aids, crutches, wheelchairs, eyeglasses and contact lenses, insulin for human relief, and any syringe, needle or device for the administration thereof.
18. Leases of vehicle if the lease is computed from gross receipts of the operation, for holders of valid I.C.C. permits.
19. Wholesale sales.
20. Intrastate transportation of freight.

SUMMARY OF SALES TAX COLLECTIONS

Total state sales tax collections for the past twelve years are summarized in this section to show general trends. As shown in Figure 2, total sales tax collections peaked in 1982 at \$227,011,946. Since that time, sales tax collections have hovered around the \$185 to \$191 million range, alternating up and down each year. The fiscal 1986 collections, at \$185,769,412, represented a 2.8 percent decline from a year earlier. Table 4 presents the data that were graphed in Figure 2, along with the total sales tax collections from each county. The counties which experienced sales growth during the past fiscal year were primarily those where large construction projects were involved. Sublette county showed the greatest increase from a year ago, at 53%, followed by the counties Lincoln (13%), Sweetwater (13%), Teton (10%), Carbon (9%), Laramie (9%), and Hot Springs (2%). Out of state tax revenues declined by better than 8 percent. Likewise, there were 16 counties that had declining sales for this time period, most notably, Sheridan (-25%). Weston, Converse, Natrona and Fremont counties all showed reductions exceeding 10 percent. The growth rate over the past 10 years in current and constant dollars can be found in Table 6. Monthly sales tax collections, as received by the State Department of Revenue and Taxation, are provided in Table 7 for seasonal analysis.

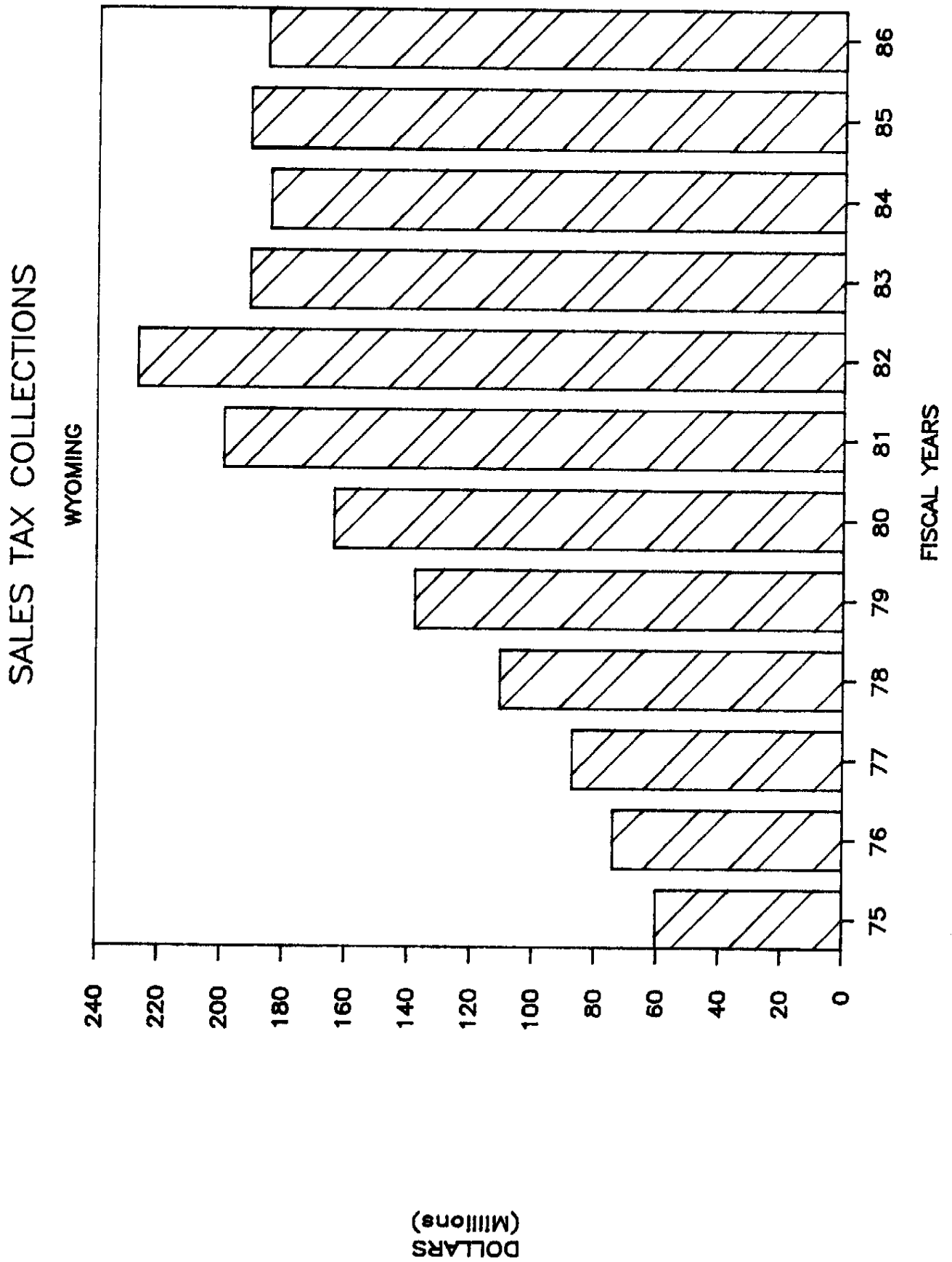

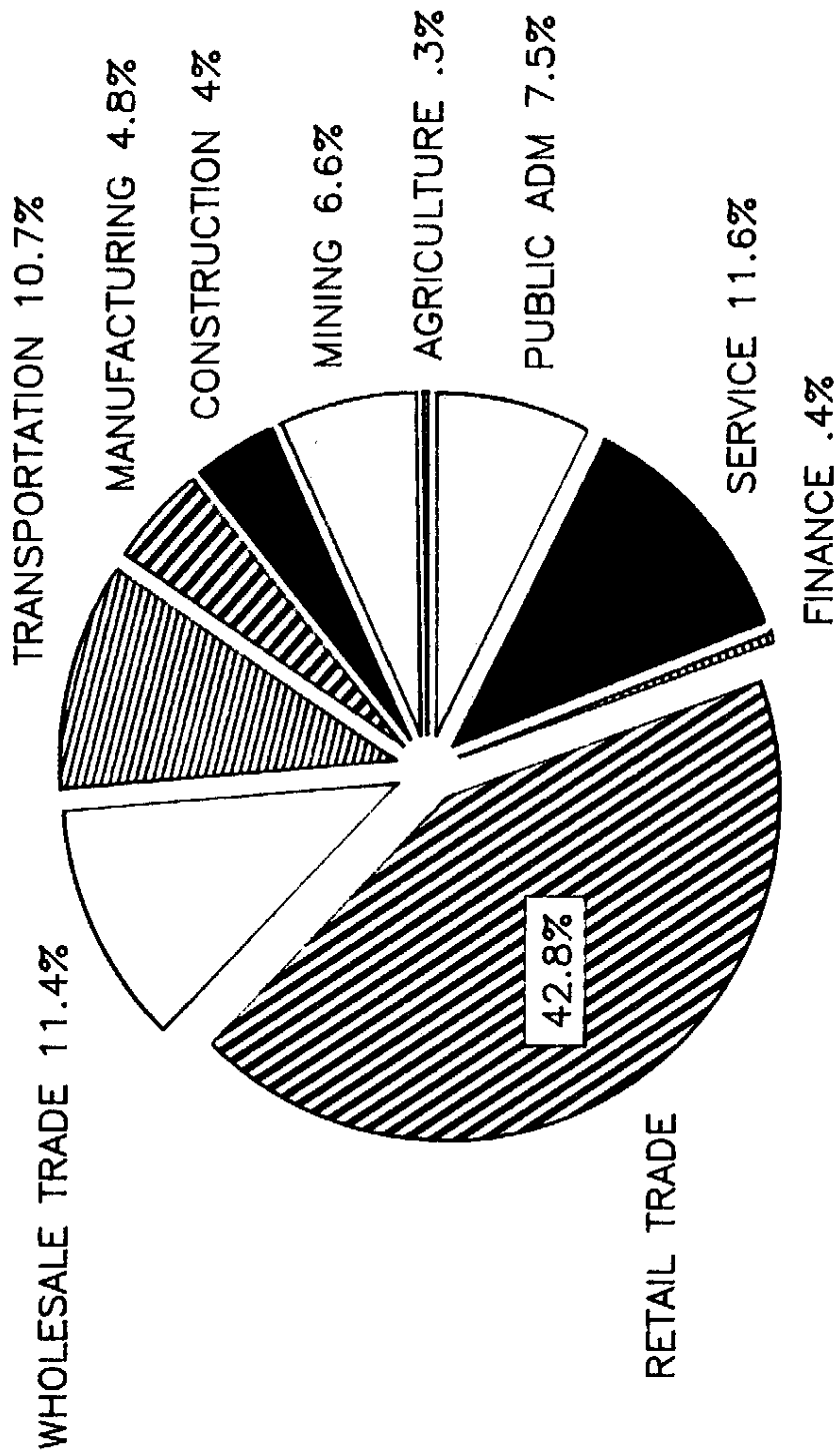
SALES TAX COLLECTIONS BY MAJOR
INDUSTRIAL SECTORS

This section contains the state and county sales tax collections by major industrial sectors. Definitions can be found in the glossary.

State sales tax collections dipped 2.8 percent from fiscal year 1985 to 1986. Two sectors recorded significant gains in sales tax collections during this time period. The Construction sector increased 36.4 percent and the Financial sector increased by 10.9 percent. Only two other sectors experienced growth in sales tax collections (although minimal), Public Administration (1.3%), and Transportation (.5%). Six sectors experienced a decline in sales tax collections. The largest decline was realized in the Mining sector (-23.3%) followed by Manufacturing (-10.9%), Wholesale Trade (-9.1%), Agriculture (-5.2%), Services (-2.5%) and Retail Trade (-.3%).

Figure 3 shows each of the industrial sectors as a percentage of total sales tax collections for FY86.

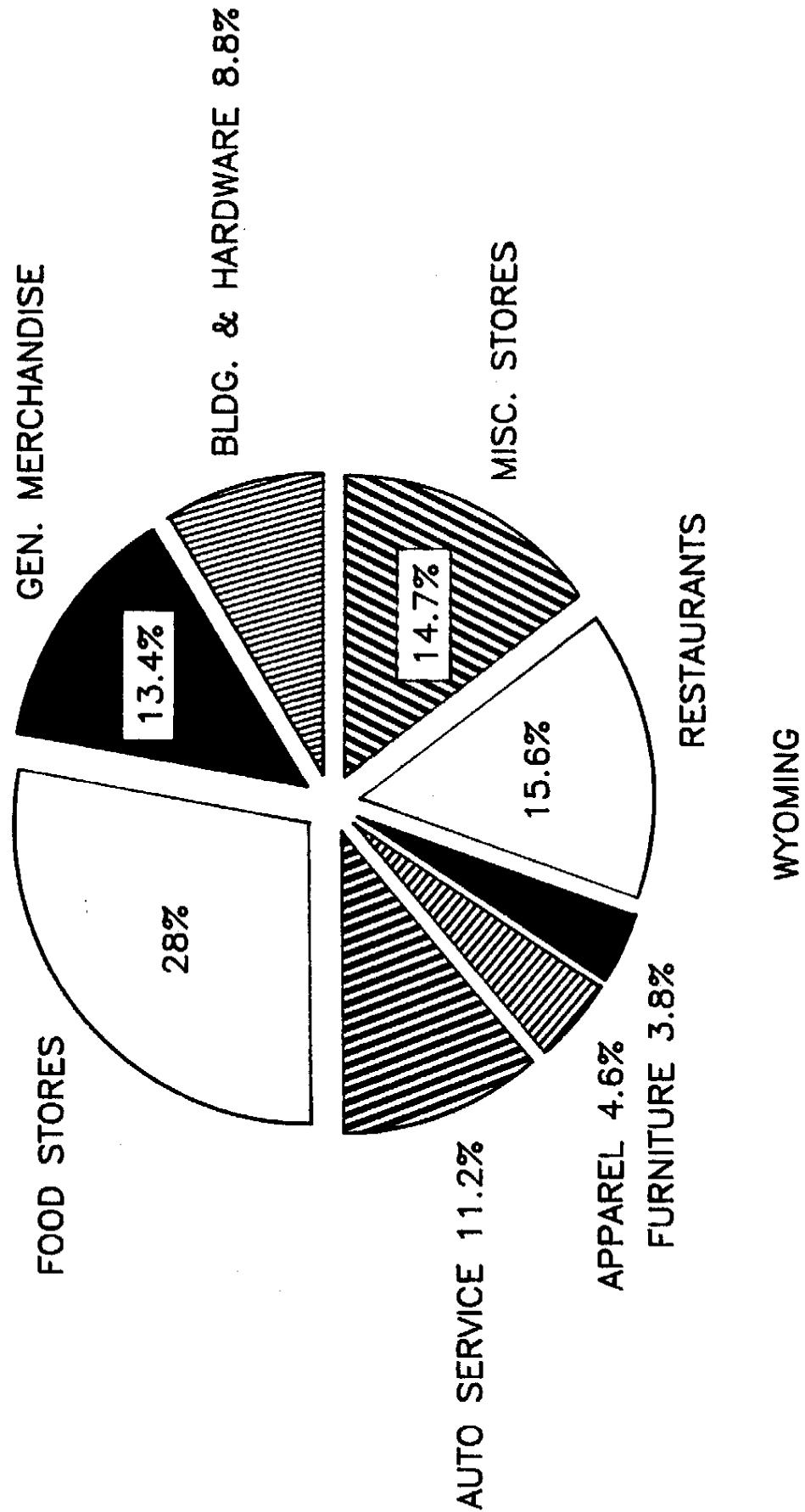
RETAIL SALES TAX COLLECTIONS

This section of the report details the sales tax collections of the retail sector statewide and by each county. The retail sector is subdivided into eight major categories which are defined in the glossary.

There was very little change in total retail sales tax collections for FY86 when compared to FY85, only -.3 percent. The categories of General Merchandise (5%), Restaurants (2.8%) and Apparel (1.9%) provided the most substantial increases in collections over FY85. Sales tax collections from Miscellaneous Stores (.5%) and Food Stores (.3%) showed very modest increases from a year ago. However, significant declines in collections from the categories of Building and Hardware (-9.2%), Auto Services (-5.2%), and Furniture (-3.5%) offset the increases from the other categories.

While the component categories of the retail sector have fluctuated since last year their importance to the total remain closely the same. Figure 4 shows the breakdown of total retail sales tax collections for FY86 by category.

SECTION IV

USE TAX COLLECTIONS SUMMARY TABLES AND CHARTS

SUMMARY OF USE TAX COLLECTIONS

Total State use tax collections for the past six years have been summarized in this section. As shown in Figure 5, total use tax collections reached the highest level in 1982, at \$58.7 million. The 1986 State use tax collections were up nearly \$10.6 million or 31 percent from fiscal year 1985, representing the first increase in this revenue source since 1982. The three counties mainly responsible for this substantial hike are Sublette, Lincoln, and Sweetwater which experienced increases of 1,141, 259, and 90 percent respectively, from fiscal 1985. Seven other counties showed increases while the remaining 13 counties, along with out of state collections, showed decreases from the previous year.

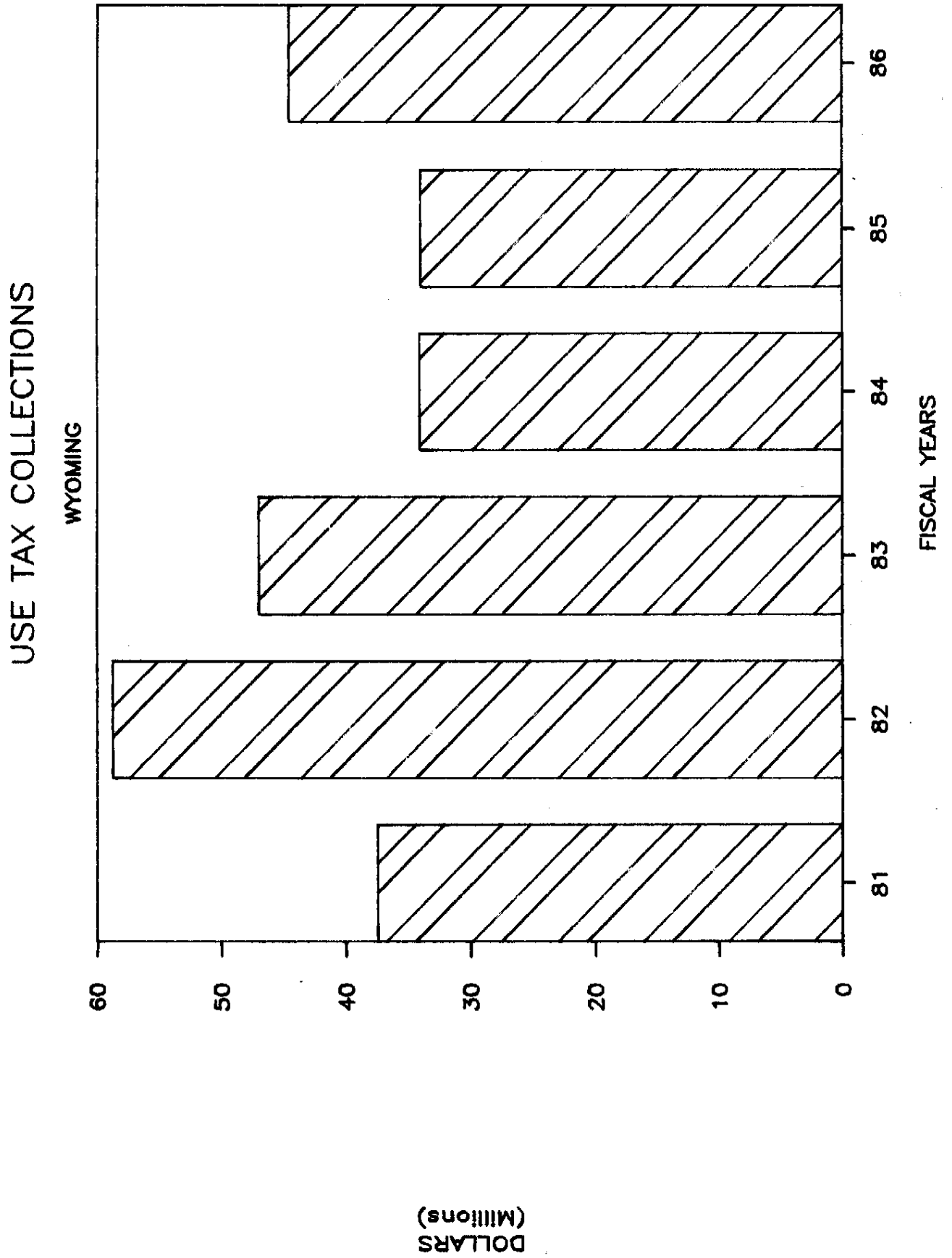

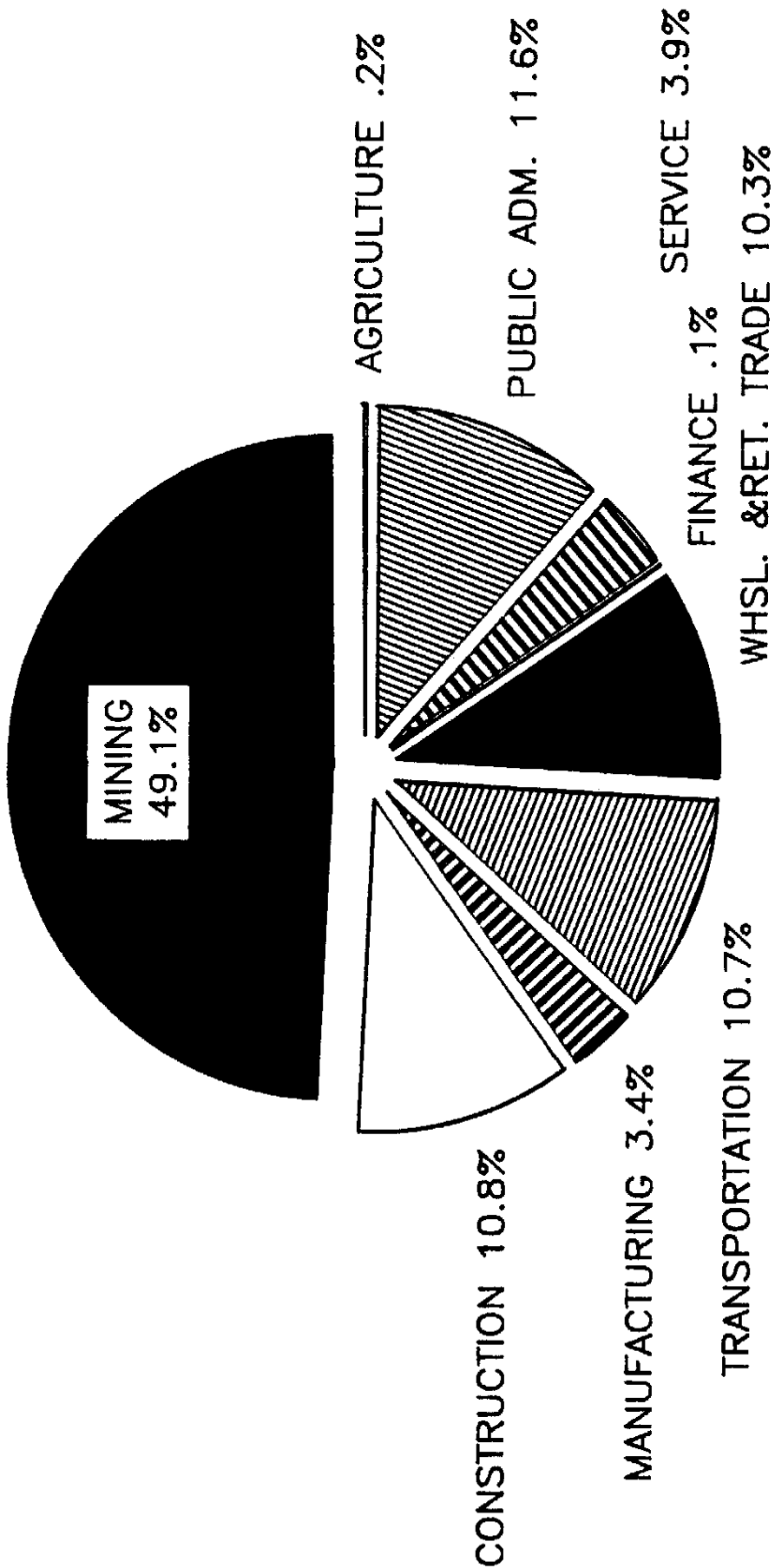
USE TAX COLLECTIONS BY MAJOR INDUSTRIAL SECTORS

This section contains the state and county use tax collections by major industrial sectors. Definitions can be found in the glossary.

State use tax collections increased 31 percent from fiscal year 1985 to 1986. The Mining sector recorded the most significant increase from fiscal 1985, of 109 percent. Two other sectors, Services and Construction also showed substantial increases of 59 and 27 percent respectively, over fiscal 1985. Six sectors experienced declines in use tax collections from fiscal 1985 to 1986. The largest decline was felt in the Wholesale and Retail Trade sectors (grouped together, -30%) followed by Agriculture (-24%), Manufacturing (-22%), Finance (-9%), Transportation (-1%), and Public Administration (-1%).

Figure 6 shows each of the industrial sectors as a percent of total use tax collections for FY86.

GLOSSARY

GLOSSARY

NOTE: All page citations refer to Executive Office of the President, Office of Management and Budget, Standard Industrial Classification Manual 1967, Washington: U.S. Government Printing Office (1967)

AGRICULTURE

This division includes establishments primarily engaged in agricultural production, forestry, commercial fishing, hunting and trapping, and related services. (p. 17)

APPAREL

This major group includes retail stores primarily engaged in selling new clothing, shoes, hats and related articles for personal wear and adornment. (p. 267)

AUTOMOBILE

This major group includes retail dealers selling new and used automobiles, boats, recreational and utility trailers, and motorcycles; those selling new automobile parts and accessories and gasoline service station. However, these collections do not include sales of new and used vehicles, since the County Treasurer collects this tax and therefore is included in the Public Administration sector. (p. 265)

BUILDING AND HARDWARE

This major group includes retail establishments primarily engaged in selling lumber and other building materials; paint; glass and wallpaper; hardware; nursery stock; lawn and garden supplies and mobile homes. (p. 260)

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT TAX

(Sec. 39-6-412, W.S. 1984)

This is an optional sales tax imposed for the express purpose of capital construction. The revenue from the tax shall be used only for planning, construction, furnishing, equipping and debt service for any capital improvement project authorized by public election.

CONSTRUCTION

This division includes establishments primarily engaged in construction, which is defined to include new work, additions, alterations and repairs. (p. 45)

FINANCE

This division includes establishments operating primarily in the fields of finance, insurance and real estate. (p. 277)

FOOD STORES

This major group includes retail stores primarily engaged in selling food for home preparation and consumption. (p. 263)

FURNITURE

This major group includes retail stores selling goods used for furnishing the home such as furniture, floor coverings, drapes and electrical and gas appliances. (p. 269)

GENERAL MERCHANDISE

This major group includes retail outlets such as department stores, variety stores and general merchandise stores which sell a number of lines of merchandise such as dry goods, apparel, accessories, furniture and home furnishings, small wares, hardware and food. (p. 262)

INHERITANCE TAX

(Sec. 39-6-810 to 39-6-813, W.C. 1977)
This new provision repealed the old state Inheritance Tax. The state now collects all or its prorata share of the "Federal Credit for State Death Tax". This tax is applicable to the estates of descendants whose date of death is January 1, 1983 and thereafter. This tax is commonly referred to as a "pickup tax", wherein the state of domicile, and the states where the non-resident decedent owned real and tangible personal property with an actual situs in the non-domicillary state, collect the Federal Credit or a prorata share which is allowable on the Federal Estate Tax Return.

MANUFACTURING

The manufacturing division includes all establishments such as plants, factories, and mills engaged in the mechanical or chemical transformation of materials or substances into new products. (p. 57)

MINERAL SEVERANCE TAX

(Section 39-6-301 to 39-6-307, W.S. 1977)

The tax is levied on the cash market value of specified minerals and valuable deposits after the mining or production process is completed. The particular rate varies with the type of deposit. The distribution of collections also varies from the State funds (General, Trust and Agency, Capitol Facilities, etc) with the type of deposit.

MINING

This division includes all establishments primarily engaged in mining. Mining is here used in the broad sense to include the extraction of solid and gaseous minerals occurring naturally as well as other preparation customarily done at the mine site, or as a part of mining activity. (p. 31)

MISCELLANEOUS STORES

This major group includes retail establishments not elsewhere classified such as drug stores, liquor stores and used merchandise stores. (p. 272)

PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

This division includes the legislative, judicial, administrative and regulatory activities of Federal, State, local and international governments. Also, nonclassifiable establishments have been placed in this category.

RESTAURANTS

This major group includes retail establishments selling prepared foods and drinks for consumption on the premises, and also lunch counters and refreshment stands selling prepared foods and drinks for immediate consumption. (p. 271)

RETAIL TRADE

This division includes establishments engaged in selling merchandise for personal or household consumption and rendering services incidental to the sale of the goods. (p. 259)

SALES TAX

(Sec. 39-6-401 to 39-6-417, W.S. 1977)

This tax is levied on the gross receipts from the sale of tangible personal property and specified services. For a listing of exemptions and rates refer to the introduction. The collections are distributed between the State General Fund and local jurisdictions.

SERVICES

This division includes establishments primarily engaged in providing a wide variety of services (ie. such as legal, health and repair) for individuals, business and government establishments, and other organizations. (p. 295)

TRANSPORTATION

This division includes establishments providing to the general public or to other business enterprises, passenger and freight transportation, communication services, electricity, gas, steam water or sanitary services, and the U.S. Postal Service. (p. 219)

USE TAX

(Sec. 39-6-501 to 39-6-603, W.S. 1977)

The Use Tax is levied upon tangible personal property that is purchased from an out-of-state vendor and shipped directly to the purchaser for storage, use or consumption in the state. Freight and property in interstate transportation is exempted. The rate is fixed at three percent and the collections are distributed between the State General Fund and local jurisdictions.

WHOLESALE TRADE

This division includes establishments or places of business primarily engaged in selling merchandise to retailers or acting as agents or brokers in buying merchandise for or selling merchandise to retailers. However, when a wholesale good is not sold for resale it is taxed at retail value.
