1999 County Population Estimates

According to the U.S. Census Bureau's recently released population estimates, the July 1999 population for Wyoming slightly decreased to 479,602 from 480,045, which was the revised figure for 1998. The estimated net migration numbers, after accounting for the natural change (births minus deaths), indicate that over 2,800 more persons left the state than moved in from 1998 to 1999. Nationally, the population was estimated at 272,690,813 in 1999, an increase of 0.9 percent from 1998.

Most counties in Wyoming showed population decreases between 1998 and 1999. However, Teton County continued to lead the state with a strong growth rate of 2.4 percent. Campbell, Lincoln, and Sublette counties also realized over 1 percent expansion, respectively. Big Horn, Goshen, Hot Springs, Park, Sweetwater, Washakie, and Weston counties each suffered losses of at least 1.0 percent during the same period (see page 2).

1998 Wage and Salary Summary

New estimates from the U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis for 1998 are now available for the following series: wage & salary disbursements, wage & salary employment, and average wages per job. All 3 series are presented on a place-of-work basis for counties. The employment figures are a measure of full-time and part-time jobs.

Estimates indicate that the total wage and salary employment for Wyoming in 1998 was 242,972, an increase of 1.7 percent from 1997. The national job growth rate for the same period was 2.5 percent. The 1998 average wage per job in the state was \$24,609, a 3.3 percent growth from earlier year. Nationwide, the average wage was \$31,299, up 5.0 percent during the same period (see page 3).

1997 Economic Census

The data from 1997 Economic Census are published on the basis of the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS). Recently

released reports with Geographic Area Series data for Wyoming include economic sectors with NAICS 22, NAICS 23, NAICS 48-49, NAICS 51, NAICS 52, NAICS 61, and NAICS 81. Each report provides several key economic statistics including number of establishments (locations), number of employees, annual payroll, and measure of output (such as sales, receipts, or revenue), mostly for the state, counties, and cities with 2,500 or more inhabitants.

All results of the 1997 Economic Census are available on the U.S. Census Bureau's Internet site (<http://www.census.gov>) and on CD-ROM. The state-level summary statistics are presented in this publication. Users can also contact our office for the detailed reports or technical assistance about the census (see page 4 to 6).

1997 Vehicle Inventory and Use Survey

This survey, conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, produces state level statistics on the physical and operational characteristics of the state's truck, van, minivan, and sport utility vehicle (SUV) population.

There were an estimated 291,300 private and commercial trucks registered in Wyoming during 1997, up 24 percent from the 1992 level. During this 5 year period, the number of minivans increased 73.3 percent, while SUVs and pickups increased 37.7 and 10.4 percent, respectively. Total truck registrations in 1997 included 60.4% pickups, 15.9% SUVs, and 5.4% minivans. Wyoming has approximately one pickup for every 3 people and about one SUV for every 10 people (see page 7).

1999 Federal Government Expenditures

Wyoming received \$3.6 billion federal funds in FY 1999, a substantial increase of 8.3 percent over 1998. The direct Fed expenditure or obligation data at the county level include domestic benefits, subsidies, grants, goods and services, and salaries and wages. Wyoming ranked 2nd on per-capita grants spending in 1999 (see page 8 to 9).
