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PREFACE

The 2023 edition of the Wyoming Sales, Use, and Lodging Tax Revenue Report is a compendium of detailed excise tax information. This publication contains sales and use tax collection information categorized by the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) for Wyoming and its twenty-three counties. Sales tax collections for the retail trade sector, which are itemized by sub-sector components, and for the accommodation and food services sector are provided in the report. Also included in this publication are annual lodging tax collections by county and local entity. As a point of clarification, sales and use tax collections by NAICS codes reflect the **taxable sales** made within a particular industrial sector, NOT the taxable purchases made by that sector.

This report includes total sales and use tax collections activity by state and county for fiscal years 2021-2023, for both the state-imposed 4% taxes and total taxes, which includes local optional taxes (Wyoming State Government's fiscal year extends from July 1 through June 30). Lodging tax information is provided for fiscal years 2021-2023. The data were provided by the Wyoming Department of Revenue, and were compiled for publication by the Economic Analysis Division.

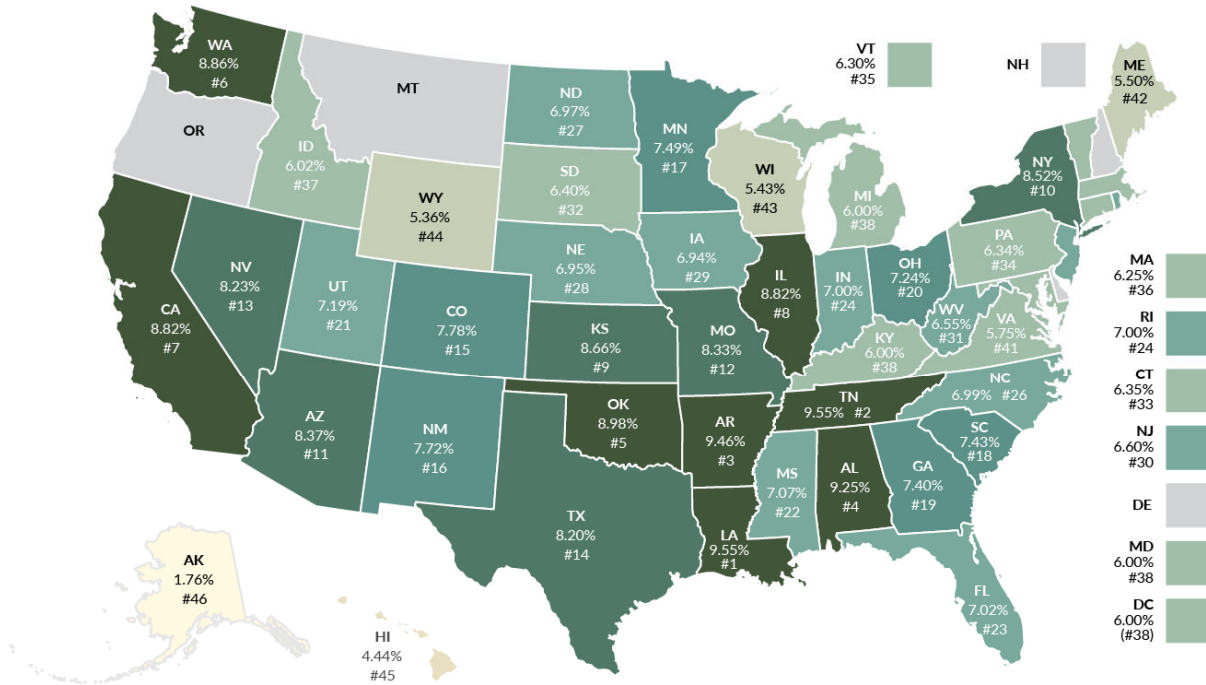

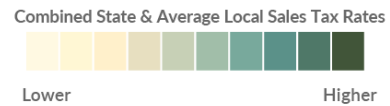


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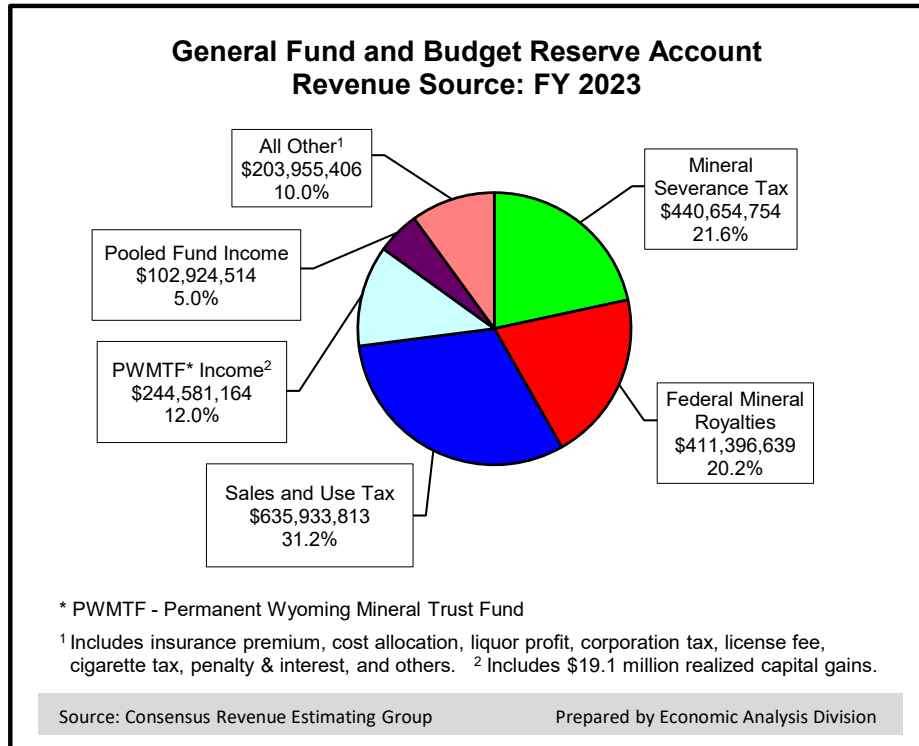
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INTRODUCTION

Sales and use tax collections are the two principal revenue sources for state and local governments in Wyoming. These two revenue sources, when tabulated over time, also provide a valuable indication of economic activity at the state and county levels.



Lodging tax collections provide revenue to the State Tourism Office, cities, towns, and counties. This economic indicator is particularly useful in identifying and monitoring tourism activity and local economic trends.

The reporting of sales and use tax collections is based upon the 2017 North American Industry Classification System (NAICS), developed by the Federal Office of Management and Budget. Under this system, a business is classified by its primary activity, which is determined by the principal product, or group of products that are produced, distributed, and/or services rendered. Each NAICS sector classification is briefly described in the glossary on page 67.

SALES TAX

Wyoming has implemented a sales and use tax since 1935. The revenue from this tax is shared between the state and local governments within the county-of-origin. Since the inception of the sales and use tax, the distribution shares to the state and county-of-origin have changed several times. Currently, the state-imposed sales tax rate is 4 percent, and the breakdown of the distribution is 69 percent goes to the state and 31 percent to county-of-origin. This current formula was put in place in fiscal year 2005.

The State's share of sales tax revenue is distributed to the General Fund. The chart on page 4 and the table located on page 8 outline the significance of this tax. The portion of sales tax revenue returned to the counties and municipalities is mainly distributed based upon the decennial census population within the counties.

Beginning in 1973, Wyoming counties were granted the option to impose an additional one percent sales tax approved through public election. As of January 1, 2023, all counties except for Park and Sublette were imposing this optional sales tax for general purpose. The optional sales tax revenue, less administrative costs, is returned to the county-of-origin. Distribution between county and municipalities is also based on the proportion of the decennial census population.

In addition to the aforementioned county optional tax, any county, through public election, may impose an additional excise tax of up to one percent on retail sales made within the county. This optional excise tax is referred to as the 1 percent capital facilities option tax or the specific purpose option. The revenue generated from this tax is designated solely for the planning, construction, furnishing, equipping, and debt servicing for any capital improvement project as authorized through public election. As of January 1, 2023, Albany, Carbon, Crook, Hot Springs, Laramie, Niobrara, Platte, Sheridan, and Teton counties imposed a 1 percent specific purpose option tax. Since April 2007, counties could also impose another one percent sales tax for economic development purposes. Only Fremont and Goshen counties imposed this particular

tax as of January 1, 2023, at 0.50 percent and 0.25 percent, respectively. A table of effective tax rates by county is located on page 9.

To derive an estimate of county gross taxable sales, the specific county tax collection can be divided by the corresponding tax rate. However, this method suffices as only an approximate indicator of gross sales and does not include any non-taxable sales. (See pages 10-11 for a list of all taxable events and exemptions). Further, because county optional taxes originate and expire at varying times, county sales tax rates may fluctuate from one year to another. When measuring performance over time, the inclusion of these optional revenues results in statistical variances. Therefore, only the state imposed 4 percent tax collections should be used for the purpose of year-to-year comparisons. The table and graph on page 16 display only the state imposed sales tax collections and the annual percent change for fiscal years 2012 through 2023.

USE TAX

A state use tax is imposed on purchases made outside a taxing jurisdiction for first use, storage, or other consumption within that jurisdiction. Thus, the use tax prevents sales tax avoidance, or payment of a lesser tax rate when making purchases outside of the taxing jurisdiction where first use, storage, or other consumption will occur. Wyoming's taxing jurisdictions are the State of Wyoming and each county.

Use tax is a complement of sales tax. Effective January 1, 1981, the adoption of an optional sales tax requires a change in the use tax rate of equal amount. State use tax collections are shared between state government and the county-of-origin on the same distribution basis as sales tax. Therefore, the rate and allocation, as mentioned earlier in the sales tax description, applies for use tax as well. Again, for legitimate comparisons from one year to another, only the state imposed 4 percent use tax data should be applied. The table and graph on page 49 display only the state imposed use tax collections and the annual percent change for fiscal years 2012 through 2023.

LODGING TAX

Effective January 1, 2021, a statewide lodging assessment is imposed on sales of lodging services at the rate of three percent (3%). These collections are distributed to the Wyoming Tourism Account and Wyoming Tourism Reserve Account. Moreover, another two percent (2%) is also imposed statewide (but for local governments) including county areas and towns where there was no local lodging tax as of January 1, 2021. In addition, any county or municipality, through public election, may impose an additional tax of up to two percent for lodging purpose. Accordingly, total tax rate for lodging services in any area of Wyoming cannot exceed 7 percent.

Prior to January 1, 2021, cities, towns, and counties, by voter approval, had the option to impose an excise tax of up to 4 percent on all sleeping accommodations for guests staying less than thirty days. This tax also extends to mobile accommodations such as tents, trailers, and campers.

All lodging tax collections for local governments (up to 4%), less a 1 percent state administrative cost are distributed to the cities, towns, and counties-of-origin. At least 90 percent of the tax distributions must be used to promote travel and tourism within the county, city, or town that is imposing the tax. The remaining amount, not to exceed 10 percent of the total amount distributed, may be used for general revenue within the governmental entity imposing the tax. A list of counties and municipalities that levy a lodging tax are on page 9.

As of January 1, 2023, Albany, Campbell, Crook, Fremont, Goshen, Hot Springs, Laramie, Natrona, Park, Sheridan, Sweetwater, Washakie, and Weston counties, Kemmerer city in Lincoln County, and Pinedale town in Sublette County imposed an optional 2 percent lodging tax.

For meaningful comparisons from one year to another, only the state imposed 3 percent lodging tax data should be applied. The map on page 64 displays the change of the state imposed 3% collections.

TAXABLE EVENTS AND EXEMPTIONS

Wyoming Statute 39-15-103 describes the following sales and services as **taxable** events:

1. Retail sales of tangible personal property within the state.
2. Leases of tangible personal property if the property would have been taxable, had it been sold.
3. Intrastate telephone and telegraph services, and the equipment used to carry out such services.
4. Intrastate transportation of passengers.
5. Sales by public utilities and by those furnishing gas, electricity, or heat for domestic, industrial, or commercial consumption.
6. Meals regularly served to the public, and cover charges.
7. Lodging services to transient guests, e.g., motels, hotels.
8. Admissions to amusements, or athletic events.
9. Repair, alteration, or improvement of tangible personal property.
10. Contract seismographic surveying, contract geophysical surveying, and other contract geophysical exploration operations calculated to reveal the existence of geologic conditions favorable to the accumulation of oil or gas, and for all services rendered in and all types of coring, logging, testing, stimulating, perforating, cementing, completing, recompleting, or attempting to complete any well for production of oil or gas.
11. Sales of automobiles, mobile homes, campers, and semi-trailers.
12. Sales of alcoholic beverages.
13. Sales of computer hardware and non-customized computer software.

Wyoming Statute 39-15-103 (a) defines "Sales Price" as the consideration paid by the purchaser of tangible personal property, excluding the actual trade-in value allowed on property exchanged at the time of transaction, admissions, or services which are subject to taxation as provided by this article, and excluding any taxes imposed by the federal government, or this article.

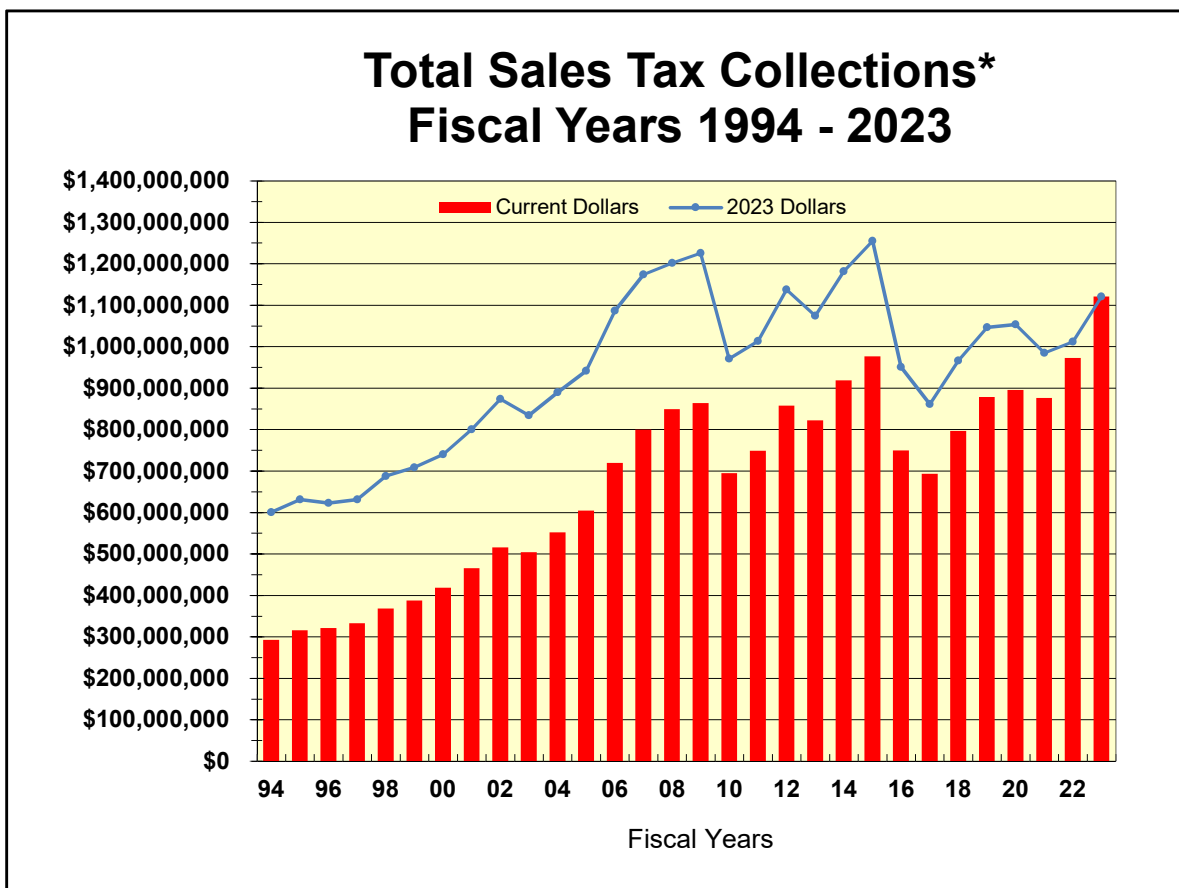
Wyoming Statute 39-15-105 governs exemptions from state sales tax. **Exemptions** include the following:

1. Sales of tangible personal property to a person engaged in manufacturing, if such property becomes an ingredient or component of the item manufactured. Sales of containers, labels, etc., are also exempt.
2. Sales of livestock, feeds for feeding livestock for marketing purposes; seeds, roots, bulbs, small plants, and fertilizer, planted or applied to land, the products of which are to be sold.
3. Intrastate transportation of sick, injured, and deceased persons by ambulance or hearse.
4. Intrastate transportation of employees when the transportation is paid for by the employer.
5. Intrastate transportation of raw farm products to processing plants.
6. Interstate transportation of freight and passengers.
7. Sales of energy if the energy is consumed directly in manufacturing, processing, or agriculture.
8. Sales of power or fuel used directly in generating motive power for transportation purposes, provided that gasoline, or diesel fuels used had been taxed (per gallon) under the Special Fuels, or Gasoline Tax Acts.
9. Sales of the services of professional engineers, geologists, or members of similar professions.
10. Sales made to the State of Wyoming, or its political subdivisions.

11. Sales made to a religious, or charitable organization, or non-profit corporations providing meals to senior citizens.
12. Occasional sales made by religious, or charitable organizations for fund raising purposes.
13. Sales which Wyoming is forbidden to tax, either by the State, or by the laws, or constitution of the United States.
14. Sales of prescription drugs, oxygen for medical use, plasma, prosthetic devices, hearing aids, crutches, wheelchairs, eyeglasses and contact lenses, insulin for human relief, and any syringe, needle, or device for the administration thereof.
15. Leases of vehicle if the lease is computed from gross receipts of the operation, if the operator is operating under a valid interstate authority or permit.
16. Wholesale sales.
17. Intrastate transportation of freight and property including oil and gas by pipeline.
18. Sales of school annuals.
19. Sales of newspapers.
20. Sales to Wyoming joint apprenticeship and training programs.
21. Sales to Joint Powers Boards organized under the Wyoming Joint Powers Act.
22. Transportation of drilling rigs, including charges for loading, unloading, assembly, and disassembly.
23. Sales of food for domestic home consumption.
24. Admission to, or user fees for county, or municipal owned recreation facilities.
25. Sales of carbon dioxide and other gases used in tertiary production.
26. Labor/service charges, including transportation and travel, for repair, alteration, or improvement of property owned by the State of Wyoming, or its political subdivisions.
27. Lodging services provided by guides or outfitters.
28. Intrastate transportation by public utility or others of raw farm products to processing or manufacturing plants.
29. Intrastate transfer of persons services by a government, charitable, or non-profit organization.
30. Sales of fuel for use as boiler fuel in the production of electricity.
31. Sales of water delivered by pipeline or truck.
32. Sales of farm implements.
33. Sales or lease of machinery to be used in the state directly or predominantly in manufacturing tangible property.
34. Sales or lease of any aircraft used in federal aviation administration commercial operation.
35. Sales of equipment used to construct a new coal gasification or coal liquefaction facility.
36. Sales price paid for purchase or rental of computer software, computer equipment, and related utility equipment by a data processing services center.
37. Sales of and retail commissions on lottery tickets or shares and equipment necessary to operate a lottery.
38. Sales of equipment by telecommunication and internet providers used to provide broadband internet service in an unserved area.

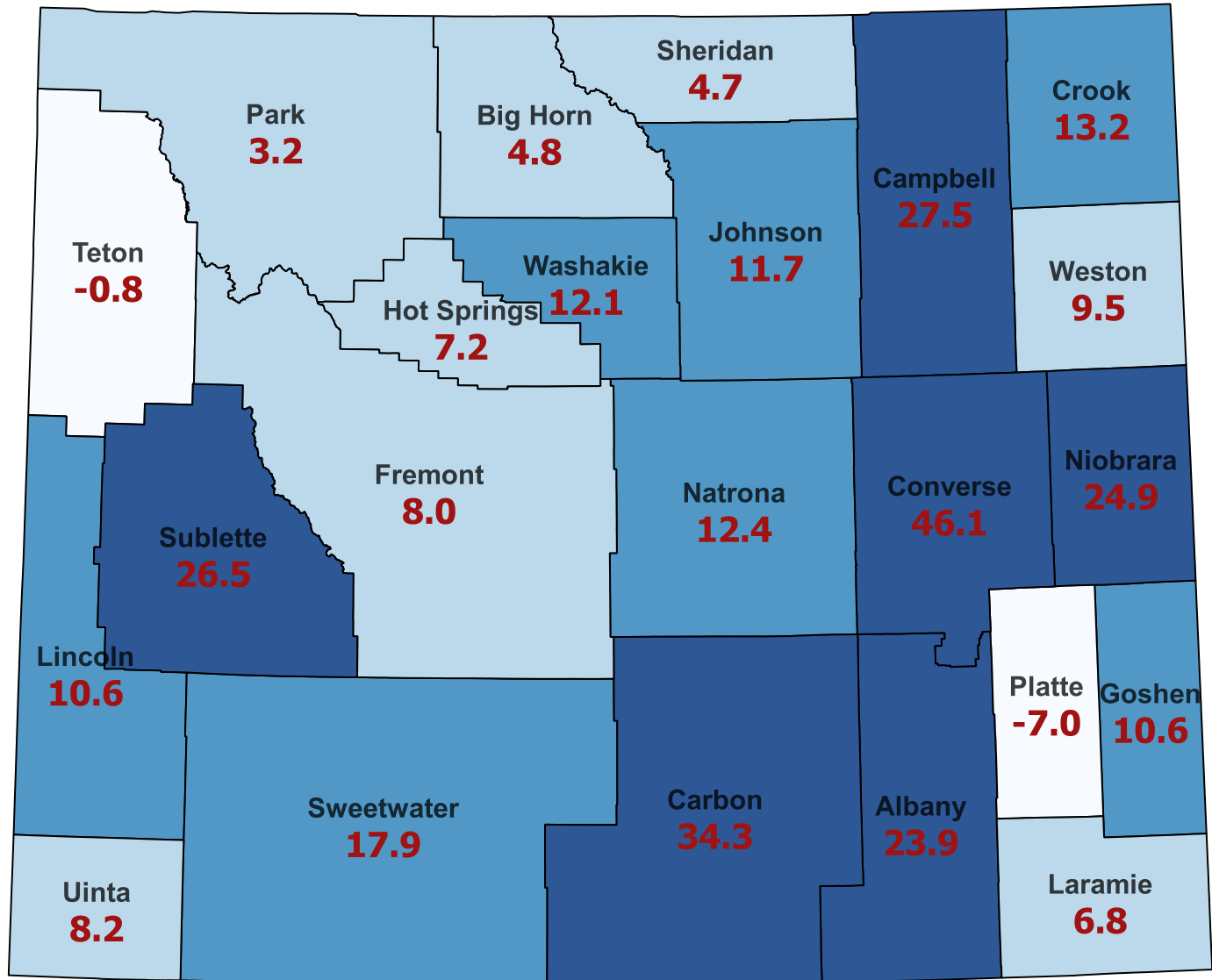

Wyoming = 14.4%

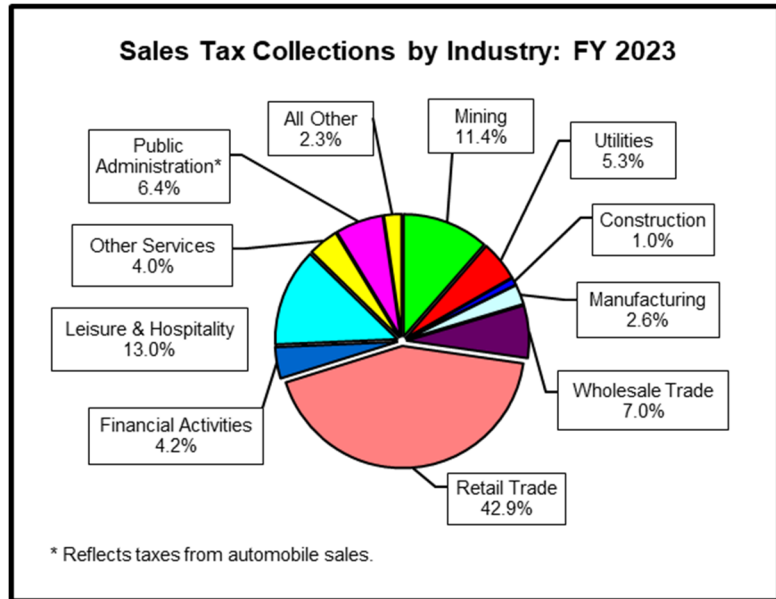

SUMMARY OF SALES TAX COLLECTIONS

Total sales tax collections for fiscal year 2023 (FY 2023), \$1,120.8 million, increased 15.3 percent from the previous year. The annual growth rate for the state-imposed 4% sales tax collections was 14.4 percent, compared to 12.3 percent recorded in fiscal year 2022 (FY 2022).

Prior to the COVID-19 pandemic, the change of Wyoming's total sales and use taxes were always driven by fluctuation in mineral prices and accompanying exploration & production activities. However, since the pandemic started, the state's economy and sales and use tax collections have been largely affected by the virus related



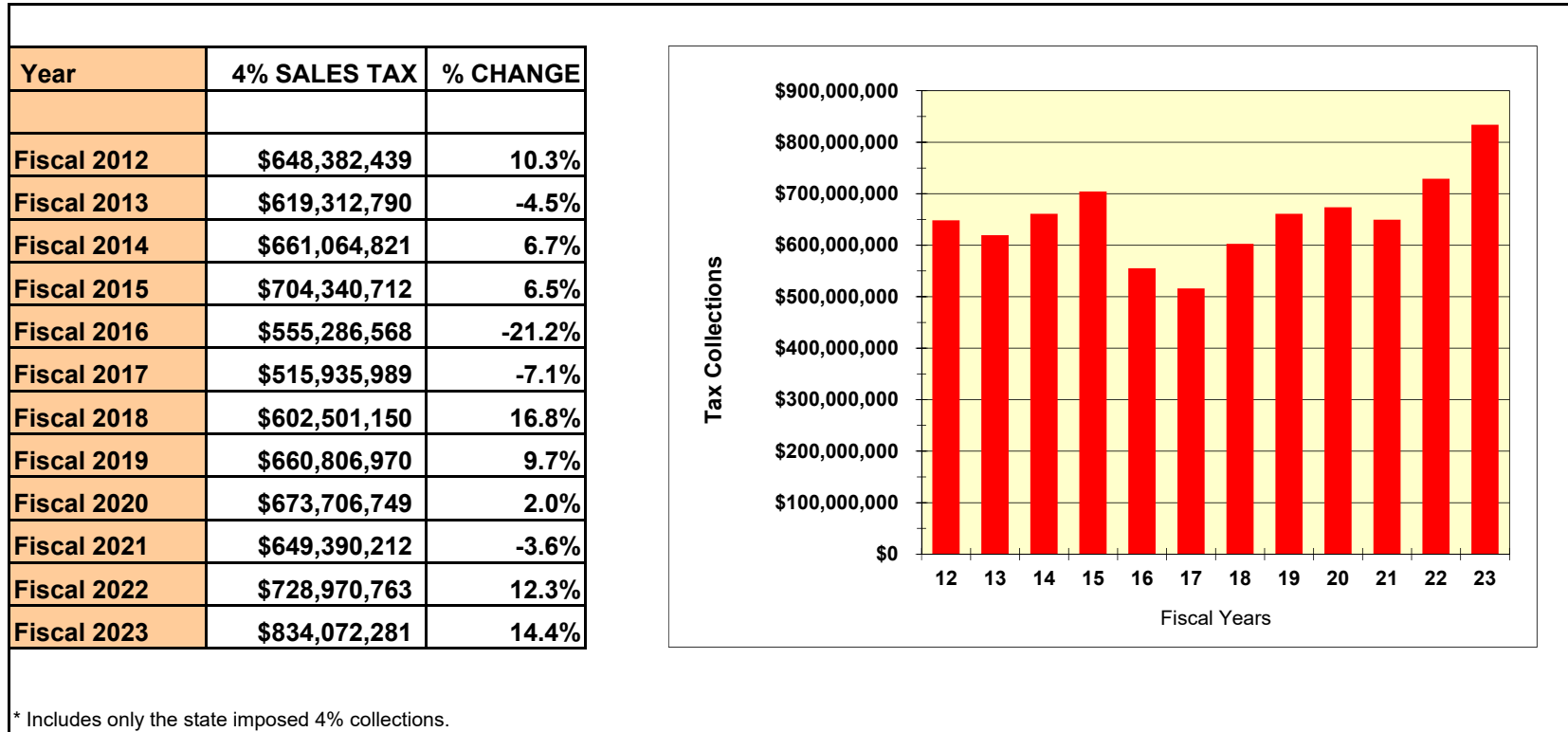
federal and local policies and deployment of health care measures. This included the closing and reopening of the economy, the rounds of federal fiscal stimulus payments to individuals and businesses, and monetary response. Since COVID, there has been robust demand for travel and tourism services, food services, retail goods, and automobiles. It also, subsequently, (starting in the second quarter of 2021) boosted inflation of a wide range of goods and services to the highest level in 40 years. In addition, responding to the increased prices, oil and natural gas activities have also rebounded at a faster pace since the first quarter of 2021.

Because locally imposed optional taxes often change during a fiscal year, an accurate comparison should only include the state-imposed 4% taxes to reflect changes in taxable sales over time. As the impact from the COVID-19 pandemic faded, Wyoming's economy continued to rally in FY 2023, featured by the continued rebound of oil and gas drilling, healthy payroll job additions, low

unemployment rate, and strong income growth. Compared to FY 2022, nearly every major industrial sector experienced an increase in sales and use tax collections. Retail trade (excluding motor vehicles), the largest industry sector in terms of sales tax collections, increased 8.5 percent. Wholesale trade, transportation & warehousing, and machinery and equipment leasing (a sub-sector of financial activities) and repair industries (a sub-sector of other services) that act in tandem with mineral extraction operations each grew more than 20.0 percent. Wyoming's pivotal industry, mining, demonstrated the largest growth of 61.9 percent due to the continued rebound in exploration activities. However, the amount collected from this industry is still lower than FY 2019, pre-pandemic. As a result of increased activities in wind power projects and general rate increase in utility gas service, collections from the utilities sector grew 34.6 percent. Sales and use taxes from online shopping (a sub-sector of retail trade) increased 17.4 percent. Information (including publications) is the only sector that experienced a decline (-3.9%) during the year.

Across the state, year-over-year statewide sales tax collections increased in 21 counties, led by Converse (46.1 percent) and Carbon (34.3 percent) counties. Albany, Campbell, Niobrara, and Sublette counties each experienced over 20.0 percent increases. These counties benefited either from the rebound in mineral activities or wind power projects in FY 2023. Additionally, persistent and still elevated broad-based inflation across most goods and services played a large role in the overall strong sales and use tax collections. Platte County suffered the largest contraction (-7.0 percent), mainly due to decreased activities in retail and wholesale trade industries. Teton (-0.8 percent) is the only other county that experienced a decline in collections in comparison to FY 2022, mostly attributed to the reduced sales in accommodation and food services. The oldest national park, Yellowstone, was temporarily closed in June 2022 due to flooding, and then reopened with limited admission until December of 2022.

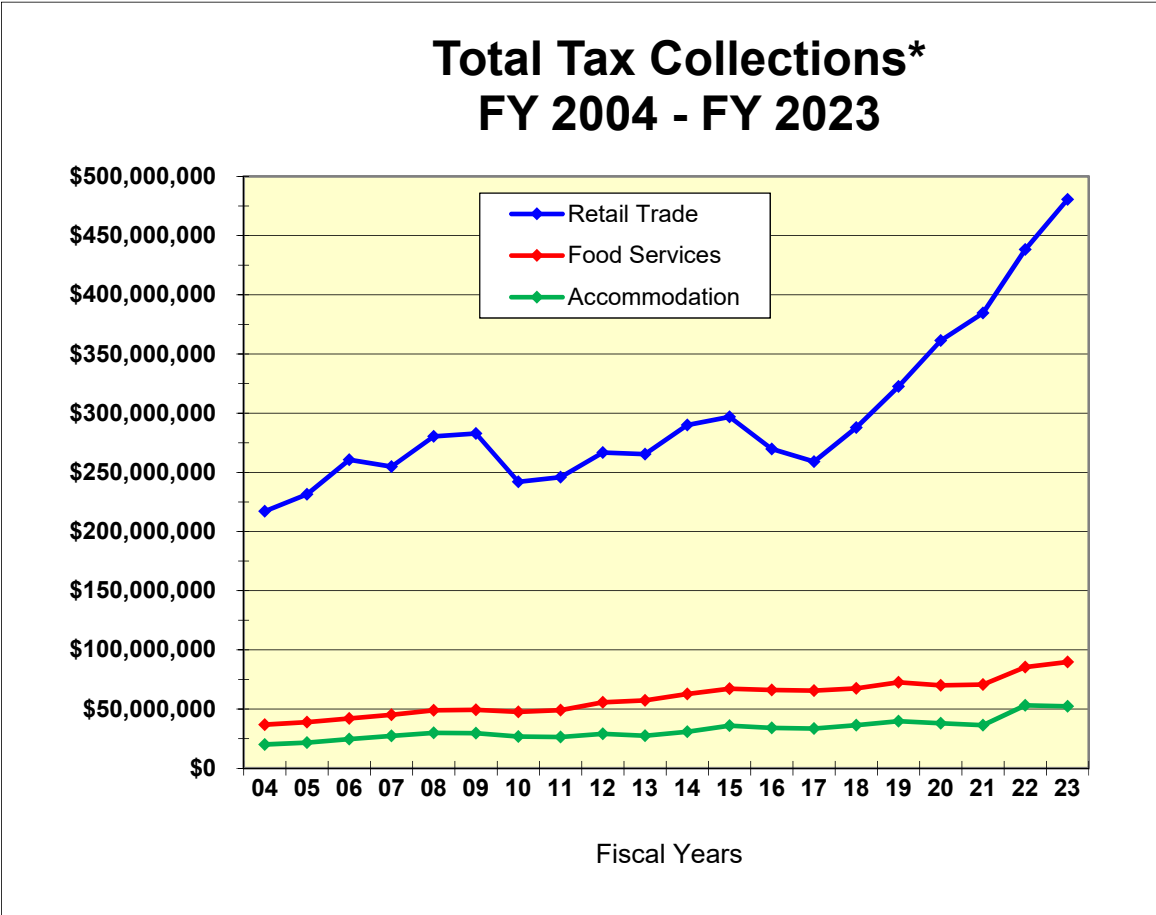

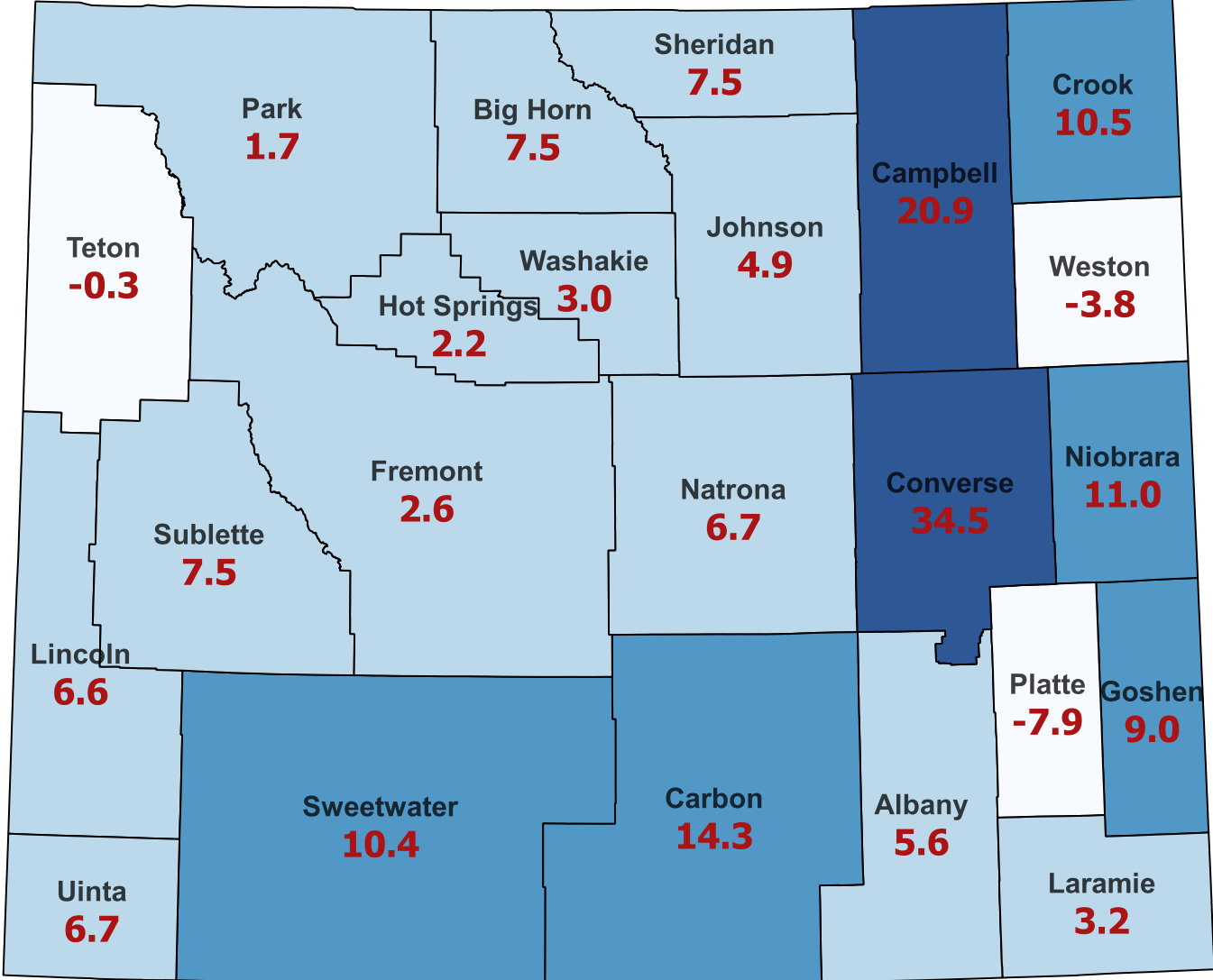

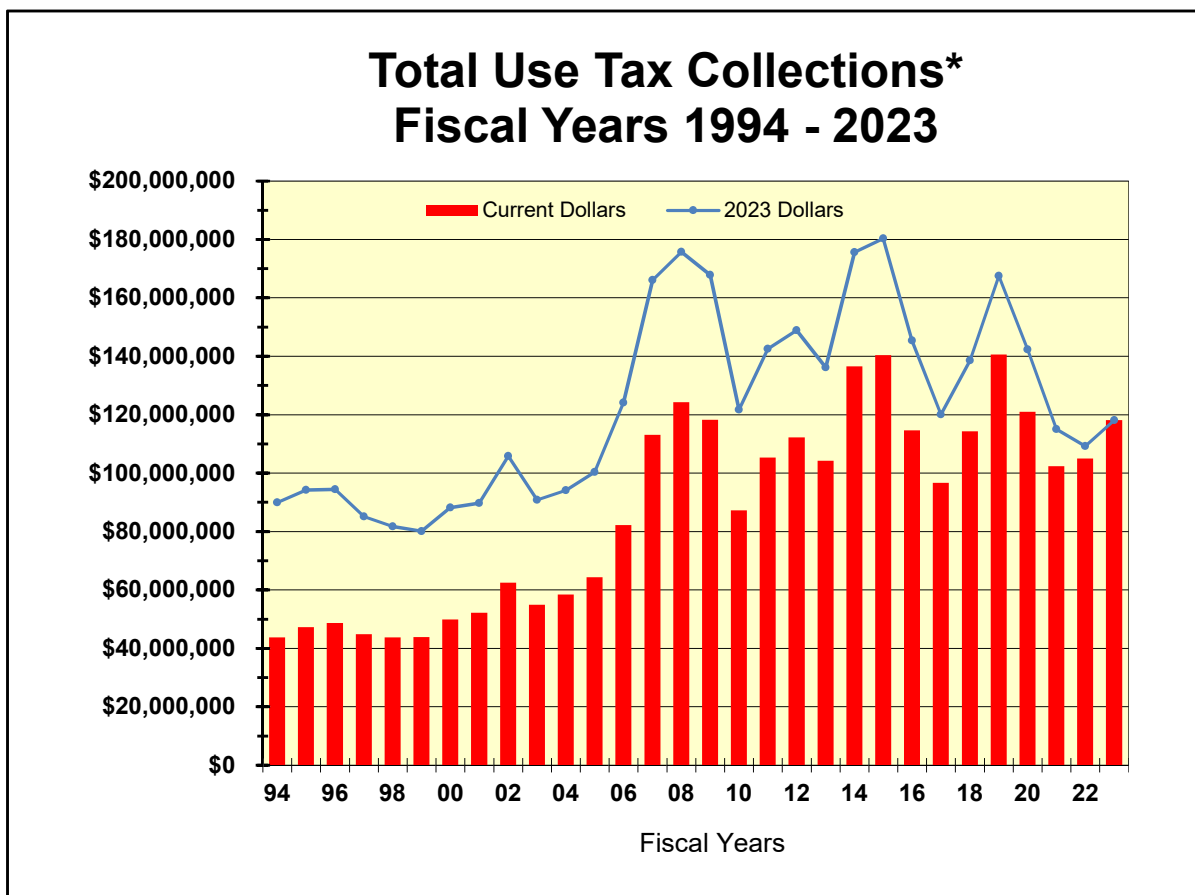

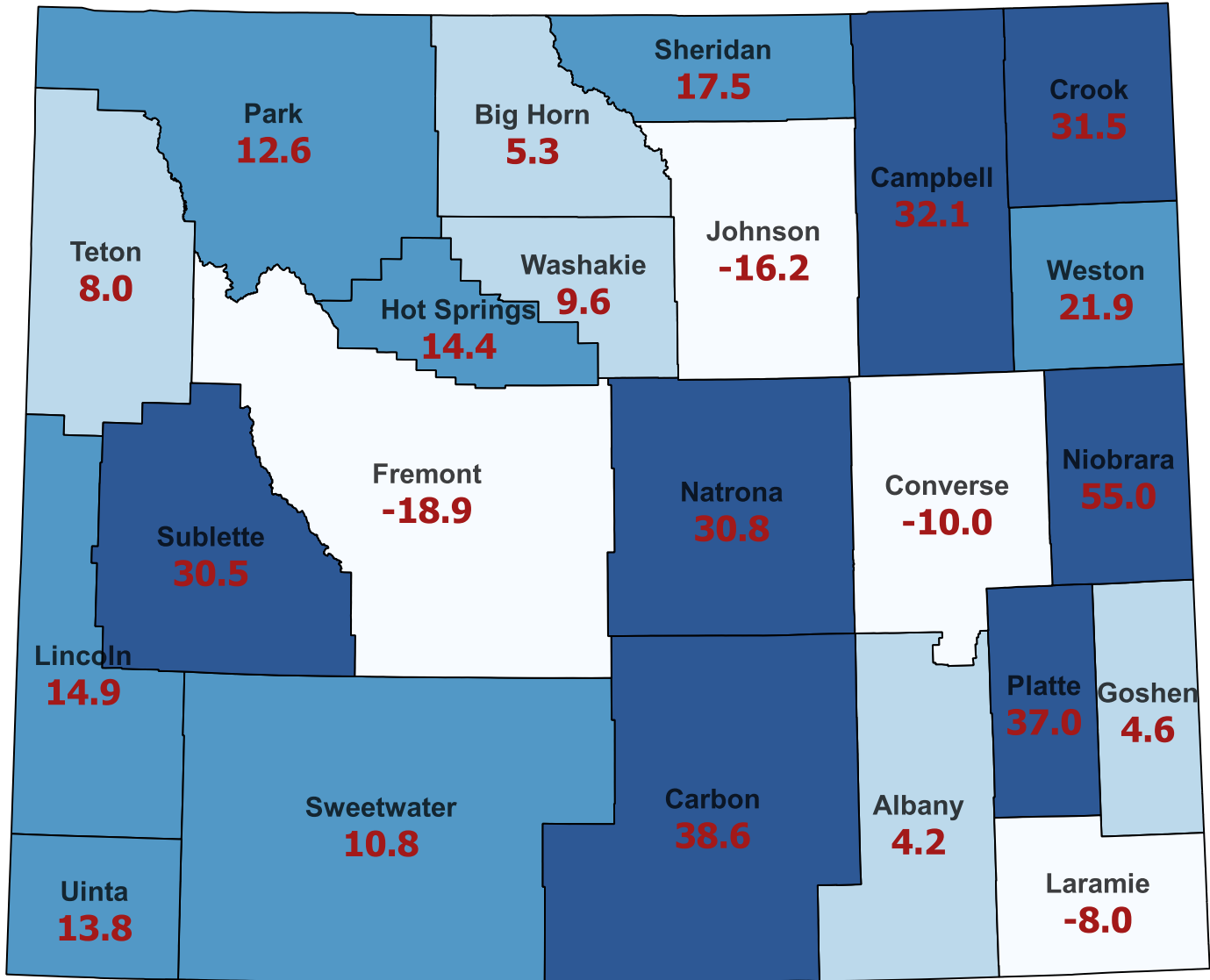

Wyoming = 11.3%

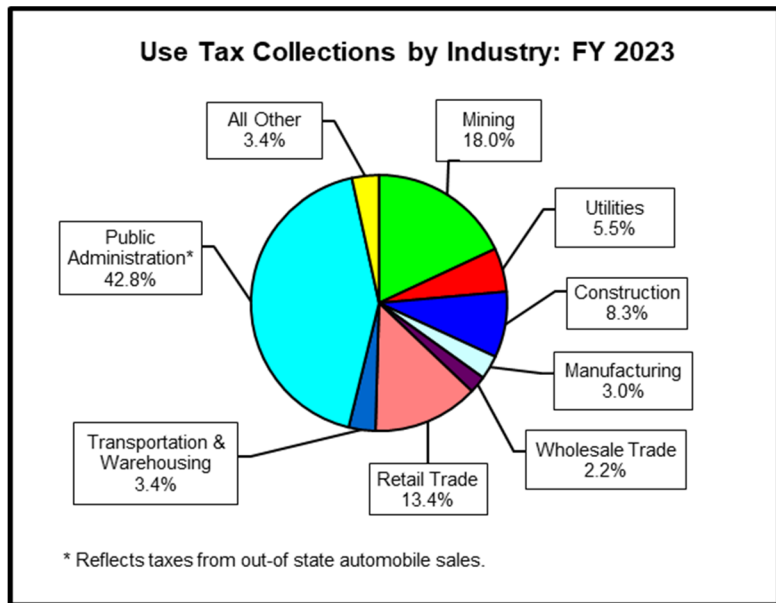

SUMMARY OF USE TAX COLLECTIONS

Use tax collections totaled \$118.1 million during FY 2023, an increase of 12.5 percent from the previous year. State-imposed 4% use tax collections also increased 11.3 percent from FY 2022 to FY 2023. This expansion comes after an annual increase of 3.0% the year before (FY 2022). Because locally imposed optional taxes often change during a fiscal year, an accurate comparison should only use the state-imposed 4% taxes to reflect changes in taxable sales over time.

In FY 2023, the majority of the NAICS super sectors experienced increases in use tax collection from FY 2022 levels, led by transportation & warehousing (73.0%). The mining (26.8%), wholesale trade (21.0%), and construction (20.8%) industries also showed robust expansions. Manufacturing and information were the only sectors that



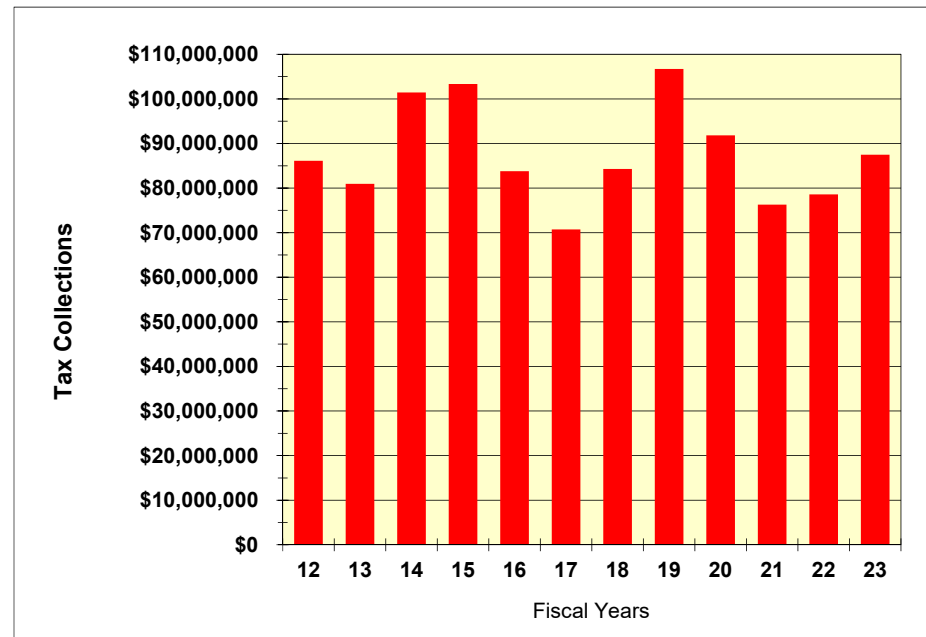
experienced a double-digit decline in use tax collections over the year, -31.6 and -25.3 percent, respectively. Use tax collections usually fluctuate considerably from one year to another in many sectors. A single large mining or construction project may make a big difference in use tax collections. Unlike collections for sales taxes, which are usually dominated by the retail trade and leisure & hospitality sectors, it is the public administration sector and goods-producing industries, such as mining and construction that typically cover a large portion of the use tax collections. Use tax collections reported in the public administration sector are primarily comprised of taxes generated through automobile purchases made out of the state.

Nineteen of Wyoming's counties saw an annual increase in use tax collections in FY 2023. The increase in Niobrara County from FY 2022 to FY 2023 was 55.0 percent, followed by the next highest county, Carbon, 38.6 percent. Campbell, Crook, Natrona, Platte and Sublette also experienced expansions of over 30.0 percent, respectively. Increases in mining activities and related services were mostly responsible for the large year-over-year growth in these counties.

Fremont County had the largest percentage contraction in use tax collections from FY 2022 to FY 2023, -18.9 percent, followed by Johnson (-16.2%), Converse (-10.0%), and Laramie (-8.0%). The rate of change in statewide 4% use tax collections over the past twelve years (FY 2012 to FY 2023) is shown on page 49. The map on page 46 shows the percent change in the state imposed 4% use tax collections by county from FY 2022 to FY 2023.

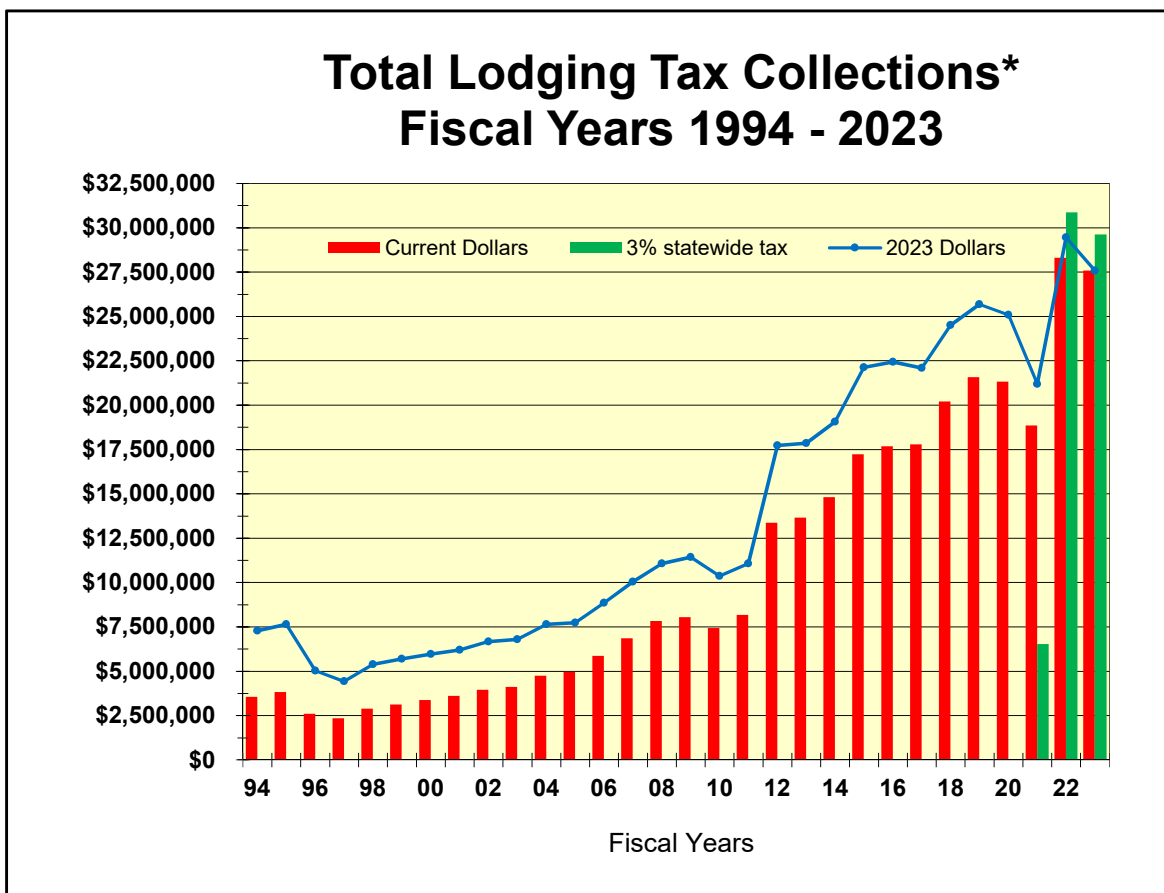

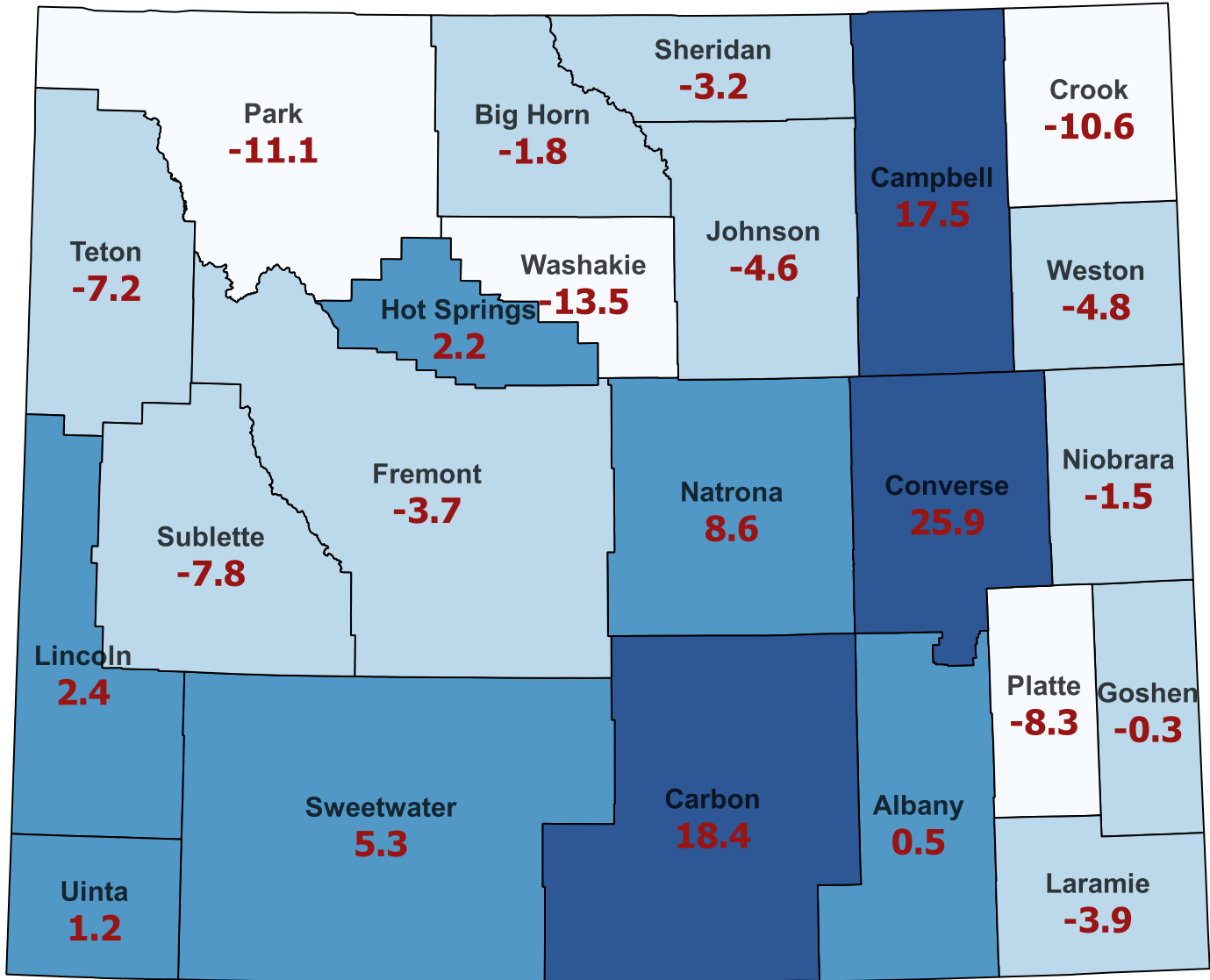

SUMMARY OF LODGING TAX COLLECTIONS

Total lodging tax collections (including statewide lodging taxes), \$57.1 million for fiscal year 2023, were down slightly from the \$59.1 million collected in the previous year, or -3.4 percent. The year-over-year change for the state-imposed 3% lodging tax collections was -4.0 percent. Due to record breaking outdoor and park visitations, and substantial increases in lodging prices, total lodging sales in the state increased significantly, 46.0 percent in fiscal year 2022. However, it was not a surprise that the closure and the subsequent limited admission due to the flooding in Yellowstone National Park and the return of normal tourism activities, post-COVID reversed the trend in fiscal year 2023.

Converse (20.8%) showed the fastest growth, followed by Campbell (17.5%). A rebound in the mining activities were perhaps mostly responsible for these strong increases. Two other counties, Natrona and Carbon also demonstrated an over 8.0 percent growth rate. Teton County, which collects more than half of Wyoming's lodging taxes due to its geographical inclusion of national parks, Yellowstone and Grand Teton, experienced a decrease of 7.5 percent from FY 2022 to FY 2023. Park County, with the second highest in lodging collections in the state, declined 11.2 percent, were affected by the summer flood. Overall, 14 counties showed declines in FY 2023.

The map on page 64 shows the percent change in lodging tax collections by county between fiscal years 2022 and 2023.

GLOSSARY

North American Industry Classification System (NAICS)

11 Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing and Hunting: The Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing and Hunting sector comprises establishments primarily engaged in growing crops, raising animals, harvesting timber, and harvesting fish and other animals from a farm, ranch, or their natural habitats.

21 Mining, Quarrying, and Oil and Gas Extraction: The Mining sector comprises establishments that extract naturally occurring mineral solids, such as coal and ores; liquid minerals, such as crude petroleum; and gases, such as natural gas. The term mining is used in the broad sense to include quarrying, well operations, beneficiating (e.g., crushing, screening, washing, and flotation), and other preparation customarily performed at the mine site, or as a part of mining activity.

22 Utilities: The Utilities sector comprises establishments engaged in the provision of the following utility services: electric power, natural gas, steam supply, water supply, and sewage removal. Within this sector, the specific activities associated with the utility services provided vary by utility: electric power includes generation, transmission, and distribution; natural gas includes distribution; steam supply includes provision and/or distribution; water supply includes treatment and distribution; and sewage removal includes collection, treatment, and disposal of waste through sewer systems and sewage treatment facilities.

23 Construction: The Construction sector comprises establishments primarily engaged in the construction of buildings or engineering projects (e.g., highways and utility systems). Establishments primarily engaged in the preparation of sites for new construction and establishments primarily engaged in subdividing land for sale as building sites also are included in this sector.

31-33 Manufacturing: The Manufacturing sector comprises establishments engaged in the mechanical, physical, or chemical transformation of materials, substances, or components into new products. The assembling of component parts of manufactured products is considered manufacturing, except in cases where the activity is appropriately classified in Sector 23, Construction.

42 Wholesale Trade: The Wholesale Trade sector comprises establishments engaged in wholesaling merchandise, generally without transformation, and rendering services incidental to the sale of merchandise. The merchandise described in this sector includes the outputs of agriculture, mining, manufacturing, and certain information industries, such as publishing.

44-45 Retail Trade: The Retail Trade sector comprises establishments engaged in retailing merchandise, generally without transformation, and rendering services incidental to the sale of merchandise. The retailing process is the final step in the distribution of merchandise; retailers

are, therefore, organized to sell merchandise in small quantities to the general public. This sector comprises two main types of retailers: store and non-store retailers.

48-49 Transportation and Warehousing: The Transportation and Warehousing sector includes industries providing transportation of passengers and cargo, warehousing and storage for goods, scenic and sightseeing transportation, and support activities related to modes of transportation. Establishments in these industries use transportation equipment or transportation related facilities as a productive asset. The type of equipment depends on the mode of transportation. The modes of transportation are air, rail, water, road, and pipeline.

51 Information: The Information sector comprises establishments engaged in the following processes: (a) producing and distributing information and cultural products, (b) providing the means to transmit or distribute these products as well as data or communications, and (c) processing data.

52 Finance and Insurance: The Finance and Insurance sector comprises establishments primarily engaged in financial transactions (transactions involving the creation, liquidation, or change in ownership of financial assets) and/or in facilitating financial transactions.

53 Real Estate and Rental and Leasing: The Real Estate and Rental and Leasing sector comprises establishments primarily engaged in renting, leasing, or otherwise allowing the use of tangible or intangible assets, and establishments providing related services. The major portion of this sector comprises establishments that rent, lease, or otherwise allow the use of their own assets by others. The assets may be tangible, as is the case of real estate and equipment, or intangible, as is the case with patents and trademarks.

54 Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services: The Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services sector comprises establishments that specialize in performing professional, scientific, and technical activities for others. These activities require a high degree of expertise and training. The establishments in this sector specialize according to expertise and provide these services to clients in a variety of industries and, in some cases, to households. Activities performed include: legal advice and representation; accounting, bookkeeping, and payroll services; architectural, engineering, and specialized design services; computer services; consulting services; research services; advertising services; photographic services; translation and interpretation services; veterinary services; and other professional, scientific, and technical services.

55 Management of Companies and Enterprises: The Management of Companies and Enterprises sector comprises (1) establishments that hold the securities of (or other equity interests in) companies and enterprises for the purpose of owning a controlling interest or influencing management decisions or (2) establishments (except government establishments) that administer, oversee, and manage establishments of the company or enterprise and that normally undertake the strategic or organizational planning and decision-making role of the company or enterprise. Establishments that administer, oversee, and manage may hold the securities of the company or enterprise.

56 Administrative and Support and Waste Management and Remediation Services: The Administrative and Support and Waste Management and Remediation Services sector comprises establishments performing routine support activities for the day-to-day operations of other organizations. These essential activities are often undertaken in-house by establishments in many sectors of the economy. The establishments in this sector specialize in one or more of these support activities and provide these services to clients in a variety of industries and, in some cases, to households. Activities performed include: office administration, hiring and placing of personnel, document preparation and similar clerical services, solicitation, collection, security and surveillance services, cleaning, and waste disposal services.

61 Educational Services: The Educational Services sector comprises establishments that provide instruction and training in a wide variety of subjects. This instruction and training is provided by specialized establishments, such as schools, colleges, universities, and training centers. These establishments may be privately owned and operated for profit or not for profit, or they may be publicly owned and operated. They may also offer food and accommodation services to their students.

62 Health Care and Social Assistance: The Health Care and Social Assistance sector comprises establishments providing health care and social assistance for individuals. The sector includes both health care and social assistance because it is sometimes difficult to distinguish between the boundaries of these two activities. The industries in this sector are arranged on a continuum starting with those establishments providing medical care exclusively, continuing with those providing health care and social assistance, and finally finishing with those providing only social assistance. The services provided by establishments in this sector are delivered by trained professionals. All industries in the sector share this commonality of process, namely, labor inputs of health practitioners or social workers with the requisite expertise. Many of the industries in the sector are defined based on the educational degree held by the practitioners included in the industry.

71 Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation: The Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation sector includes a wide range of establishments that operate facilities or provide services to meet varied cultural, entertainment, and recreational interests of their patrons. This sector comprises (1) establishments that are involved in producing, promoting, or participating in live performances, events, or exhibits intended for public viewing; (2) establishments that preserve and exhibit objects and sites of historical, cultural, or educational interest; and (3) establishments that operate facilities or provide services that enable patrons to participate in recreational activities or pursue amusement, hobby, and leisure-time interests.

72 Accommodation and Food Services: The Accommodation and Food Services sector comprises establishments providing customers with lodging and/or preparing meals, snacks, and beverages for immediate consumption. The sector includes both accommodation and food services establishments because the two activities are often combined at the same establishment.

81 Other Services (except Public Administration): The Other Services (except Public Administration) sector comprises establishments engaged in providing services not specifically provided for elsewhere in the classification system. Establishments in this sector are primarily engaged in activities, such as equipment and machinery repairing, promoting or administering religious activities, grant making, advocacy, and providing dry-cleaning and laundry services, personal care services, death care services, pet care services, photofinishing services, temporary parking services, and dating services.

92 Public Administration: The Public Administration sector consists of establishments of federal, state, and local government agencies that administer, oversee, and manage public programs and have executive, legislative, or judicial authority over other institutions within a given area. These agencies also set policy, create laws, adjudicate civil and criminal legal cases, provide for public safety and for national defense. In general, government establishments in the Public Administration sector oversee governmental programs and activities that are not performed by private establishments. Establishments in this sector typically are engaged in the organization and financing of the production of public goods and services, most of which are provided for free or at prices that are not economically significant.

For this report, a few industries are combinations of the original NAICS sectors described above with the following commonly adopted names:

Financial Activities: Finance and Insurance (52) + Real Estate and Rental and Leasing (53).

Professional & Business Services: Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services (54) + Management of Companies and Enterprises (55) + Administrative and Support and Waste Management and Remediation Services (56).

Educational & Health Services: Educational Services (61) + Health Care and Social Assistance (62).

Leisure & Hospitality: Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation (71) + Accommodation and Food Services (72).
